FUNCTION DESCRIPTION

Power On:
Press and hold  3 seconds. The device will prompt "Power On".

Power Off:
Press and hold  3 seconds. The device will prompt "Power Off".

Press  button 1 second to turn on ANC ON/OFF.
The device will prompt "ANC ON/OFF".

WIRELESS PAIRING

1. Power the headphones ON. The device will boot into pairing mode automatically and prompt "The Bluetooth™ device is ready to pair", and the LED indicator will flash BLUE and RED.

2. Set your mobile device to search for wireless devices.
Select "Swissbrand ANC" from the list of found devices.

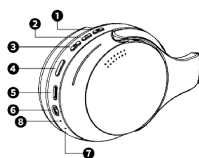
3. After a successful pairing, the device will prompt "Pairing Successful". The LED indicator light will flash BLUE intermittently while connected.

In wireless mode, playback and volume can be adjusted with the on-ear controls or with your paired device.

Press the  and  buttons to skip tracks.

Press and hold the  and  buttons to adjust volume.

PHONE CALLS

To use the phone functions on the headphones, you must be connected to a wireless-enabled device.

1. Press the  button to answer and end phone calls.
In-progress audio playback will automatically pause and resume.

2. Press the  button 2x to dial the last outgoing phone number.

3. Press and hold the  button for 3 seconds to reject an incoming call.

LED LIGHT STATUS

1. Charging status — Long bright red light, when fully charged red light is off

2. Power on — Flash blue then red and blue LED indicator flash alternately

3. Pairing status — Red and blue LED indicator flash alternately

4. Already connected status — Flashing blue light for 3 seconds

5. Play status — LED indicator will flash BLUE intermittently

6. ANC status — ANC ON: LED indicator long bright green light

NOTE

Low battery: the device will prompt "Battery Low".

CHARGING THE HEADPHONES

Plug the small connector of the included charging cable into the charging port on the bottom of the headphones' earcup.
Plug the large connector into a USB power source, such as the USB port on a computer, or a 5V USB wall adapter (not included).

The LED indicator on the headphones will turn RED while charging and turn OFF when finished charging

POWERING ON/OFF

Press and hold the  button for 3 seconds to power the headphones ON and OFF.

When powered on, the headphones may automatically reconnect to a nearby previously-paired device with wireless enabled.

USING THE ACTIVE NOISE CONTROL

The headphones Active Noise Control (noise cancelling) feature reduces unwanted noise from the outside environment. You can use ANC while listening to audio, or use ANC by itself.

Press the  button to turn on Active Noise Control (noise cancelling). The LED indicator light will turn GREEN when ANC is ON.

Press the  button to turn ANC OFF.

OPERATION GUIDE

Answer call —————Short press 

Hang up —————to a call short press  3 seconds

Redial the last phone number —————2x press 

Play/Pause Music —————Short press 

Going to Siri/ assist —————Long press  2 seconds

Volume control to up and down —————Long press  /  2 seconds

Song switch to next & previous track —————Short press  / 

CONNECTING WITH THE 3.5mm AUX CABLE

Plug one connector of the Included 3.5mm auxiliary cable into the 3.5mm aux input port on the bottom of the right earcup. Plug the other connector into the audio output port on your media-playing device.

In auxiliary mode, all playback and volume will be adjusted with the controls on your connected device.

The headphones will automatically power OFF when a 3.5mm AUX cable is inserted.
