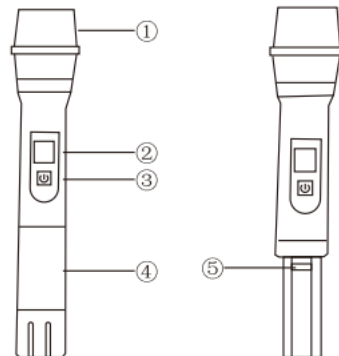

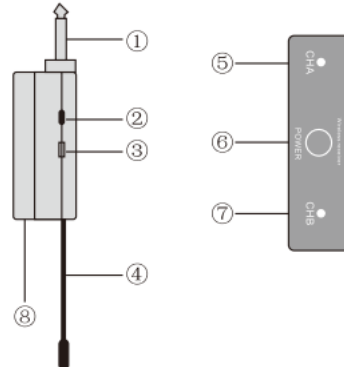

Handheld transmitter function



- ① Nethead: Speak and sing towards this place.
- ② Status display screen: displays the working status and frequency, etc.
- ③ Power switch: Turn on and off the power.
- ④ Battery cover: Unscrew the tailpipe to fit the battery.
- ⑤ Tail cover: At the wireless wave transmission antenna, try not to hold it by hand when using it.

Receiver function



- ① Audio output: 6.35mm male.
- ② Power switch: Push up to turn on, push down to turn off.
- ③ Charging interface: Use a data cable for charging.
- ④ Receiving antenna: Receiving signals from the transmitting end.
- ⑤ Channel A indicator light: When channel A receives a signal, the signal light is on.
- ⑥ Channel B indicator light: When B channel receives a signal, the signal light is on.
- ⑦ Power indicator light: green when the receiver is turned on, red when charging. The red light does not light up when fully charged.
- ⑧ Battery cover: Equipped with 18650 replaceable batteries, open the battery cover and replace it directly.
