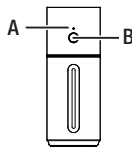
## Operation

### 1 Function

- When the humidifier is on, the indicator (A) is steady on green light. When the humidifier is off, the indicator (A) is off.
- When the battery is low, the indicator (A) is blinking red light.
- When charging, the indicator (A) is blinking green light. When the battery is full, the indicator (A) is steady on green light.
- When the humidifier is low water, the indicator (A) is steady on red light.

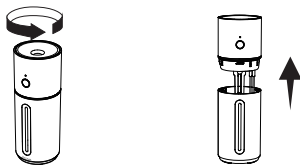
### 2 Power Button

- Tap to turn the humidifier on / low mist level / high mist level / off.
- Press power button (B) for 2s to turn the accent light and water tank light on/off.

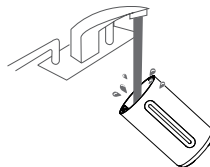


### 3 To open

- Rotate the top of humidifier anticlockwise and remove from the water tank.



### 4 Clean the water tank before first use.



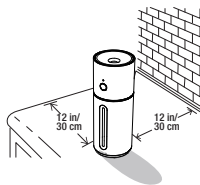
### 5 Fill the tank.

- Recommend using purified or distilled water. Do not fill with hot water.



### 6 Choose a flat location

- Choose a hard, flat surface for the humidifier at least 12 inches / 30 cm away from any walls. The surface must be water-resistant.

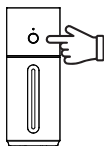


## Operation (continued)

### CHANGING THE WICK

#### 1 Turning off

- Turn off the humidifier, remove the humidifier top from the tank.



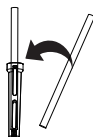
#### 2 Take off the wick bracket

- Rotate the wick bracket anticlockwise, take off the wick bracket.



#### 3 Change a new wick

- Remove the wick from the filter bracket, change a new wick.



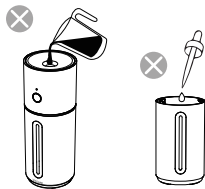
#### 4 Put it back

- Place the wick bracket and rotate it clockwise.



### DO NOT ADD FOREIGN OBJECTS

- 1 □ Do not add essential oils or pour water at the mist nozzle. If there is standing water in the mist nozzle, please dry it with a clean tissue or cloth.



**NOTE:** We recommend using purified or distilled water to fill the tank.



**NOTE:** Do not fill past the tank's max waterline.



**NOTE:** Do not add water directly through mist nozzle.



**NOTE:** Do not add essential oils into the water tank.



**NOTE:** Do not use water treatment liquids in this humidifier.

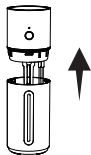
## Care & Maintenance

### CLEANING

Please clean water tank and mist nozzle every 3 days before storing it.

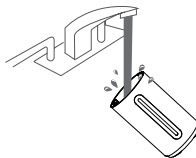
#### 1 Turning off

- Unplug the humidifier, remove the humidifier top and wick bracket from the water tank.



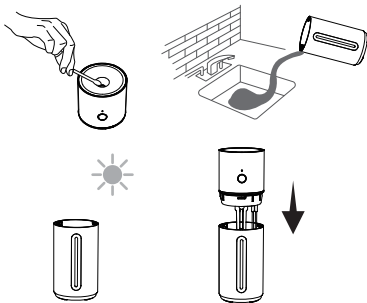
#### 2 Clean the water tank

- Rinse the water tank, then pour out any water from the tank.



#### 3 To descale the humidifier

- Fill the tank with 1/3 of a cup/ 70 mL of distilled white vinegar.
- Assemble the humidifier top on the tank, and swish the vinegar around the tank, soak for 15-20 minutes.
- Rinse all parts until any vinegar smell is completely gone.
- Clean the mist nozzle with a 50/50 mix of white vinegar and water by a cotton swab. Wipe off with a wet cotton swab. Dry all parts with a cloth. Make sure all parts are completely dry before reassembling or storing.



**NOTE:** Cleaning on a water-resistant surface, such as a kitchen counter.



**NOTE:** Change the water in 3 days to avoid bacteria growth.



**NOTE:** Use a tissue or cloth to clean the mist nozzle regularly.



**NOTE:** If not using the humidifier for 3 days or longer, remove water, clean and dry.



**NOTE:** Never immerse the top of humidifier in water or liquid. Do not place any part of the humidifier in dishwasher.



**NOTE:** Do not use detergents or additives to clean the humidifier.

## Safety Information

### READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

- Only use the humidifier as described in this manual.
- Place the humidifier and USB-C Cable properly so that it will not be knocked over.
- Do not place humidifier near to large pieces of furniture or in high-traffic areas.
- Turn off humidifier if do not use it. And disconnect from power by removing the USB-C Cable from the outlet.
- Do not use the humidifier in wet environments.
- Keep the humidifier away from children.
- Always unplug your humidifier from the power outlet before cleaning your humidifier or detaching the humidifier top from water tank.
- Always make sure to place the humidifier on a flat area before operation.
- Only fill the water tank with clean water. Never fill the water tank with any other liquids.
- Do not place the humidifier near to heat source, such as stovetops, ovens or radiators.
- Do not use other items as replacement parts for this product.
- Do not cover the mist nozzle while the humidifier is working, otherwise it may damage the humidifier.
- Do not immerse the humidifier top, power cord or plug in water.
- If the humidifier is damaged or is not functioning properly, stop using it and contact Customer Service immediately.
- This humidifier should not to be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capacities or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for the safety.
- The product shall be charged by class 2 power unit only.

### BATTERY & CHARGING CORD

- This product has an internal, non-replaceable lithium battery. This battery is not user-serviceable. Please dispose in accordance with local, state, province, and country regulations.
- Do not grab the USB-C Cable with wet hands. Keep the USB-C Cable away from liquids.

## Troubleshooting (continued)
