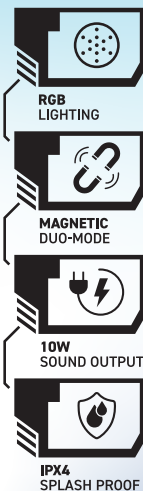
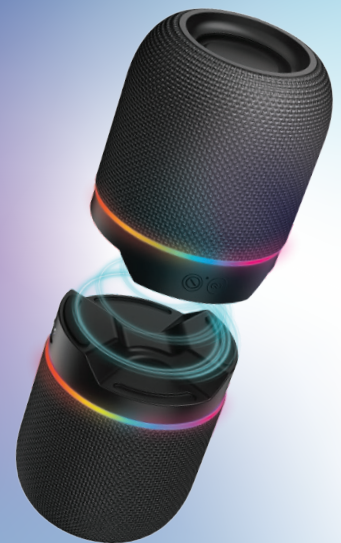

Important Safety Precautions

When using your VIVITAR Magnetic Wireless Speaker, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including:

1. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING YOUR SPEAKER
2. Do not submerge the speaker in water. Do not place the speaker on wet surfaces.
3. Only clean using a clean, soft cloth.
4. Products may contain small pieces that can be a choking hazard. Parental supervision is advised.
5. Do not expose the speaker to excessive heat or fire.
6. Do not expose the speaker to extreme cold or hot temperatures to avoid battery damage.
7. Do not attempt to repair the speaker yourself. Contact a qualified service center if the product is in need of service.
8. Do not drop, crush, or expose the speaker to excessive physical force.
9. Do not charge while the speaker is in contact with water, as electric shock may occur.
10. Unplug charging cable when not in use or during thunderstorms.
11. Do not play music while the speaker is charging.

13. Do not leave your wireless speaker unattended while magnetically attached to any surface.

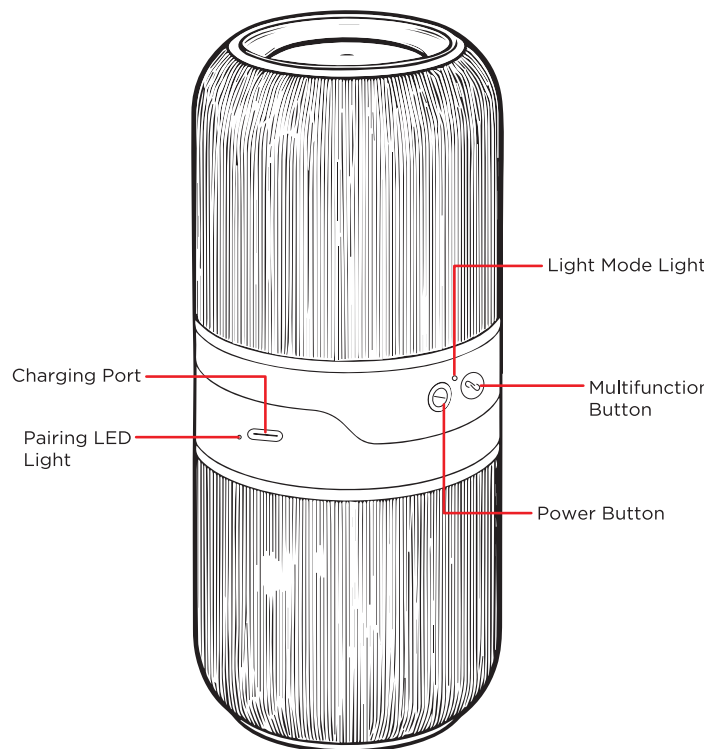

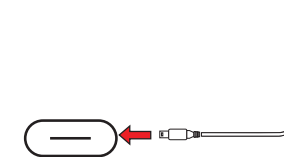

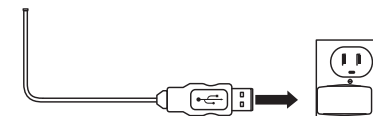


Charging

Insert one end of the included charging cable into the Charging Port of your speakers. Each speaker must be charged separately.



Insert the other end of the charging cable into a suitable USB charging adapter (not included).

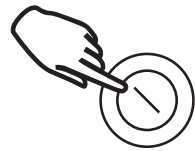

Powering ON/OFF

Press and hold the Power button for two to three seconds to power ON/OFF the speaker.

Press and Hold



Mode Selection

Power ON your speaker. Press the Multifunction button to switch between available audio modes.

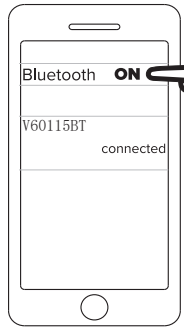

WARNING: While changing audio modes, the sound may be very loud. Please exercise caution while changing audio modes.

Bluetooth Pairing

Once powered ON, set your speaker to Bluetooth mode.



Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone. Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on. Connect to the device listed as “V60115BT”.

NOTE: Disconnect through your connected device or by changing modes.

After successfully pairing, the speaker’s Pairing LED Indicator light will flash blue.

Changing Light Modes

Your speaker has different light modes that can be set. To cycle through the available light modes, press the Multifunction button twice.

Press Twice to Cycle Light Modes.



Speaker’ s Controls

Multifunction Button:

- Press twice to cycle through available light modes.
- Press to cycle through available audio modes.
- Press and hold to pair with another V60115BT speaker.
- While paired with another speaker, press and hold to disconnect.

Power Button:

- Press and hold to power ON/OFF the speaker.
- Press twice to recall the last called number.
- Press to answer an incoming call.
- Press during a call to hangup.
- Press twice to decline an incoming call.
- While in FM Radio Mode, press to scan for radio stations. Press again during scanning to stop at the current station.

Additional Features

TWS Pairing:

TWS Pairing enables the speaker to pair with another V60115BT Magnetic Wireless Speaker to play music in sync.

Power ON both speakers. Press and hold the Multifunction button to turn ON True Wireless Stereo. Enable TWS for both speakers.

When both Speakers are ON and have TWS enabled, they will automatically pair together. When paired, go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone. Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on. Connect to the device listed as ‘V60115BT’.

To unpair the two speakers, press and hold the Multifunction button.

Additional Features (Continued)

Magnetic Base:

The speakers have a magnetic base, enabling them to connect together for easy storage, or to be placed on flat meagnetic surfaces. Before using the magnetic base, inspect and wipe away any dust or grime from the base with a dry towel.

WARNING: Keep the speakers away from any magnetically sensitive devices to avoid damage.

FM Radio:

To listen to music from local radio stations in FM radio mode, set the speaker to the corresponding mode. Press the Power button to scan for available FM stations. Press again to stop at the current selected station.

CAUTION: While in FM Radio mode, the volume may be very loud. Please exercise caution while changing audio modes.
