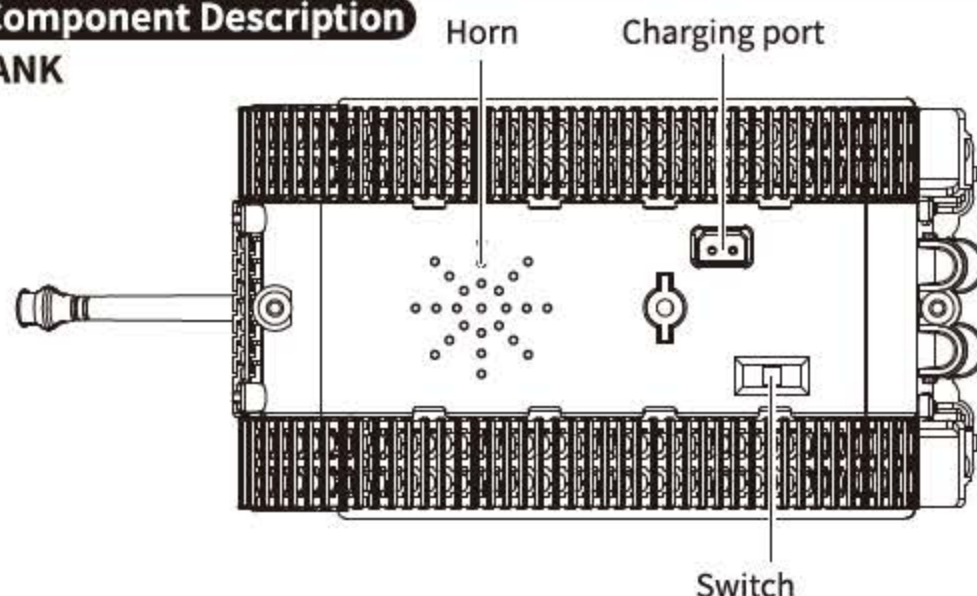

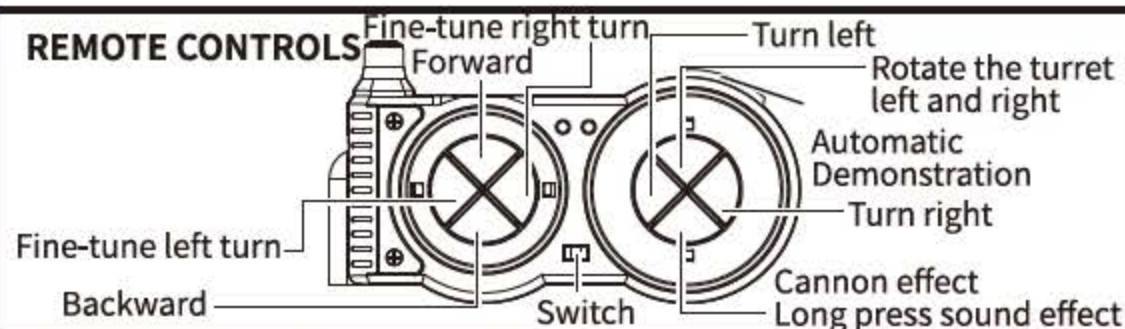


Component Description

REMOTE CONTROLS

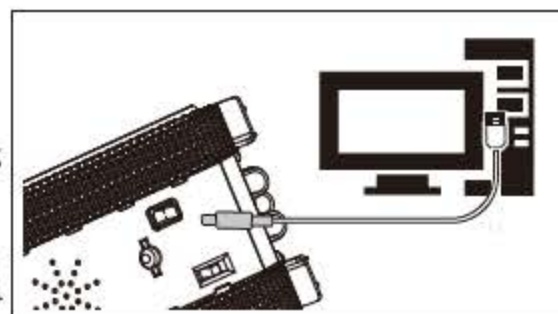


Preliminary

1. Remove packaging cover
2. Push out the tank
3. Unscrew the screws on the bottom of the tank to separate the base from the tank
4. As shown, push out the remote control.
5. Use a screwdriver to open the battery cover of the remote control (as shown in the picture) and install 4 "AA" batteries correctly, then close the battery cover and tighten the screws.
6. Turn on the power of the remote control, press any function key on the remote control, the working indicator light blinks means that the remote control functions normally.

7. TANK CHARGING

- (1). Turn off the tank power and insert the other end of the type-C charging cable into the tank charging port (as shown in the figure). The indicator light will light up during charging.
- (2). After charging for about 16-17 minutes, the charging indicator light will turn off and charging is complete. The tank can travel for about 12-13 minutes when it is fully charged.



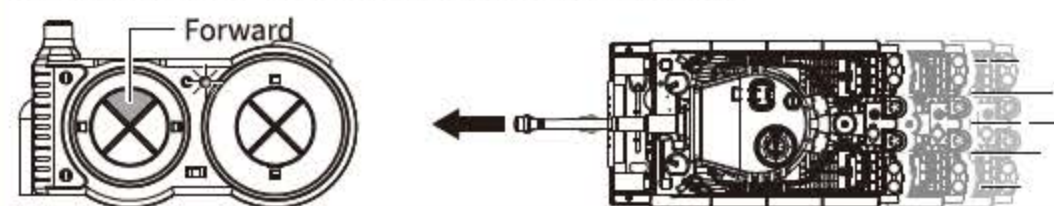
CAUTION

1. Do not pull the charging cable and plug during charging.
2. Please make sure the product is fully discharged before charging to avoid overcharging affecting the battery life.

Operation Guide

Before driving, please turn on the power of the remote control and the tank, the indicator light of the remote control will be long bright while the tank emits sound effect, the frequency pairing is successful, and then put the tank on a flat surface.

1. Press "Forward" button and the tank moves forward.



2. Press the "Backward" button to move the tank backward.



3. Press the left button and the tank will rotate left on the spot.



4. Press the right button and the tank will rotate right on the spot.



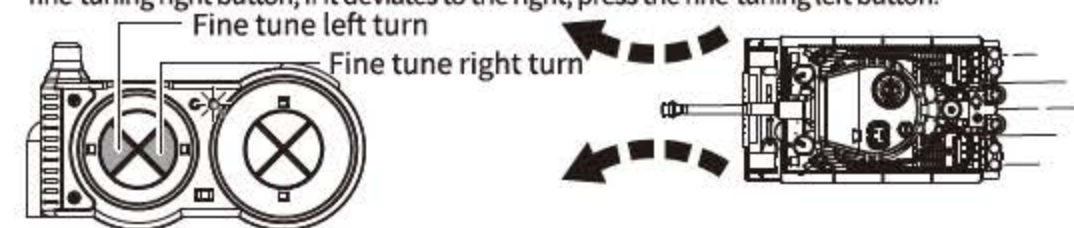
5. Press the "Forward" and "Turn Left" buttons at the same time, and the tank will move forward and turn left.



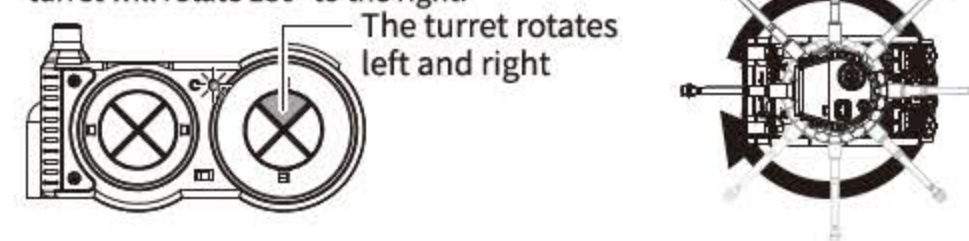
6. Press the "Forward" and "Turn Right" buttons at the same time, and the tank will move forward and turn right.



7. If the tank deviates to the left or right while moving in a straight line, you can adjust it by pressing the fine-tuning button on the remote control. If it deviates to the left, press the fine-tuning right button; if it deviates to the right, press the fine-tuning left button.



8. Press the "turret rotate left and right" key and the turret will rotate 180° to the right.



Operation

1. Bluetooth Operation Instructions

- (1). APP download instructions, scan the QR code, and select the corresponding version to download.
- (2). Turn on the tank switch, turn on the Bluetooth function of the mobile phone and turn on Shenqiwei APP, select the tank model you like, and select hand control (control) or gravity sensing (driving). Enter and click the Bluetooth icon in the upper right corner to connect. For more experience details, please see the instruction manual in the upper right corner of the homepage.

2. Remote Control pairing Instructions

- (1). Turn on the remote control. The indicator light will turn off after about 2 seconds. Turn on the tank. The indicator light will stay on, indicating that the pairing is successful. If the indicator light is off, check whether the car or the remote control has power.
- (2). Turn off the switch when the tank is charging. It cannot be charged when it is turned on! When charging, be sure to identify the positive and negative sides of the plug. The green light on the remote control will turn on when charging. The charging time is 2-3 minutes. The green light will turn off automatically when the charging is completed. When the battery of the remote control is too low, the green light will flash and you can replace it with a new battery. Note: If the tank is not used for a long time, you need to charge it. Do not hold the charging cable and plug during charging. Please make sure that the product is fully discharged before charging to avoid overcharging that affects the battery life. Remember to turn off all switches after use to avoid damaging the battery. The remote control and APP can be paired at the same time, but cannot be operated at the same time.



Preservation methods

1. After use, wipe the dust on the tank, and pack the tank well placed in a dry and well-ventilated place.
2. After use, turn off the switch of the tank and remote control to improve the battery life.
3. Before using again, check whether the power of the tank and remote control is sufficient.

Warning

- The product itself uses 3.7V rechargeable built-in lithium-ion batteries;
- The remote control uses four 1.5V "AA" batteries;
- Please note the polarity when installing or replacing the batteries;
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not rechargeable;
- Adult supervision is required when charging rechargeable batteries;
- Do not use old, new or different types of batteries;
- Battery terminals should not be short-circuited.
- When the product slows down, it means that the product is low on power.
- Please just charge the product as above.
- If the remote control batteries are low and the power indicator is dimmed or does not light up, replace the batteries with new ones.
- Please recognize the charging plug and charging port when charging.
- Remove the batteries from the remote control when it is not used for a long time.
- Under the guidance of an adult when unpacking.
- Retain this information for future reference.
