Back / Exit



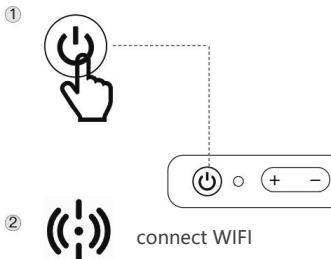

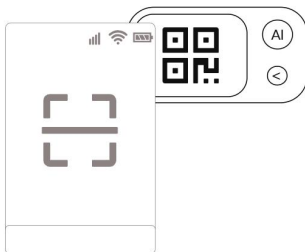
SIM & Memory Card Slot

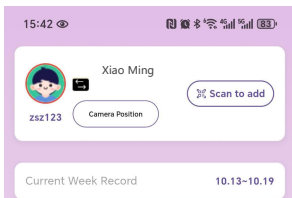
Device Activation & Binding

2. Open the "Oroa" app, log in, go to the Homepage, then scan to bind.



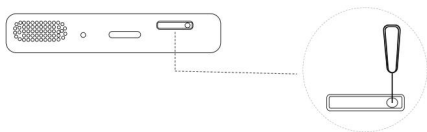

SIM/Memory Card Installation

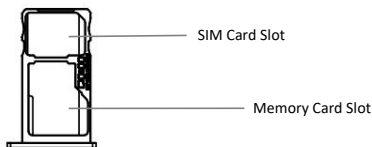
Connectivity: Use Wi-Fi or insert a SIM card.

Steps:

1. Eject the card tray with the provided pin.



2. Place your card in the tray and push it back in firmly.
