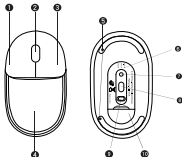

2.4G CONNECTION METHOD

1. Open the receiver cover at the bottom of the mouse, take out the receiver, and turn on the power switch;
2. Click the mode switch button at the bottom of the mouse, and the corresponding indicator light will be red for 2.4G;
3. Insert the receiver into the USB port of the computer;

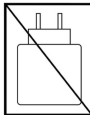
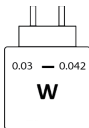
BLUETOOTH CONNECTION METHOD

1. Turn on the power switch;
2. Click the mode switch button at the bottom of the mouse, and the corresponding indicator light will light up (blue light/green light).;
3. Turn on the Bluetooth of your computer or other device, search for or select "BT3.0 Mouse" Or "BT5.2 Mouse", start Bluetooth pairing and complete the connection

Force pairing:

When the mouse is in the Bluetooth channel, long press the bottom mode button for 5 seconds. The BT status light enters the flashing mode. At this point, you can re-enable the device's BT and proceed with the connection
