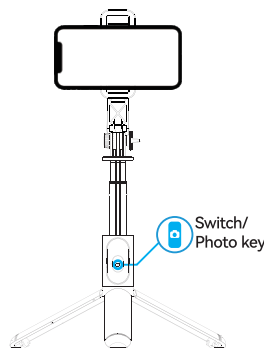

selfie stick Instructions for use

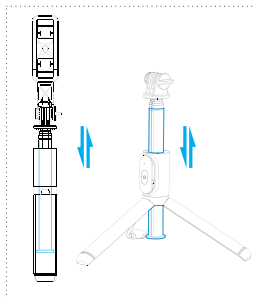

Tripod mode

When switching the selfie stick to tripod mode, be sure to extend the final section of the pole and adjust it until the tripod is stable.

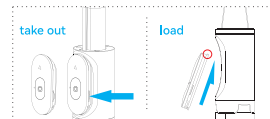


How to Use

- 1. Power On:** Press and hold the shutter button for 3 seconds to turn on.
- 2. Bluetooth Pairing:** The indicator light flashes rapidly for 4 seconds to enter pairing mode. During pairing, the blue indicator light flashes. Use your phone to search for "Selfie" to connect. Once paired successfully, the blue indicator light turns off.
- 3. Taking Photos:** When the selfie stick is connected to your phone, press the shutter button briefly. The blue light flashes.
- 4. No Pairing:** After powering on, the device will automatically shut down after 5 minutes of inactivity when no pairing connection exists.
- 5. Pairing Mode:** After powering on, the device enters sleep mode after 10 minutes of inactivity while connected to a phone. It will automatically shut down after an additional 10 minutes of inactivity in sleep mode.
- 6. Power Off:** In either powered-on or sleep mode, press and hold the shutter button for 3 seconds to power off. The indicator light will flash and then turn off.

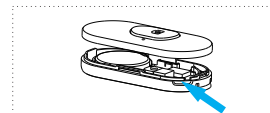

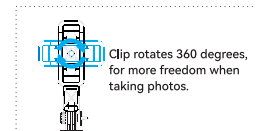

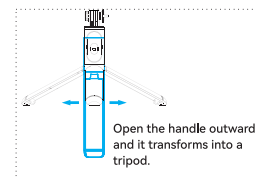
Cut out from the groove on the left Open the remote control cover.
