Important safety information

Thank you for buying this REVOLT item. To ensure that you operate the vehicle correctly, please read these instructions carefully before first use and store them in a safe place for future reference.

Safety information

- *Keep the smaller-sized accessories out of the reach of children.
- *Do not store batteries in a hot environment (e.g. near open flames or a heating device).
- *Children must be supervised by an adult when operating the vehicle. The vehicle should always remain within the line of sight of the driver (or instructor).
- *Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries. When installing or changing the batteries, ensure that they are connected in the correct polarity. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types.
- *Do not short circuit the battery terminals.
- *If you do not plan to use the vehicle for at least 10 days, discharge the battery to 40%-50% (i.e. if the battery is fully charged, drive the vehicle for half of the total driving time). This helps to prolong the lifespan of the battery.
- *You must only use the charging cable provided. Disconnect the charging cable from the vehicle before cleaning.
- *Regularly inspect the charging cable's wires, plug socket, outer casing and other accessories to ensure they are not damaged. If there are any signs of damage, discontinue use immediately until repaired.
- *After use, ensure that the vehicle and remote control are switched off and remove the batteries in the remote control.
- *The packaging and this manual contain important information and should be kept in a safe place for future reference.

Repair and maintenance

- *Clean the product regularly with a clean, soft cloth.
- *Avoid exposing the product to direct sunlight or heat.
- *Although this product is designed to drive on water, do not submerge the product in water, as it may damage the electronic components.
- *Water may enter the product during play and should be dried thoroughly afterward.

Battery Installation

Remote control

1. Remove the battery cover on the remote control and load the AA batteries into the battery compartment according to the indicated polarity.
2. Replace the battery cover.



2x1.5V "AA"

Battery Installation

RC Truck

1. Open the battery compartment cover at the base of the truck.
2. Disconnect the cable between the truck and battery.
3. Connect the charging cable with the battery's cable for charging.
4. Once the battery is fully charged, disconnect the charging cable, reconnect the battery cable and truck's cable.
5. Tighten the battery compartment cover back in place and tighten the screw.



Battery Charging Tips:



1. The new battery pack needs to be charged before first use.
2. Insert the plug of the battery pack to the port of the USB charging cable, and connect the USB charging cable to a power source.
3. The indicator light is "red" when charging, and "off" when fully charged. Do not overcharge.
4. Check the RC Truck, battery, charging cable, plugs and other parts regularly.

Charging for too long will not increase the battery capacity.

Powering Down:

1. When play has ended, turn off the power of the remote control first, then turn off the power of the truck.
2. It is recommended to remove the batteries from the remote control after play.

This device and its antenna(s) must not be co-located or operation in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter.
