WARNING

PAIRING

1: Auto Pairing

When taking out the wireless headset from the charging case. The earphones will automatically turn on. Sync together and enter pairing mode.

2: Syncing your headset

When headset do not sync together or become disconnected during use.

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- 1: Turn off both earphones and turn back on.
- 2: If that does not work. Place both headset back into case and remove from charging case.
- 3: While headset are out of the charging case. Press and hold both headset buttons for 3 seconds. This will force the headset to turn off and on again and sync with each other.
- 4: Open up Bluetooth setting on your smart device and scan for **PLOOS**.

BUTTON FUNCTION

1: On/Off buttons

Long press 3 seconds to turn on

Long press 5 seconds to turn off.

2: Play/Pause music

When listening to music. Quick double press the left button or right button to play or pause the music.

3: Previous /Next Song

When listening to music.

Press left button 1.5 seconds to go to previous song

Press right button 1.5 seconds to go to next song

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4: Voice +/-

Press left button once to decrease the voice volume

Press right button once to increase the voice volume

5: Answer/Hang up

When there is an incoming call. Press left or right button once to answer the call.

Press the button again to end the call.

6: Reject

When there is an incoming call. Press left or right button hold 2 seconds to reject the call.

7: Voice assistant

Press left button 3 times to activate voice assistant.

CHARGING FUNCTION

Fully Charge the case and headset before using for the first time.

By cable

Connect the included Type-C cable to the charging port and the other end into a USB powered sources to charge the headset case.
