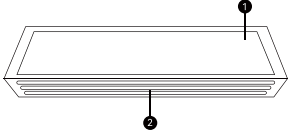

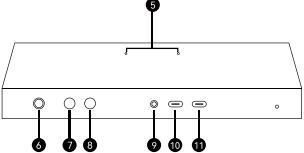
Front view

Quick start guide

Initial Power-On and Setup

- Select the appropriate conversion head and assemble it onto the adapter.
- Connect the power adapter to the device's DC power interface and turn on the power.
- The device will automatically start. When starting for the first time, please follow the on-screen guide to complete:Select the system language.Connect to Wi Fi network.
- After completing the basic settings, the device will enter the main interface.

Connect Configuration Software

- Use the USB-C cable included in the package, with one end plugged into Type-C port 1 and the other end plugged into the computer USB port.
- Download and install the "UltraMate" configuration software from the official website www.Sanytron.com.
- Run the software and create a project.
- Search for CoreBar in the newly created project and configure it within the project.
- According to the requirements, configure the functions of the CoreBar and each module.
