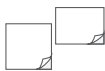

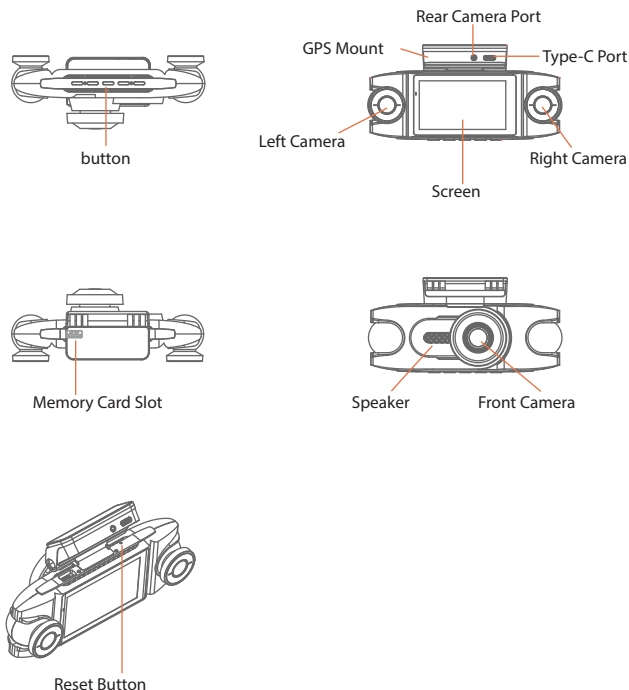

01 Safety Precautions

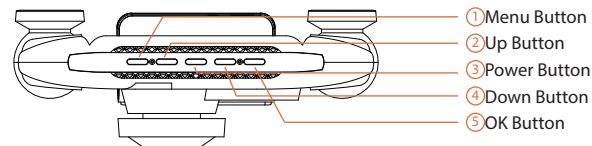
To prevent personal injury or equipment damage, please read and follow the below safety guidelines carefully:

03 Button Functions



- ① Menu Button
 - Press Once - to enter/exit settings menu.
 - Press Once - to go back to the previous screen. (in menu mode)
- ② Up Button
 - Press Once (Recording Interface) - take photo.
 - Press Once (Menu Interface) - move up one line .
 - Press Once (Playback Interface) - previous video.
 - Hold 3s - lock/unlock video. (while recording, indicator turns yellow when locked)
- ③ Power Button
 - Press Once - turn screen off/on. (while device is on)
 - Hold 3s - power off/on. (while device is on)
- ④ Down Button
 - Press Once (Recording Interface) - switch front / rear camera, spit screen mode.
 - Press Once (Menu Interface) - move down one line.
 - Press Once (Playback Interface) - play next video.
 - Hold 3s - turn Wi-Fi on/off. (in recording mode)
- ⑤ OK Button
 - Press Once - Pause/Stop Recording.
 - Press Once - confirm/select. (menu mode)
 - Hold 3s - Microphone on/off. (in recording mode)
