KEY OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power Key
Long press this button for 1.5 seconds to power on; Long press for 3 seconds again to power off. Find the Bluetooth name "ANC" in the search list to connect it to your mobile or other Bluetooth device.

+ Key
Long press to skip to next song. Short press to increase volume.

– Key
Long press to previous song. Short press for decrease volume.

Play/Pause Key
Press this button to play/pause the music.

Call
Press the **Play/Pause** button to hang up.
Long press the **Play/Pause** button to reject call.
Quick double press the **Play/Pause** button to redial last number.

You can also use the wired function by using the 3.5 mm jack to connect a mobile device or computer to the headphones.
