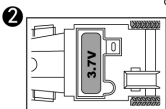
Turn on the screw of the remote control.

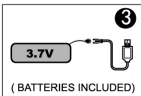
Use 2 "AA" Batteries.

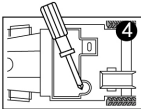
Install the screws of the remote control back.

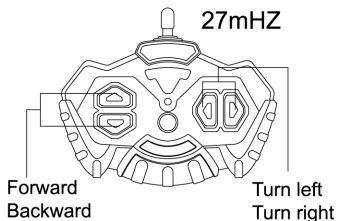
Open the battery compartment screw.

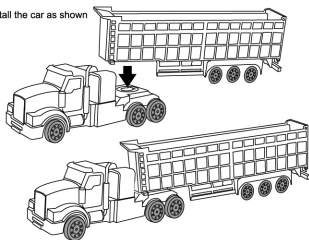
Battery connected to USB charger. To recharge (must make. Use the charger equipped by our factory)
