Preface

1.Thank you for purchasing this digital media player. Please read this manual thoroughly before use.

2.This manual is based on the latest product information available at the time of production. Any product modifications are subject to change without prior notice.

3.The power interface of this product is designed specifically for charging the built-in battery. Please charge the device using a USB port from a computer or a 5VDC/600mA power adapter that complies with national standards and is CCC certified. Please do not connect to other power supply equipment, otherwise it may cause irreversible consequences such as failure to charge or data and hardware damage, for which we do not assume any responsibility.

4.Do not attempt to repair or disassemble the product yourself.Unauthorized repairs will void any warranty or after-sales service.

Precautions

- 1.Keep the device away from electromagnetic environments, excessive humidity, and dusty conditions.
- 2.Do not submerge the device in water. Do not use corrosive or abrasive cleaners.
- 3.Avoid applying excessive pressure to the device.
- 4.Please do not vibrate or hit the product violently.
- 5.It is recommended to lower the volume before using headphones and gradually increase it to a comfortable level. To protect your hearing, avoid high volume (Prolonged use of high volume listening can damage the listener's hearing.If you experience tinnitus, reduce the volume or stop use) .
- 6.Keep the device out of reach of children to prevent accidents or falls.
- 7.Unplug the device after charging to avoid prolonged power connection.
- 8.Do not use headphones while driving, cycling, operating machinery, or when awareness of surrounding sounds is required.

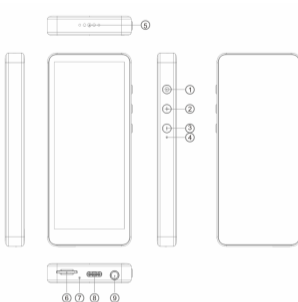
9. Battery Charging Notes :

- ④ Do not expose the battery to direct sunlight, fire, or overheating environments.

Quick Guide

System Reset

If the device freezes, press the “RESET” button to force shutdown. Then press the power button to restart.

Navigation

- ① Tap the ◀ icon at the bottom to go back.
- ② Tap the “○” icon to return to the home screen.
- ③ Tap the “□” icon to view and close running applications.
- ④ Tap the “▽” icon to hide part of the menu.

Volume Adjustment

- ① Buttons: Press the “Volume +” or “Volume -” to adjust volume level.
- ② Touchscreen: Drag the slider on the volume bar to adjust the sound.

Notes on Battery Charging

1. Please use PC USB port or 5V/600mA power adapter to charge. Note: Different PCs have different current output capabilities of the USB interface, and the charging time will also be slightly different. It is recommended that when using the PC USB interface to charge, try to charge in the off state to speed up the charging speed. When charging, it is a normal phenomenon that the charger and the player have a certain temperature rise.
2. New battery needs to charge and discharge for several times to achieve optimum performance.
3. The player can be fully charged in about 3 hours normally. It is recommended to unplug it from the USB interface after charging, and please do not connect to the power supply for a long time.
4. The polymer lithium battery coming with can be recharged repeatedly.

5. The polymer lithium battery must be replaced by professionals, do not replace it by yourself. Note: if the battery is improperly replaced, there is a danger of explosion, and it can only be replaced with the same type or, equivalent type of battery. In order to protect the environment, give the waste battery to a professional organization for recycling.

6. Battery life may vary with usage conditions and production time.

Do not expose the battery to overheated environment such as sunlight or,fire.

Note:

-  When charging via a PC USB port, the charging time may vary slightly due to differences in current output capacity across USB ports on different PCs. For faster charging, it is recommended to charge the device while the PC is powered off.
-  Slight heating during charging is normal.

Function Descriptions

Gallery

Tap the “Gallery” icon to view saved photos, screenshots, and media on the TF card.

FM Radio

Tap the “Radio” icon to access FM features. Tap “ < ” “ > ” to manually fine-tune the radio band to select a station. Tap “ ⏮ ” “ ⏭ ” to select the saved radio station quickly. “ ★ ” is the saved radio band. The upper right corner “ ≡ ” is the automatic search for radio bands. “ 🎧 ” can select headphones or speakers. “ ⋮ ” can record the sound of the radio band. Tap “ ⏮ ” “ ⏭ ” to play or pause the radio.

Sound Recording

Tap the “Record” icon to access:

1. Start Recording: Tap “●”
2. Pause/Resume: Tap “||” to pause the recording and click “●” again to resume recording
3. Save Recording: Tap “■”
4. File List: Tap the folder icon “≡” to view saved files

【Note】 Recording format: WAV

Calendar

In the main interface, Tap the “calendar” icon to enter. The upper left corner “▼” can choose: day/week/month/schedule corresponding to the format of the interface. Tap a date to add notes. “+” The menu offers: Create Event, Refresh, Search, Display Settings, Clear Events, Jump To Date, Settings.

File Manager

Browse internal or TF card files. Tap to open files or media, and switch to appropriate function. “” to Select, Share, Open with, Rename, Add to Favourites, Move to bin, Move to, Move to safe folder, Copy to Back up to Google Drive, File info

Bluetooth

Tap “Bluetooth” to toggle on. Tap to search and connect to available devices. Paired devices will auto-reconnect. The icon will change when connected. 

Settings:

Tap “Settings” to configure:

- 1.WLAN: Connect to Wi-Fi
- 2.Bluetooth: Connect to phones, headphones, speakers etc.
- 3.Memory: View internal storage status.

- 4.Apps & Notifications: View recent apps and permissions etc.
- 5.Battery: Check battery info and power saving options etc.
- 6.Storage : Manage internal and TF card storage
- 7.Sound and Vibration: Adjust media,alarm, and notification volume
- 8.Display:Adjust brightness ,wallpaper,sleep time,font,screen rotation etc.
- 9.Security :Set screen lock, data encryption
- 10.Google :Services and preferences
- 11.Auto Shutdown: Set timer (5/10/15/20 min ,or Never)
- 12.Schedule Power on/off : can set the automatic on/off time
- 13.System:a.Language & input; b.Gestures,c.Date & Time;d. sd card upgrade; e. Developer options,f.Reset options;
- 14.About Phone

Charging and Battery Management

1. Connect one end of the USB cable to a PC, the other to the device to charge.
2. Charging is complete when the battery icon stops flashing.

Notes:

1. New batteries require several cycles for optimal performance.
2. If unused for a long time, recharge monthly to prevent over-discharge damage.
3. Battery damage due to over-discharge or non-original chargers is not covered under warranty.

Using TF Card

1. Insert the card properly until you hear a “click.”
2. To remove, press the card inward and release to eject.

Cautions:

- 1.Insert card correctly into the slot.
- 2.Do not remove the card during operations to avoid data loss.
- 3.Avoid high temperatures or humidity.
- 4.Keep away from liquids and corrosive materials.

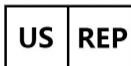
