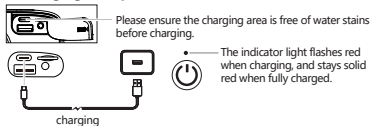
Speaker User Instructions

1. Power On/Off

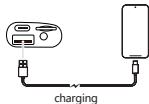


Note :
If there is no audio playback or the volume is set to 0, and no button is pressed during this time, the speaker will automatically power off after 2 hours of inactivity.

3. Power Bank Function



Note :

The power bank function is only available when the speaker is on and working properly. The power bank function will not work when the speaker is turned off.

4. Bluetooth Pairing

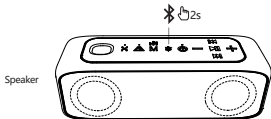


- ① Short press the Bluetooth button, and a prompt "Pairing" will sound, entering Bluetooth pairing mode. The BT indicator light will flash green rapidly.
- ② On the phone, go to Settings - Bluetooth - enable Bluetooth, search for "NOBIS SOUND N1", and tap to connect. Once connected successfully, a prompt "Connected" will sound, and the BT indicator light will stay solid green.

Note :

- This speaker can save up to 6 paired devices in its list. It will automatically connect to the nearest paired device when turned on. If you need to pair a new device, follow the above steps.
- The speaker can only connect to one device at a time.
- To clear the paired device list, press and hold both the Volume Up and Volume Down buttons for 2 seconds. Once completed, the speaker will re-enter pairing mode.

5. TWS Mode



- This speaker supports TWS mode with two devices. In the powered-on state, press and hold the Bluetooth button on both speakers for 2 seconds to enter TWS pairing mode. You will hear a prompt sound "TWS Pairing". After successful pairing, you will hear "TWS Connected" to indicate the TWS mode is successfully paired. After connecting via Bluetooth on your phone or other devices, you can form true wireless stereo sound.
- To exit TWS mode, press and hold the Bluetooth button for 2 seconds while both speakers are connected.

Note :

- After successfully pairing in TWS mode, the next time you use it after powering off, to ensure the correct left and right channels, first power on the speaker placed on the left side. After Bluetooth connects to the phone, the left speaker will become the master, then power on the right speaker to ensure correct channel positioning.
- In TWS mode, the beat mode will be disabled.

6. About the NOBIS GO App

Download the NOBIS GO App for an enhanced product experience.

- View product information.
- Display battery status.
- Remotely control volume and play/pause.
- Remotely control the beat tapping.
- Customize beat mode sound effects.
- Customize EQ settings.
- Set auto power-off time.



You can get the app by scanning the QR code, or by searching "NOBIS GO" in the Google Play Store or Apple App Store.

7. Music Mode

Short press the music mode button to cycle through Bluetooth Mode - MicroSD Card Mode - AUX Mode, with corresponding voice prompts: "Bluetooth Mode" - "MicroSD Card Mode" - "AUX Mode".

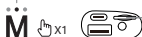
Note :

- In memory card and AUX modes, Bluetooth will automatically disconnect.
- When switching to MicroSD Card mode without a card inserted, the prompt "Please insert the MicroSD Card" will be played.
- When switching to AUX mode without the AUX cable inserted, the prompt "Please insert the Audio Line-in cable" will be played.

In Bluetooth mode, the indicator light will show the BT symbol.



In memory card mode, the indicator light will show the CARD symbol.



Insert a MicroSD card with audio files into the slot on the back of the speaker, and switch to that mode to start playing audio. MP3, WAV, FLAC, and M4A audio formats are supported.

Note : To ensure the memory card is recognized, format it to FAT, FAT32, or exFAT format.

In AUX mode, the indicator light will show the AUX symbol.



Insert one end of the AUX cable into the 3.5mm headphone jack on the back of the speaker and connect the other end to a device with a 3.5mm headphone jack, such as a phone, computer, or music player.

8. Control

Note :

- The button operations for Bluetooth and MicroSD Card modes are as shown above.
- In AUX mode, only volume up and down operations are supported.
- The tapping sound volume can only be adjusted when the device is powered on.

9. Incoming Call Mode

▶▶	 X1	Answer/End Call

	 X2	Multi-Call/Switching

When the speaker is connected to the phone via Bluetooth and there's an incoming call, the speaker will sound a prompt "Master, Someone is calling you". Short press the play button to answer/end the call hands-free; long press the play button for 1 second to reject the call.

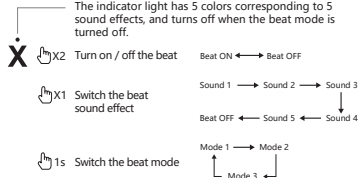
Multi-Party Call

When another call comes in during an ongoing call, you can do the following to answer/end/reject/switch calls:

- Short press the play button to answer the new call hands-free and keep the previous call on hold; press the play button again to end the current call and return to the previous one.
- Long press the play button for 1 second to reject the current incoming call and return to the previous one.
- After answering the new call hands-free with a short press, double-press the play button to freely switch between the two calls.

10. Beat Function

The indicator light has 5 colors corresponding to 5 sound effects, and turns off when the beat mode is turned off.



 Touch After enabling the beat function, touch this button to play the beat sound.

Beat function on/off and beat sound switching.

- Double-click the beat button **X** to turn the beat function on or off.
- By continuously pressing the beat button **X**, you can switch between different beat sounds or turn off the beat function.
- When the beat function is on, touch the beat touch key **O** to play the corresponding sound.
- When music is playing, the beat sound will blend with the music. When no music is playing, the beat sound will play on its own.
- Download the Nobis GO app to add more percussion sounds.

Beat mode switch

- When the beat function is on, press and hold the beat button **X** for 1 second to switch between different beat modes.
- Different beat modes include common music beats such as 2/4, 3/4, 4/4, 3/8, 6/8, etc.

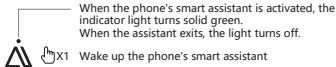
Recommended beat modes are as follows :

Mode No.	Music Beat	Music style
Beat Mode 1	4/4	Latin, Jazz, Hip-hop, Blues, Rock, Pop, Funk, Country, R&B
Beat Mode 2	3/4, 3/8, 6/8, 9/8, 12/8	Waltz, Polka, Mazurka, Minuet, Classical, Jazz (some styles)
Beat Mode 3	2/4	Hip-hop, Electronic Dance Music, Techno, House, Pop, Rock and Roll, Tango, March

Note :

- The above music beats are only suggestions.
- Feel free to experiment and find the mode that best suits your music.
- The beat mode is designed to work with most common music beats, but it may not cover all beats.
- Beat volume can be controlled with the volume buttons.

11. Wake up the phone's AI assistant



- When connected to the phone via Bluetooth, short press the AI button and a prompt will sound, indicating the smart assistant has been activated. If Bluetooth is not connected, pressing the button will result in no response.
- iPhones will activate Siri, while Android or HarmonyOS phones will trigger the built-in smart assistant.
- During a voice interaction, if the phone is in paused recording state, short press the AI button again to continue the conversation via voice input.

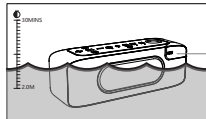
12. Factory Reset

Factory reset clears connected devices and other settings from your speaker and returns it to the original factory setting.

- Press and hold down the beat button for 8 seconds.
- Make sure the speakers is powered on.
- Once the reset is complete, you'll hear "Pairing" from the speaker.

13. IP68 Waterproof and Dustproof

Perfect for taking to the lake, the beach, listening by the pool, listening in the shower.



The rubber flap needs to be closed to keep the speaker waterproof and dustproof.

Important Safety Precaution: When the speaker is plugged into a charging source with the USB-C charging cable, never use the speaker in the shower, bath, or near water to prevent risk of electric shock.

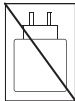
