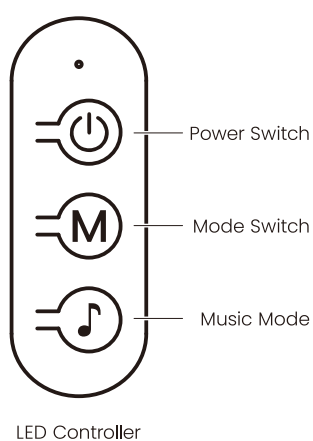
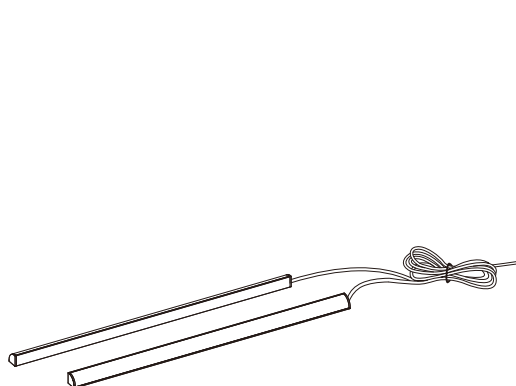
- **KEEP new and used batteries OUT OF REACH of CHILDREN.**

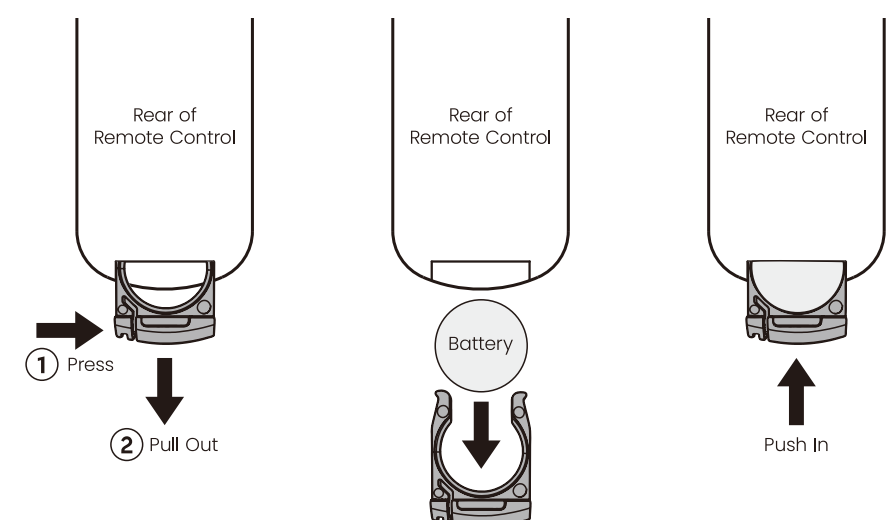
- Remove and immediately recycle or dispose of used batteries according to local regulations and keep away from children. Do NOT dispose of batteries in household trash or incinerate.

- Battery type: CR2025.
- Nominal battery voltage: 3V.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.

- Ensure the batteries are installed correctly according to polarity (+ and -).

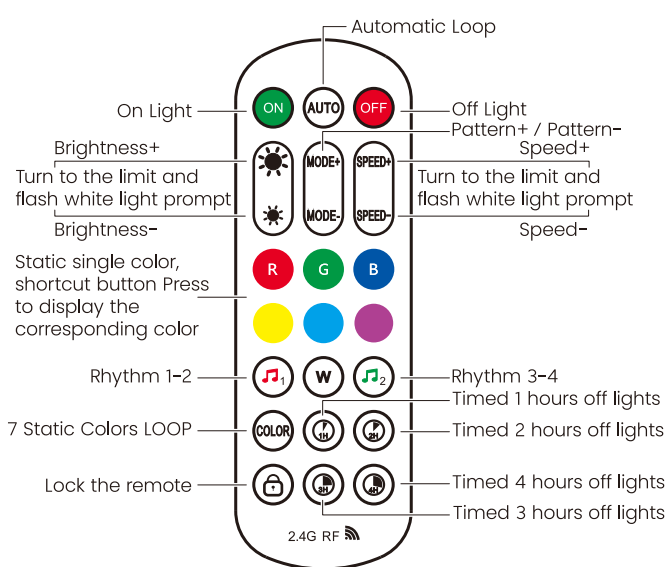


To replace or install a new battery into the remote control

Open the battery door following the instruction diagram on the back side of the remote. Insert (1) button cell battery (CR2025) in the direction as shown in the diagram below.



LED Remote Control Operation



• **Remote Control Lock:**
After the light strip is plugged in, press the lock button within 4 seconds, the white light flashes 3 times, the remote control is locked, and pressing other remote control buttons is ineffective.

• **Remote Control Unlocking:**
After the light strip is plugged in, press the lock button within 4 seconds, and the white light will flash 3 times to unlock the remote control. Pressing other remote control buttons is effective.

• Operating Environment

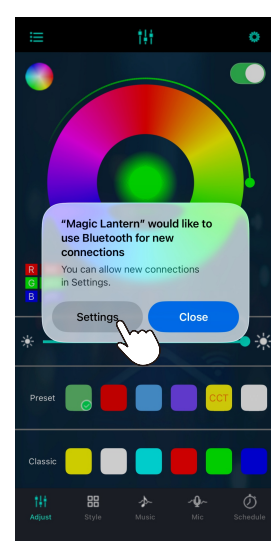

1. If Bluetooth is not enabled, a notification will appear after entering the interface. Select [Settings] to turn on Bluetooth.

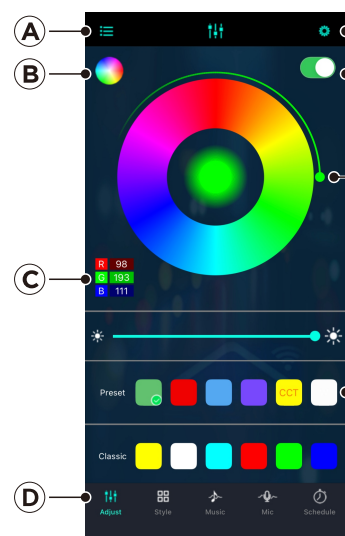
2. Connect to devices in the list using Bluetooth.

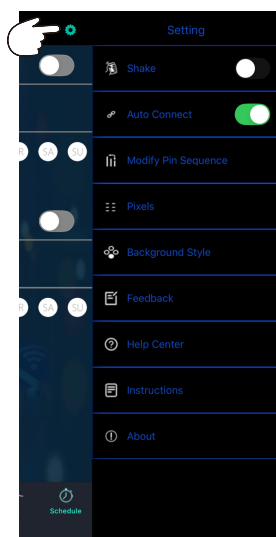

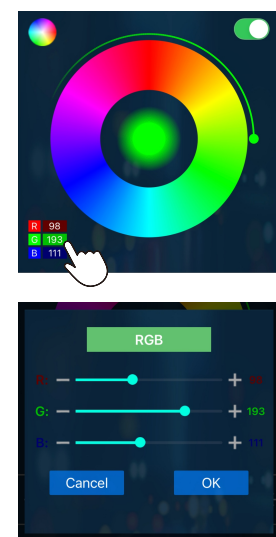

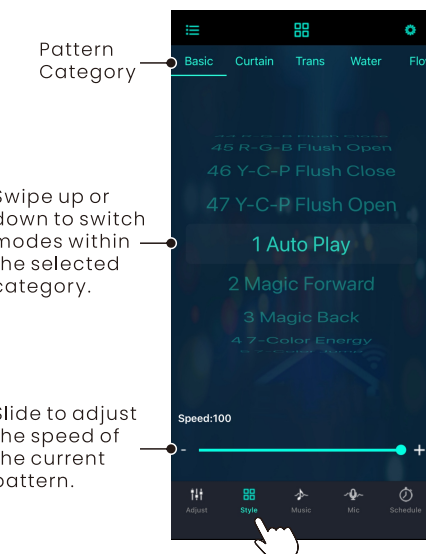

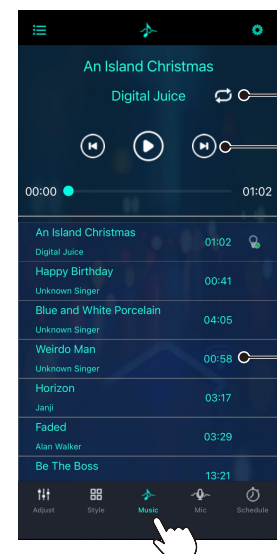

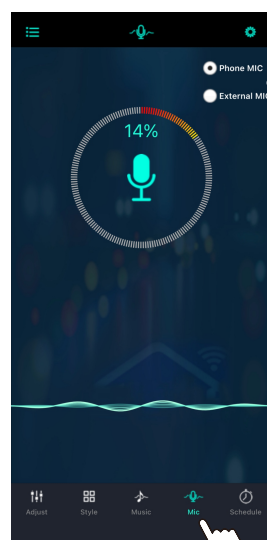

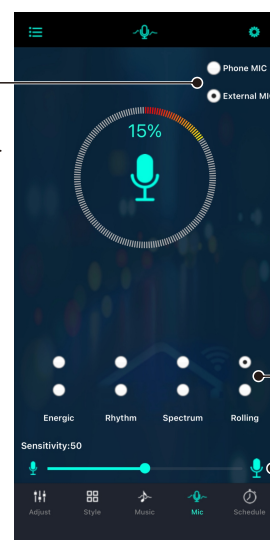
