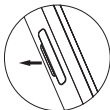
Installation and Charging

SIM card holder extraction method

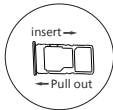
Find the position of the SIM card holder on the phone firstly, then gently pull the SIM card holder with your hand, and it will immediately pop out.



1. Find the position of the SIM card holder on the phone firstly (indicated by the arrow).

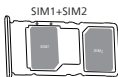
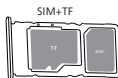


2. Gently pull the SIM card holder with your hand (indicated by the arrow), it will pop out.

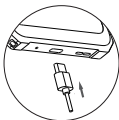


3. Insert or remove the SIM card holder as the direction indicated by the arrow.

Charge the battery



*Tips:

- You can use the phone while it is charging.
- Keeping the charger plugged to the mobile phone when the battery is fully charged will not damage the battery.
- If you do not intend to use your phone for several days, we recommend that you remove the battery.
- If a fully charged battery left unused, it will lose its charge over time.
- If a battery is being used for the first time or the battery has not been used for a prolonged period, it may take longer time to recharge.

Using your phone

Turn your phone on and off

- 1 Press and hold power key to turn on your phone.
- 2 To turn off your phone, press and hold power key and then select **Power off**.

Keys

Learn about the main keys.

Key	Definition	Function
	Power key	Press and hold to power on/off. Press to turn on/off the screen display. Hold to access the Phone options, choose Emergency, Power off, or Restart.
	Home key	Return to the home screen. Hold to open the 'Gemini' function.
	Option key	Open the options list for recent applications.
	Back key	Return to the previous screen or exit.
	Volume key	Adjust the volume in standby mode or during a call. when answering a call, press any volume key to mute the ringtone.
	Flashlight key	Long press to turn on/off the flashlight function on any interface.
	Custom Function key	Long press to enter camera by default, or users can customize other optional functions.

Home screen

From the Home screen, you can view your device's status and access applications.

The Home screen has multiple panels. Scroll left or right to view the panels on the Home screen.

Notifications panel

When you get a new notification, you can open the Notifications panel to see what event notification or new information you have received.

- To open the Notifications panel, press and hold the status bar, then slide one finger downward. If you have several notifications, you can scroll down the screen to see them all.
- To hide the panel, drag the bottom of the panel upwards.

Access applications

- Scroll left or right to another screen, select an application.
- Press  to return to the previous screen, press  to return to the Home screen.

Manage applications

- In idle screen, tap **Settings**  > **Apps**
- Tap **Running**, you can view all the running apps, tap this app to enter it, you can tap **Stop** to choose stop running.
- Tap **Downloaded**, you can view all the downloaded apps, tap app to enter it, you can check the detailed information of this app, tap **Uninstall** to unloading it.

Make a call

1. In the application list, tap 

- 2 Dial the number directly or choose one number from the filtered list that have matching digits.
- 3 Make a voice call.
- 4 Tap  to end the call.

Send a message

- 1 In the application list, tap .
- 2 Tap New message .
- 3 Enter the number or tap to select the number from phonebook.
- 4 Select the text field and enter your message text.
- 5 Press  to add a subject for the message or attach a file (Pictures, Videos, Audio or Slideshow).
- 6 Tap  to send the message.

Precaution

Keep your phone away from small children

-  Keep your phone and all accessories out of the reach of small children. Small parts may cause choking or serious injury if swallowed.

Radio Waves

-  Your phone operates with the following frequency bands and maximum radio-frequency power limitation:
GSM/WCDMA/TDD-LTE/FDD-LTE
-  Check with the vehicle manufacturer that electronic equipment used in your vehicle will not be affected by radio energy.

Switch off your phone

-  Turn off the phone when in an aircraft. The use of mobile phones in an aircraft may be dangerous for the operation of the aircraft, disrupt the mobile phones network and may be illegal.
-  In hospitals, clinics, other health care centers and anywhere else where you may be in the close vicinity of medical equipment.

Your mobile phone and your car

Handle your phone carefully and sensibly

 - Do not immerse the phone in any liquid; if your phone is damp, switch it off, remove the battery and let them dry for 24hrs before using them again.
 - To clean the phone, wipe it with a soft cloth.
 - In hot weather or after prolonged exposure to the sun (e.g., behind a window or a wind screen), the temperature of your phone's casing might increase. Be very careful in this case when picking up your phone and also avoid using it with an ambient temperature over 35°C or under 0°C.

Protect batteries from damage

Make sure damaged parts are replaced immediately by a qualified technician and that they are replaced with genuine manufacturer replacement parts.

- Your phone is powered by a rechargeable battery.
- Use specified charger only.
- Do not incinerate.
- Do not deform or open the battery.
- Do not allow metal objects (such as keys in your pocket) to short circuit the battery contacts.
- Avoid exposure to excessive cold or heat (under -20°C or over 60°C), moisture or caustic environments.

2. The Warranty will be valid for twelve (12) months from the date of original purchase for mobile handset. Customer should present the proof of purchase/invoice for claiming this Warranty.
3. For the entire Warranty period, Philips authorized service centre / personnel will/personnel will, at their discretion, without any charges and subject to Clause 6 repair or replace a defective Product. Repair or replacement may involve the use of same or equivalent reconditioned unit. We will return the repaired handset or can replace with another same or equivalent handset to the Customer in full working condition. All replaced faulty parts or components will become the property of our authorized service centre.
4. For the handsets available beyond the municipal limits of the available service centre, it is the responsibility of the Customer to bring the handset to the nearest service centre at his/her own risk and expenses.
5. For any handset repaired or replaced during the warranty period, the repaired or replaced handset shall continue to be within warranty period for the remaining time of the original warranty period of original handset.
6. The warranty will be declared void under the following circumstances:
 - (a) The handset IMEI number/ serial number, water indicator or the warranty seal has been removed, erased defaced, altered or is illegible;
