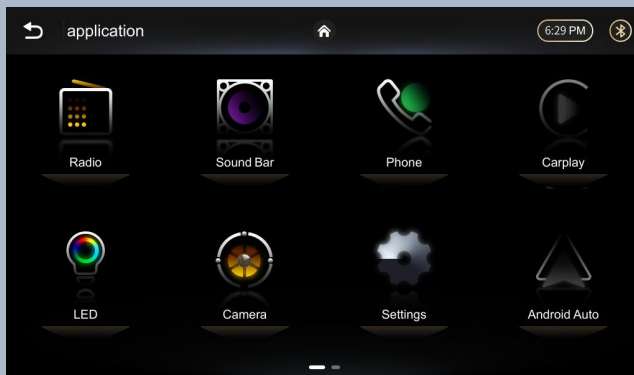


3. Dashboard Screen Introduction

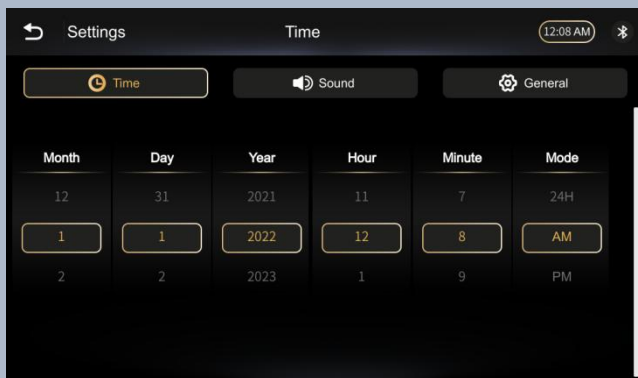


Touch the  icon will enter into main interface.

5.2 Volume Adjustment

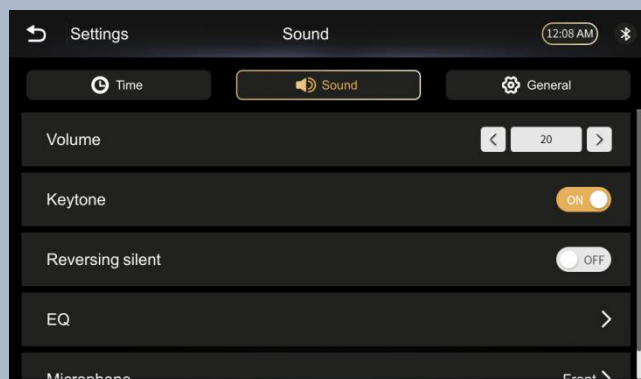
Select  switch to “Volume Setting” page

①Volume adjustment, select  to reduce volume, select  to add volume.

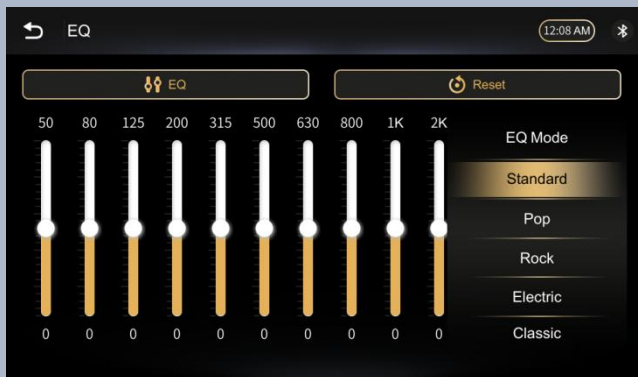

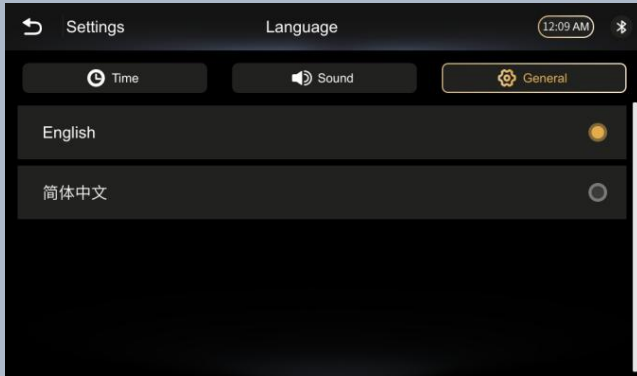

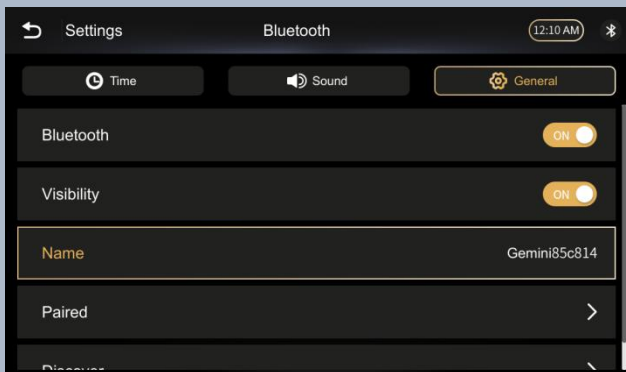

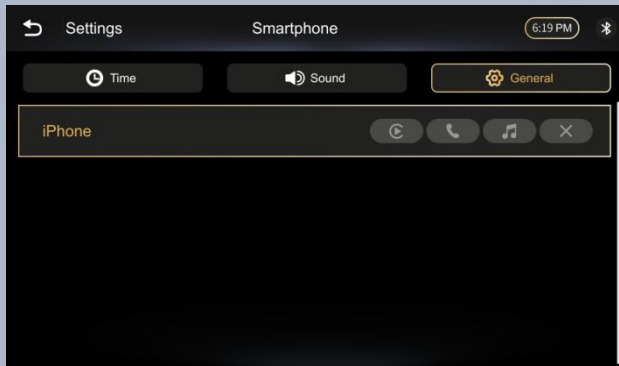

 Open BT,  Close BT



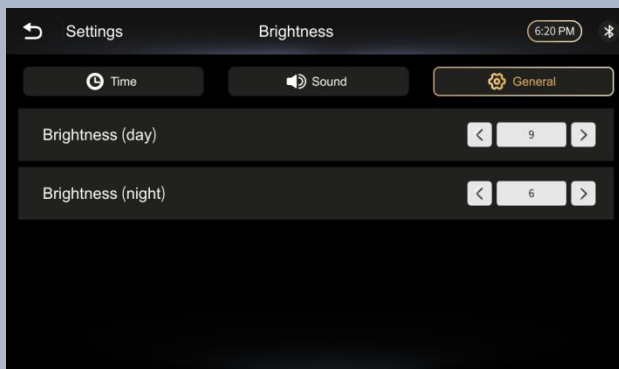

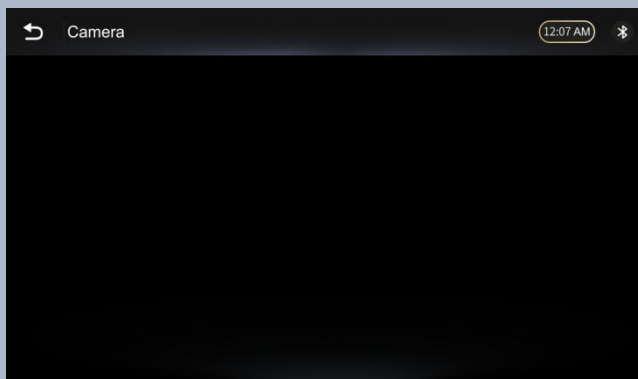
7. Radio

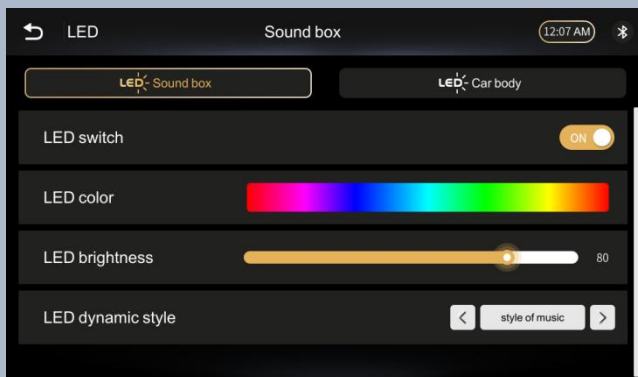


8. Front View Camera
