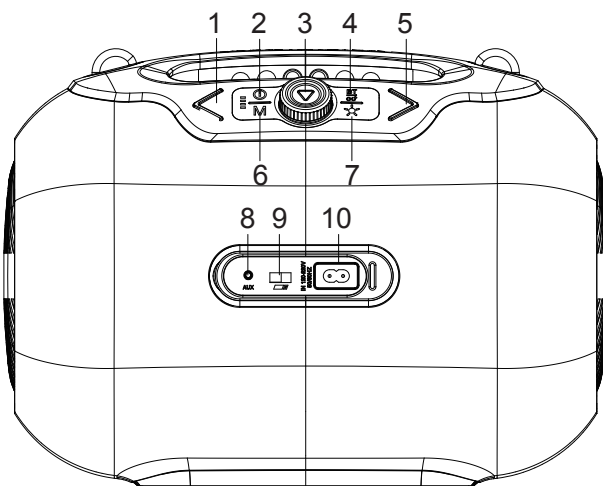


Functional panel diagram



Button function description.

1. > : Press briefly to play the previous song; in FM mode, press briefly to switch to the previous channel.
2.  : Press and hold this button to turn on, press and hold again to turn off.
3.  : Rotate to adjust volume. During music playback, press down to pause, press again to resume.
4.  : In other modes, press briefly to enter BT mode. In

BT mode, press briefly to search for and pair with another speaker in TWS mode. Press and hold to disconnect BT.

5. < : Press briefly to play the next song; in FM mode, press briefly to switch to the next channel.
6. M : When powered on, automatically enters BT mode. Press to cycle through USB-FM-AUX modes, press again to return to BT. In any mode, USB playback takes priority if a USB drive is inserted.
7. ☆ : While playing music, press and hold to cycle through 7 lighting display modes.
8. LINE IN auxiliary port.
9. USB input.

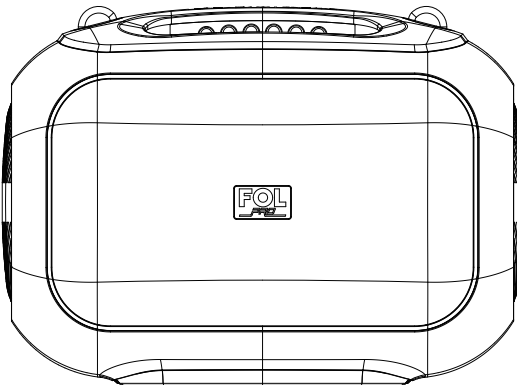
