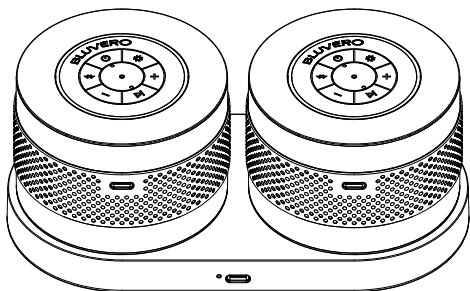


Wireless Bluetooth Speaker

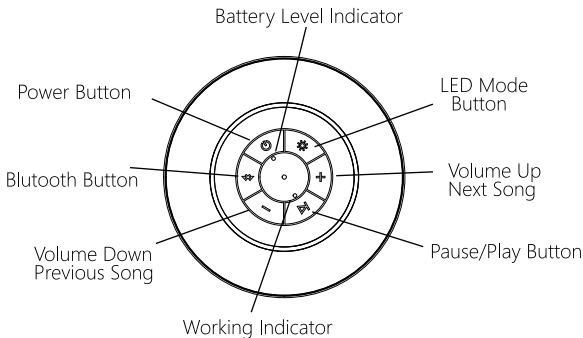
Specification

- **Wireless version:** 5.3
- **Output Power:** 5W
- **Frequency Response:** 100HZ—20KHZ

Main Feature

- **Expandable Sound:** Connect multiple speakers for a synchronized audio experience.
- **IPX4 Waterproof:** Splash-resistant design.
- **Charging Dock:** Charge two speakers simultaneously.
- **RGB LED Lights:** Multiple lighting modes.
- **Magnetic Stackable Design:** Portable and easy to align speakers for synced playback.

How to Use



Controls

- **Power Button:** Turn the speaker on or off.
- **Pause/Play Button:** Pause or play music; answer or end phone calls.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust volume or skip to the next/previous track.
- **Bluetooth Button:** Connect or disconnect the speaker from your mobile device.
- **LED Mode Button:** Cycle through different RGB lighting modes.

Multi-Speaker Connection

1. Pairing a Primary Speaker:

- Turn on a single speaker and press the Bluetooth button to designate it as the primary speaker.
- On your phone, select "**BLUVERO SPEAKER**" to connect.

2. Adding Follower Speakers:

- Turn on any additional speaker. It will automatically connect to the primary speaker.

3. Follower Mode (Single Use):

- Press the Bluetooth button on a follower speaker to use it independently.

4. Re-grouping Speakers:

- Hold the Bluetooth button again on a follower speaker to return it to the multi-speaker setup.

5. Stack-Up Play:

Portable Use

- Speakers can be used individually or stacked with magnetic alignment for on-the-go listening.

Auto Power Off

- To save battery power, the speaker will automatically turn off after a period of inactivity when no Bluetooth connection, music playback, or user operation is detected

Battery Levels

- **Green:** Over 80%
- **Blue:** 20% – 80%
- **Red:** Under 20% (flashes when below 10%)

Charging

1. Charging Station:

- Connect the station to power via USB and place the speaker on it. Magnets ensure proper alignment.

2. Direct Charging:

- Use a USB Type-C cable to charge the speaker directly.

Charging lights

- **Red:** Charging
- **Green:** Fully charged

Working lights

- **Breathing Flash:** Power is on
- **Quick Flash:** Pairing mode active
- **Solid Light:** Connected to a device or music paused
- **Slow Flash:** Music playing
- **Off:** Speaker is acting as a follower in multi-speaker mode

Troubleshooting

- **Speaker will not turn on:** Battery may be empty. Charge the speaker and try again.
- **Connection failure:** Ensure the speaker is not already connected to another device. If issues persist, reboot the speaker and restart pairing.
