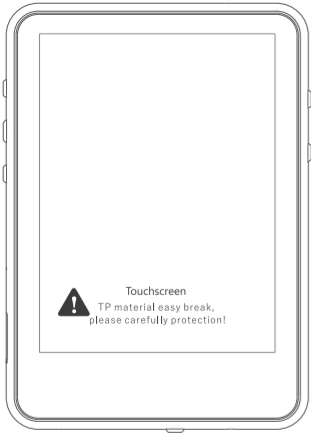

2.Button Function

① Power/Screen Off & Wake-up Button ON/OFF
Press and hold for 3 seconds to power on/off.
Short press to turn the screen off or on.

② Play/Pause Button  
While playing music or video, short press to pause or resume playback.

③ Return Button 
Short press to return to the previous menu.

④ Menu Button M
While in playback mode, short press to open the menu options.

⑤ Previous File   Volume Up +
Press and hold to increase volume (a pop-up box will appear).
While playing music or video, short press to switch to the previous file.

⑥ Next File   Volume Down -
Press and hold to decrease volume (a pop-up box will appear).
While playing music or video, short press to switch to the next file.

⑦ TF Card Slot 
Be sure to insert the TF card in the correct direction to avoid damaging the internal circuit of the TF card slot, which could prevent the card from being read or cause permanent damage to the TF card or slot.

⑧ USB Port
Used for charging the device and connecting to a computer for file transfers.

⑨ Headphone Jack
In music or video playback mode, insert the headphones to listen to music.
In radio mode, the headphones must be inserted to serve as an antenna for receiving broadcasts.

⑩ Reset Hole R (Requires professional guidance)
Use a needle with a diameter of <1mm at a 90-degree angle to gently press the internal reset button to reset the system. The location may vary by model; please refer to the actual device.

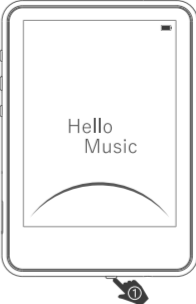

1.3 Screen Off or Screen On

While in use, short press the "Power/Screen Off & Wake-up Button On/OFF" to turn off the screen for protection, or to wake up and turn the screen back on.

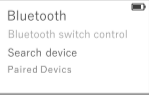
Bluetooth Functions

1. **Bluetooth switch control:** Bluetooth On... Bluetooth Off
A. When Bluetooth is not in use, make sure to turn off Bluetooth via the Bluetooth control switch to conserve battery life and extend the device's battery life.
2. **Search Device**
After turning on Bluetooth, touch "Search Device" to automatically search for available Bluetooth speakers and Bluetooth headphones. Select the device to pair and connect. Once connected, you can stream music, radio, and videos from the device to the Bluetooth speaker or headphones.
3. **Paired Device**
A list of devices that were previously connected. To reconnect, touch on a device from the list. If Bluetooth is not turned off, you need not unpair previously paired devices.

⚠️ **Note:** Bluetooth only supports connections to Bluetooth speakers and Bluetooth headphones. It does not support connecting to a smartphone via Bluetooth.

Music menu

The song played last time/the song being played: When no music is played at the background and you enter the music interface, "last song" will be displayed. As you enter this interface, the song played last time at the time of your exit will be played. When any music is played at the background, "the song being played" will be displayed. Then, you can enter the music playing interface by pressing the Play button,

- ◆ Now playing/Resume
Remember to play the last song played recently.
- ◆ All songs
Display all songs inside the player.
- ◆ Artist
Singers of all songs are listed in an alphabetic order of their name acronyms.
- ◆ Album
Albums are displayed in an on alphabetic order of their name acronyms.
- ◆ Style
Styles are displayed based on built-in styles of downloaded music.
- ◆ Favorites
Click on the  icon in the playback interface and bookmark this playlist1-6.
- ◆ Updating playlists
After adding new songs to the player or inserting a TF card, they can be read by refreshing the playlist.
- ◆ Local folder
Tracks in the machine's memory (No card, no display.)
- ◆ Card folder
Tracks in the TF card's memory (No card, no display.)

4. A-B Repeat
 - Touch the "A-B" icon once to make "A" turn red and "B" start blinking.
 - Touch the "A-B" icon a second time to make both "A" and "B" turn red, starting the A-B repeat.
 - Touch the  pause icon to cancel the repeat and stop playback.
 - 5. Speed Control
 - Touch the "X" icon to adjust the playback speed with a range of ±8 levels (X3 to X-8).
 - 6. Add to Favorites
 - Touch the  icon to add the currently playing track to your favorites 1-6.

Touch the **⏏** or **⏮** icon on the screen, or briefly press the **⏏** play/pause button on the device to pause or resume playback.

8. Previous/Next File

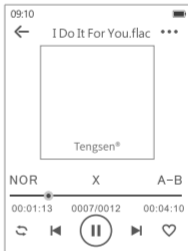

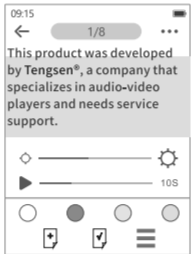

Input Method Switch:

Touch the "P" (Chinese), "EN" (English), "#+=", or "123" icon to switch between Chinese Pinyin input, English input, special symbols, numbers, etc.

3. Open the "Movie Convert Tool V1.3" software to enter the software interface
4. Click the "input icon" to select the video file you want to convert
5. Generally, the default output file path of the system is "C:\Users\User\Documents\videout\0" (you can also modify it according to your own needs)
6. Click the "icon" to enter the settings of the video you want to roll out
7. In the video settings interface, only select "Video Pixel" (other settings are not required by default)
8. General video pixels: **320x240** (please choose according to the actual display pixels of the product), click OK to confirm

Picture & Wallpaper
