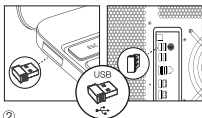
How To Connect

Before using the mouse, peel off the protective film covering the mouse feet on the bottom.

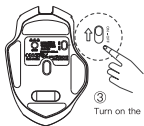
Wireless connections :



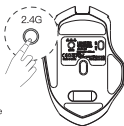
① Remove the receiver



② Insert it into the USB port of your device



③ Turn on the mouse



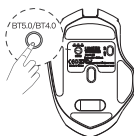
④ Press the MODE button and select 2.4G (red light)



Bluetooth Connection

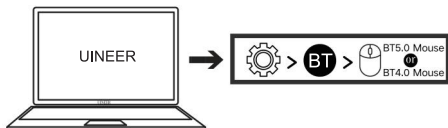


① Turn on the mouse



②

Switch the mouse mode to BT5.0 (indicated by a blue light) or BT4.0 (indicated by a green light) mode.



- ③ Enable the Bluetooth function on your device, search and select the Bluetooth name 'BT5.0 Mouse' or 'BT4.0 Mouse' to connect.

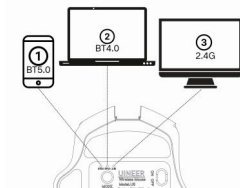
Once connected successfully, the mouse battery indicator light will turn on.

****If the connection is not successful, please repeat steps 2 and 3.**



Switching Between Connected Devices

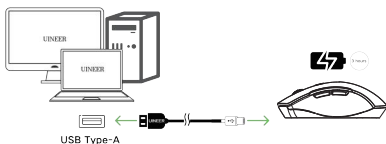
- To switch to the Device ① connected via Bluetooth 5.0 > press the "MODE" button and switch to BT5.0 (blue light).
- To switch to the Device ② connected via Bluetooth 4.0 > press the "MODE" button and switch to BT4.0 (green light).
- To switch to the Device ③ connected via the 2.4GHz receiver: press the "MODE" button and switch to 2.4G (red light).



Notes

Reconnecting: The mouse will automatically reconnect to the last paired device when switched to the corresponding mode.

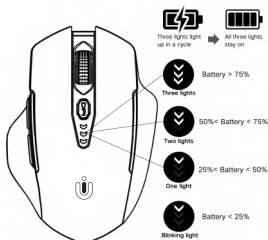
Charging The Mouse



1. Connect one end of the charging cable to the mouse and the other end to the USB-A port of a computer device.
2. For optimal performance, it is recommended to fully charge the mouse before its first use.
3. It takes approximately 3 hours to fully charge a depleted mouse.



Battery Indicator Lights



Charging: Three lights light up in a cycle

Charged: All three lights stay on

Three lights: Battery above 75%

Two lights: Battery between 50% and 75%

One light: Battery between 25% and 50%

Flashing light: Low battery, please charge.

2.4GHzレシーバー経由で接続する方法

1. USBレシーバーを取り外します。
2. デバイスのポートに挿入します。
3. マウスをオンにします。
4. モードを2.4Gモード（赤色のライト）に切り替えます。

Bluetoothモードで接続する方法

1. マウスをオンにします。
2. マウスモードをBT5.0（青色のライト）またはBT4.0（緑色のライト）モードに切り替えます。
3. デバイスでBluetooth機能を有効にし、「BT5.0 Mouse」または「BT4.0 Mouse」というBluetooth名を検索して選択し、接続します。
4. 接続が成功すると、マウスのバッテリーインジケータライトが点灯します。

マウスの充電

1. 充電ケーブルの一端をマウスに、もう一端をコンピュータデバイスのUSB-Aポートに接続します。
2. 最適なパフォーマンスを得るために、初回使用前にマウスを完全に充電することをお勧めします。
3. 完全に放電したマウスを完全に充電するには、約3時間かかります。



Verbinden über 2,4-GHz-Empfänger

1. Entfernen Sie den USB-Empfänger.
2. Stecken Sie ihn in den USB-Anschluss Ihres Geräts.
3. Schalten Sie die Maus ein.
4. Schalten Sie den MODUS auf 2,4G-Modus (rote Lampe).

Verbinden über Bluetooth-Modus

1. Schalten Sie die Maus ein.
2. Schalten Sie den Modus der Maus auf BT5.0 (blaue Lampe) oder BT4.0 (grüne Lampe).
3. Aktivieren Sie die Bluetooth-Funktion auf Ihrem Gerät, suchen Sie nach dem Bluetooth-Namen „BT5.0 Mouse“ oder „BT4.0 Mouse“ und wählen Sie ihn aus, um die Verbindung herzustellen.
4. Sobald die Verbindung erfolgreich hergestellt ist, leuchtet die Batteriestandsanzeige der Maus auf.

Maus aufladen

1. Verbinden Sie ein Ende des Ladekabels mit der Maus und das andere Ende mit dem USB-A-Anschluss eines Computergeräts.
2. Es wird empfohlen, die Maus vor der ersten Verwendung vollständig aufzuladen, um eine optimale Leistung zu erzielen.
3. Es dauert ungefähr 3 Stunden, um eine vollständig entladene Maus vollständig aufzuladen.

Connexion via le récepteur 2,4 GHz

1. Retirez le récepteur USB.
2. Insérez-le dans le port de votre appareil.
3. Allumez la souris.
4. Passez le MODE en mode 2,4G (lumière rouge).

Connexion via le mode Bluetooth

1. Allumez la souris.
2. Passez la souris en mode BT5.0 (indiqué par une lumière bleue) ou BT4.0 (indiqué par une lumière verte).
3. Activez la fonction Bluetooth sur votre appareil, recherchez et sélectionnez le nom Bluetooth « BT5.0 Mouse » ou « BT4.0 Mouse » pour vous connecter.
4. Une fois la connexion réussie, le témoin de charge de la souris s'allume.

Chargement de la souris

1. Connectez une extrémité du câble de charge à la souris et l'autre extrémité au port USB-A d'un appareil informatique.
2. Pour des performances optimales, il est recommandé de charger complètement la souris avant sa première utilisation.
3. Il faut environ 3 heures pour charger complètement une souris déchargée.

Connessione tramite ricevitore a 2,4 GHz

1. Rimuovere il ricevitore USB.
2. Inserirlo nella porta del dispositivo.
3. Accendere il mouse.
4. Passare la modalità a 2,4G (luce rossa).

Connessione tramite modalità Bluetooth

1. Accendere il mouse.
2. Passare la modalità del mouse a BT5.0 (indicata da una luce blu) o BT4.0 (indicata da una luce verde).
3. Abilitare la funzione Bluetooth sul dispositivo, cercare e selezionare il nome Bluetooth "BT5.0 Mouse" o "BT4.0 Mouse" per connettersi.
4. Una volta stabilita la connessione, l'indicatore della batteria del mouse si accenderà.

Ricarica del mouse

1. Collegare un'estremità del cavo di ricarica al mouse e l'altra estremità alla porta USB-A di un dispositivo informatico.
2. Per prestazioni ottimali, si consiglia di caricare completamente il mouse prima del primo utilizzo.
3. Sono necessarie circa 3 ore per caricare completamente un mouse completamente scarico.

Conexión a través de receptor de 2.4GHz

1. Retire el receptor USB.
2. Insértelo en el puerto de su dispositivo.
3. Encienda el ratón.
4. Cambie el MODO a modo 2.4G (luz roja).

Conexión mediante el modo Bluetooth

1. Encienda el ratón.
2. Cambie el modo del ratón a BT5.0 (indicado por una luz azul) o BT4.0 (indicado por una luz verde).
3. Active la función Bluetooth en su dispositivo, busque y seleccione el nombre Bluetooth 'BT5.0 Mouse' o 'BT4.0 Mouse' para conectarse.
4. Una vez que se haya conectado correctamente, la luz indicadora de batería del ratón se encenderá.

Cargar el ratón

1. Conecte un extremo del cable de carga al ratón y el otro extremo al puerto USB-A de un dispositivo informático.
2. Para un rendimiento óptimo, se recomienda cargar completamente el ratón antes de su primer uso.
3. Toma aproximadamente 3 horas cargar completamente un ratón agotado.

Why is the mouse not working?



please check the **follow** steps
1. please charge the mouse
2. Ensure that you **already** select the corresponding connection mode.
3. Ensure the mouse power is turned on.

why my mouse's cursor moving **slowly**?

Try to pressing the DPI button to adjust the pointer speed. we recommended to use a **black fabric** mouse pad to improve tracking.
Tip: While adjusting the **slider**, try moving the pointer to see the effect of the changes.
