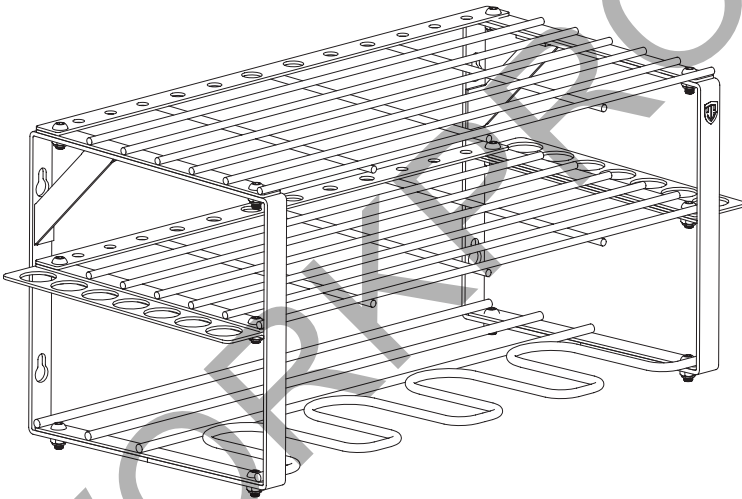

SAFETY INFORMATION

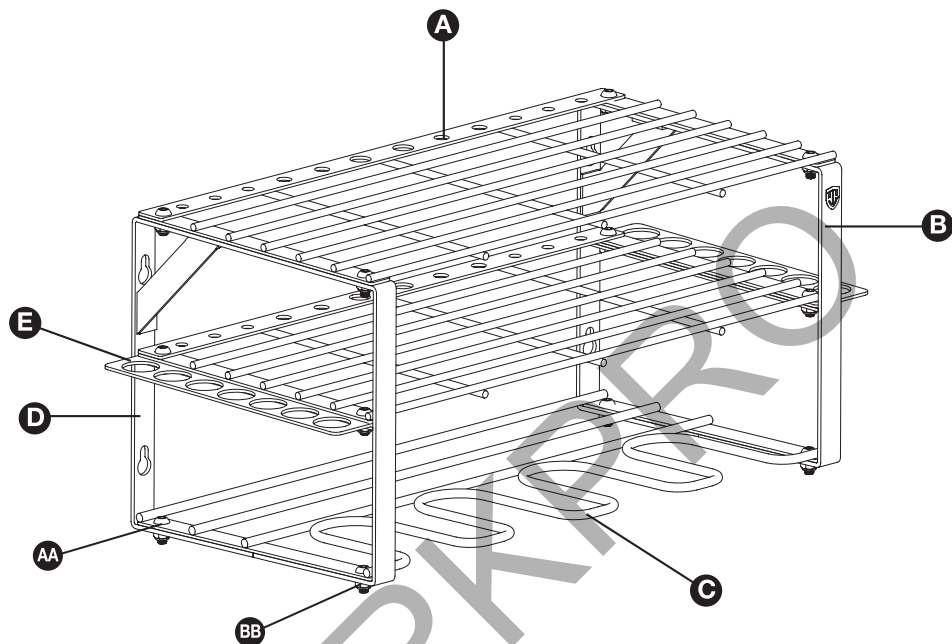

- **Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity for the shelves.**
- **This is a power tool organizer. Do not use for any other purpose than supporting tools or products.** Do not use as a seat, ladder, or standing platform.
- **Keep the area around the organizer clean and well lit.** Cluttered or dark areas invite accidents.
- **Mount the organizer in a dry, indoor place protected from wet conditions.**
- **Keep organizer dry, clean, and free from oil and grease.**
- **Do not use the organizer if it is damaged or broken.** A damaged or broken organizer may not mount securely and/or it might not provide adequate support for the items stored on it.
- **When servicing this product, use only identical replacement parts.** Use of unauthorized parts may create a risk of injury.
- **Mount the organizers to sound structural supports. NEVER mount the organizers to drywall or plaster without the mounting fastener going into a structural support. ALWAYS use concrete anchors when installing organizers into concrete, brick, or other masonry.** Failure to properly mount the organizer could result in a falling hazard that can cause death or serious personal injury.
- **Mount the organizer on smooth and flat surfaces capable of bearing the weight of organizer and the items stored on it.**
- **Use extra care when mounting the unit. Keep proper footing and balance at all times.**
- **Ensure the organizer is securely mounted.** Make sure it does not rock, slide, or move before storing products or tools.
- **Always wear eye protection during installation.** Following this rule will reduce the risk of serious personal injury.
- **Do not allow children or untrained individuals to use this organizer.**
- **Always get help when lifting, moving, and mounting the organizer.** When lifting, hold the organizer close to your body. Bend your knees so you can lift with your legs, not your back.

ASSEMBLY

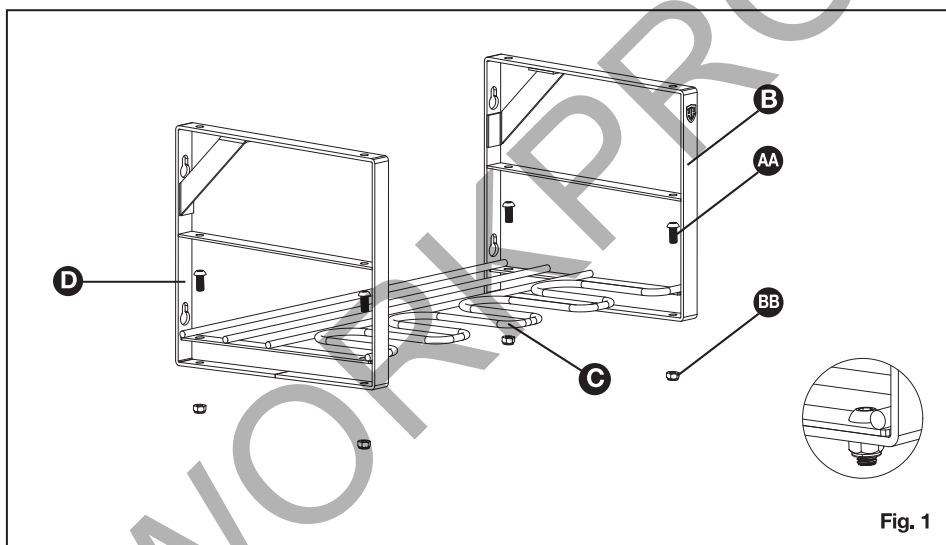


NOTE:

- Assemble on a flat surface. A piece of cardboard is recommended to keep the product from being scratched during assembly.
- Some parts may contain sharp edges, wear protective gloves if necessary.
- Two people are recommended for assembly.

STEP 1: SIDE PANELS ASSEMBLY

- Place the bottom shelf (C) on the side panels (B/D).
- Attach the left side panel (D) and right side panel (B) to the bottom shelf (C) using two M6 x 14mm hexagon socket head bolts (AA) and two M6 nuts (BB) per side and tighten to desired tightness with a 5/32"(4mm) hex key and a 10mm combination spanner.

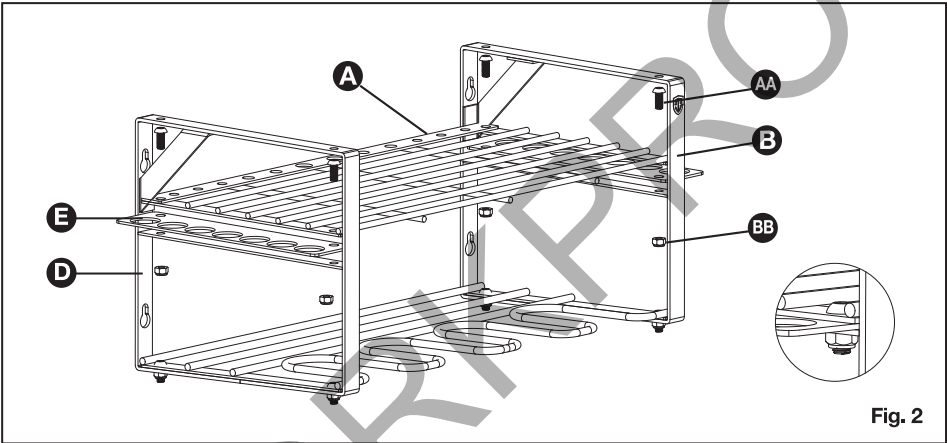
ASSEMBLY

STEP 2: MIDDLE SHELF ASSEMBLY

- Place the tool holder (E) on the left side panel (D) and right side panel (B).
- Place the middle shelf (A) on the tool holders (E).
- Attach the left side panel (D) and right side panel (B) to tool holders (E) and the middle shelf (A) using two M6 x14mm hexagon socket head bolts (AA) and two M6 nuts (BB) per side and tighten to desired tightness with a 5/32"(4mm) hex key and a 10mm combination spanner.

NOTE:

The holes on the middle shelf (A) should face backward.

ASSEMBLY

STEP 3: TOP SHELF ASSEMBLY

- Place the top shelf (A) on the side panels (B/D).
- Attach the left side panel (D) and right side panel (B) to the top shelf (A) using two M6 x 14mm hexagon socket head bolts (AA) and two M6 nuts (BB) per side and tighten to desired tightness with a 5/32"(4mm) hex key and a 10mm combination spanner.



NOTE:

The holes on the top shelf (A) should face backward.

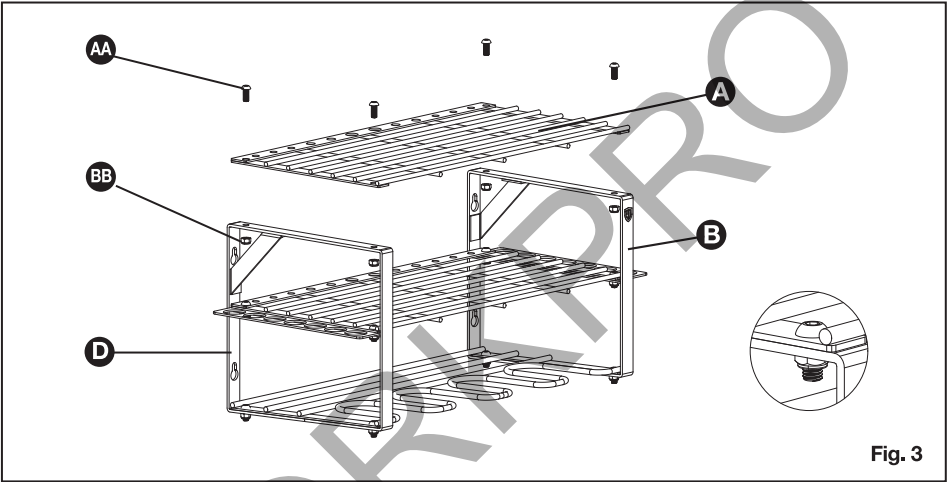

INSTALLATION

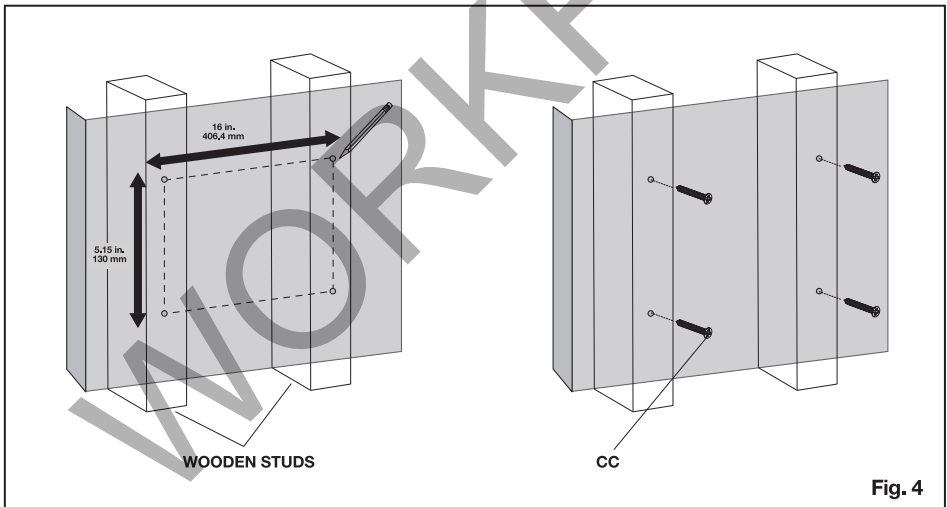
⚠ CAUTION!

- Only install on sound structural supports (such as studs and concrete) in areas where no electrical wires, utility cables, pipes, or other obstructions are located. Failure to follow these instructions can result in death, electrical shock, or other serious personal injury.
- Do not lift the product without help. Hold it close to your body. Keep your knees bent and lift with your legs, not your back. Ignoring these precautions can result in back injury.

AMOUNTING THE SCREWS

Option 1: FOR WOODEN STUDS

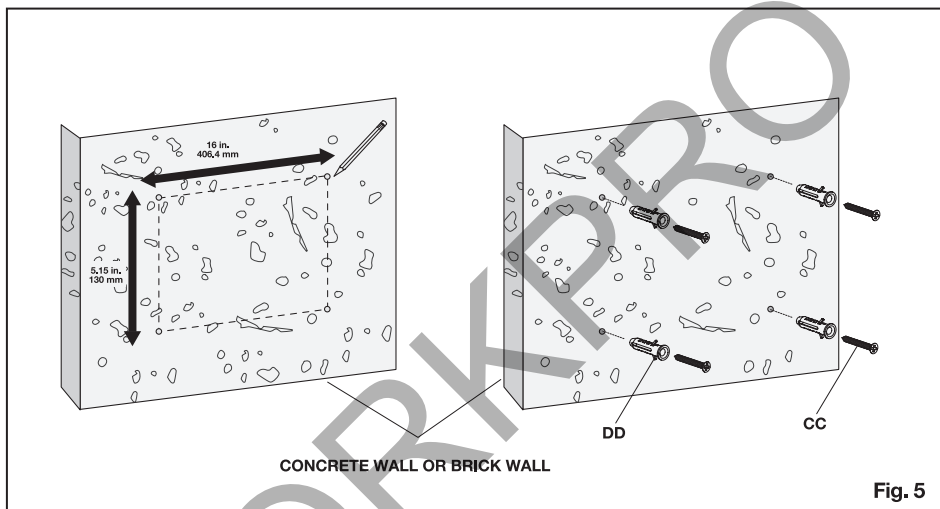
- Find the wooden studs behind your wall.
- Use a pencil and a level, mark four screw holes. The top two screw holes should be 16 in.(406.4mm) apart on studs. The bottom screw holes should be 5.15 inches(130mm) below the top screws.
- Use a power drill make four diameter 0.12in.(3mm) and depth 1.38in.(35mm) pilot holes, which is slightly smaller than the size of #4.8 x 35 Phillips head self-tapping screws (CC).
- Use a PH2 Phillips screwdriver install the screws into the pilot holes. Leave the head of the screws (CC) approximately 1/4 in.(6.4mm) off the wall.



INSTALLATION

Option 2: FOR CONCRETE WALL OR BRICK WALL

- Position the product on concrete wall in desired location.
- Use a pencil and a level, mark four screw holes. The top two screw holes should be 16 in.(406.4mm) apart on walls. The bottom screw holes should be 5.15 inches(130mm) below the top screws.
- Use a power drill make four diameter 0.31in.(8mm) and depth 1.38in.(35mm) for anchors.
- Use your fingers to press the anchor (DD) into the pilot hole, then tap the head of the anchor (DD) lightly with the rubber mallet until it is flush into the wall.
- Use a PH2 Phillips screwdriver install the screws into the anchors. Leave the head of the screws (CC) approximately 1/4 in.(6.4mm) off the wall.



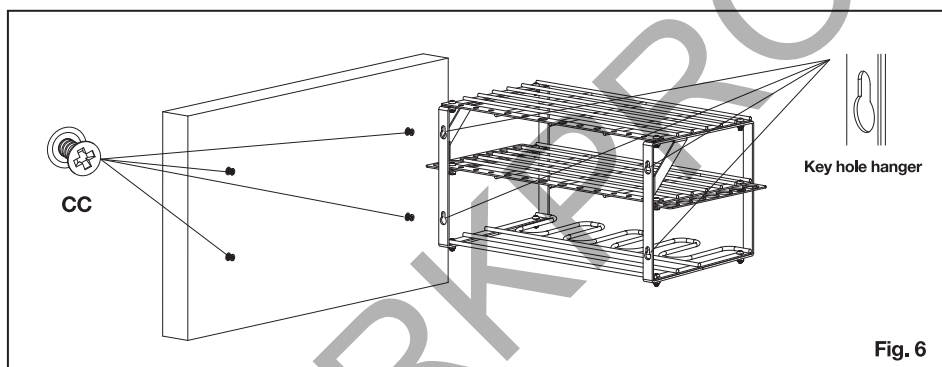
INSTALLATION

AMOUNTING THE ORGANIZER

- With the help of at least one other person, carefully lift the organizer and align the keyholes on the back with the screws in the walls.
- Place the wide portion of each keyhole over the head of each screw.
- To lock the organizer in place, slide the organizer down until the screws are inside the narrow portions of each keyhole.
- Tighten the #4.8 x 35 Phillips head self-tapping screw (CC) to the desired tightness with a PH2 Phillips screwdriver.

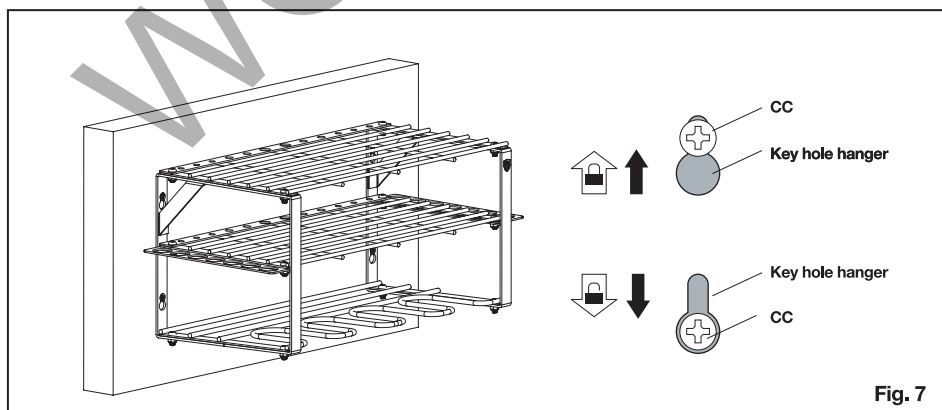
NOTE:

Check organizer installation by verifying it is level, plumb, and secure to the wall.



To unmount the organizer :

- Remove all of the items stored on the organizer.
- With the help of at least one other person, carefully lift the organizer until the screws are inside the wide portions of each keyhole and remove the organizer from the wall.



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Wipe with a dry cloth as needed to remove dust and dirt.
- Avoid contact with corrosive substances like acids, alkaline or similar substances.
