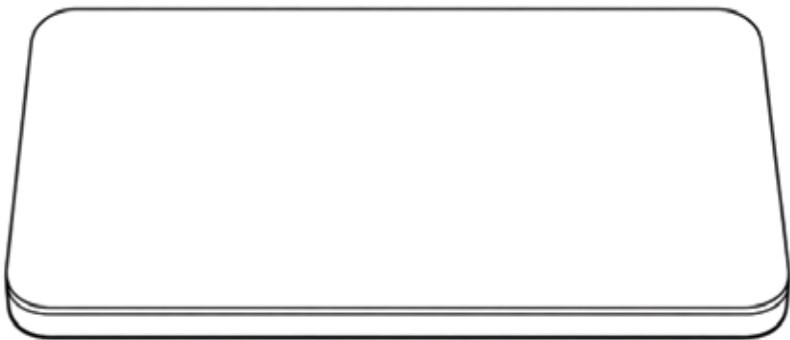

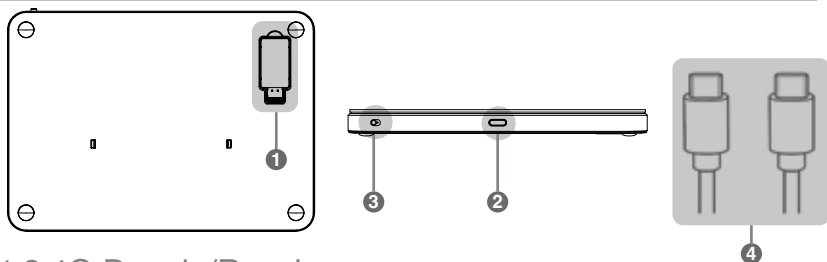

1.2.4G Dongle/Receiver

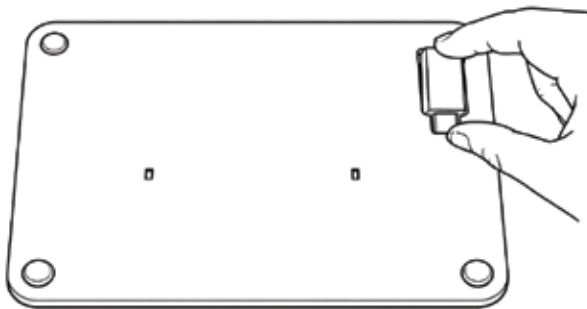
2.USB-C Charging Port

3.On/Off Switch and LED Light

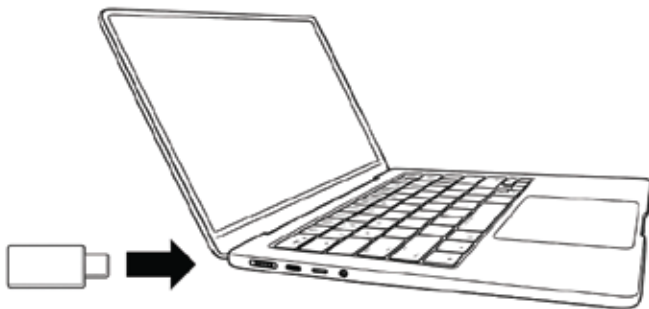
- Turn on – Red LED blinks once, then goes off
- Low Battery – Red LED blinks
- Full Battery – Red LED off

4.USB-C to USB-C Charging Cable

2.4 G Dongle/Receiver Installation



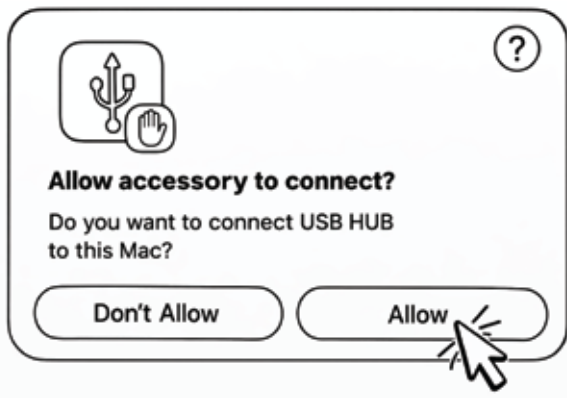
1.Remove the 2.4G Dongle/Receiver from the bottom.



2.Plug the 2.4G Dongle/Receiver into a Mac with a USB-C port.

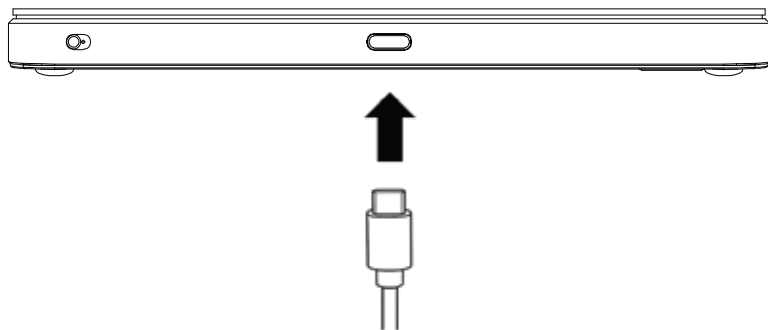


3. Turn the trackpad on.

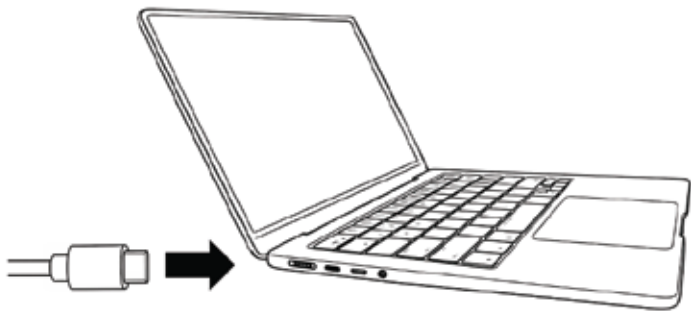


4. Your Mac may ask you to allow an accessory to connect. Make sure you click allow.

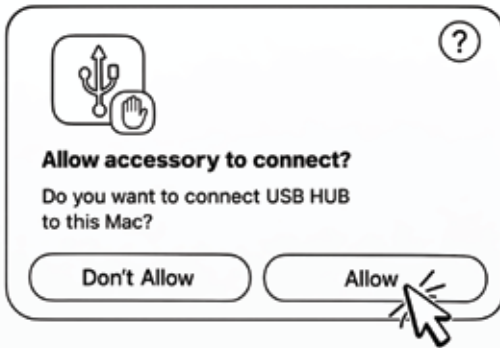
WIRED INSTALLATION



1.Plug one end of the USB-C cable into the track-pad.

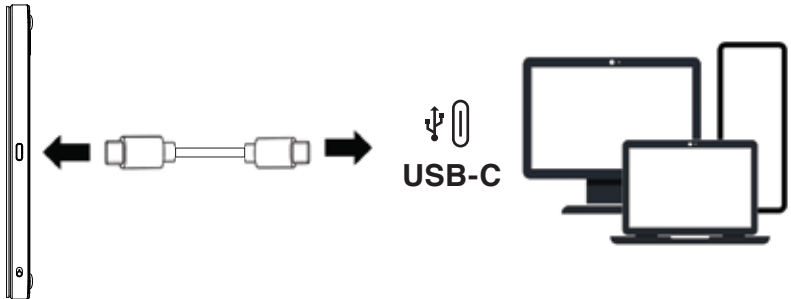


2.Plug the other end of the USB-C cable into your computer.



3.Your Mac may ask you to allow an accessory to connect. Make sure you click allow.

CHARGING THE TRACKPAD

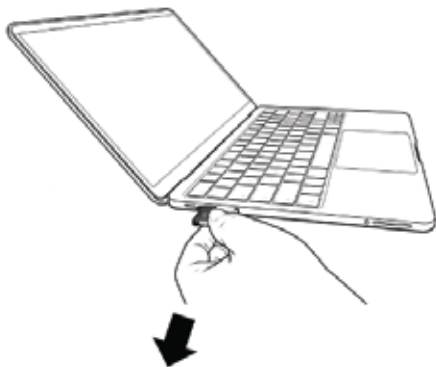


Plug one end of the USB-C cable into the MTOUCH. Then plug the other end of the USB-C cable into your computer or wall adapter to charge.

Charging LED

- Red Light Blinking – Needs Charging
- Red Light Off – Charged

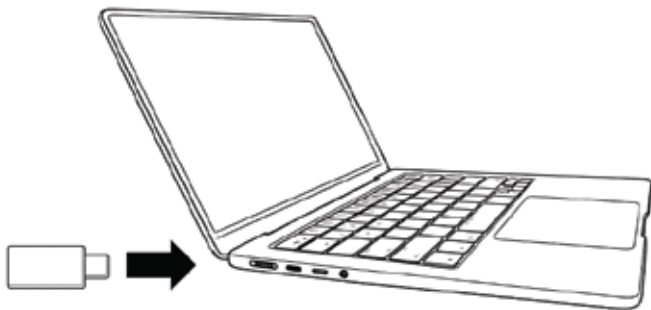
RESYNC THE DONGLE



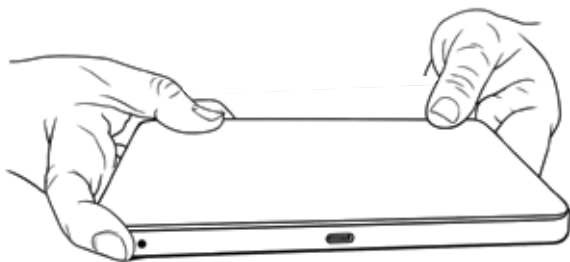
1.Remove the 2.4G dongle/receiver from your Mac.



2.Turn the trackpad off.



3.Plug the 2.4G dongle/receiver into your Mac. Note: You will need to finish step 4 within 5 seconds of finishing step 3.



4.Press both the lower right and left corners and then switch on the trackpad. The trackpad will start the pairing process. (flashing red for a few seconds until it's paired)

GESTURES FOR MAC

Below is a chart showing how you use gestures on a Mac.

Gesture Picture	Gesture Name	Description
	Tap to Click	Tap with one finger to click.
	Secondary click (right-click)	Click or tap with two fingers.
	Smart zoom	Double-tap with two fingers to zoom in and back out of a webpage or PDF.
	Scroll	Slide two fingers up or down to scroll.



Zoom in or out

Pinch with two fingers to zoom in or out.



Rotate

Click or tap with two fingers.



Swipe between pages

Swipe left or right with two fingers to show the previous or next page.



Open Notification Center

Swipe left from the right edge with two fingers to show Notification Center.



Look up and data detectors

Tap with three fingers to look up a word or take actions with dates, addresses, phone numbers, and other data.



Show desktop

Spread your thumb and four fingers apart to show your desktop.



Apps

Pinch your thumb and four fingers together to show your installed apps.



Mission Control

Swipe up with four fingers to open Mission Control.



App Exposé

Swipe down with four fingers to see all windows of the app you're using.



Swipe between full-screen apps

Swipe left or right with four fingers to move between desktops and full-screen apps.
