

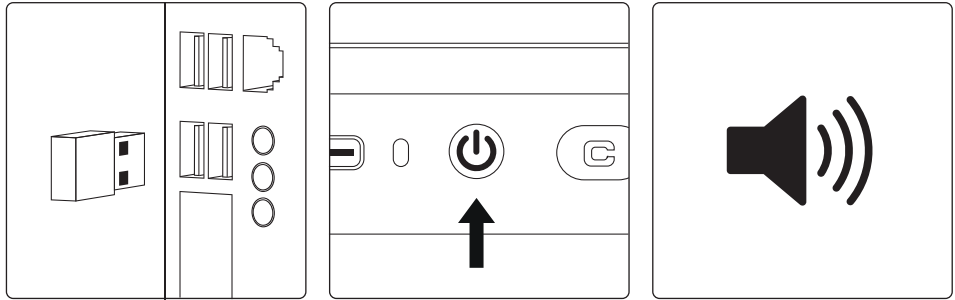

How to Connect

1. Insert the dongle into the computer's USB-A port.
2. Power on the headset by pressing and holding the power button for 3 seconds.
3. Wait for the connection notification



Care and safety

1. Keep the battery dry.
2. Avoid locating the battery terminals near metallic objects.
3. Do not short-circuit. Avoid placing metallic objects or spilling water into the device, at all times.
4. Use only the provided cable and a USB port on your computer to charge the device.
