Charge and activate

Please connect the charging cable and activate the watch for the first use. When the watch battery is at the low level, it may take 3-5 minutes to wake up, which is normal. Please wait 5 minutes and check the charging status again. Please use a charger with a rated output power of 5V and a rated output current of 0.5A-2A or a computer USB port to charge the watch.

Go to the "Device" interface and click "Add Device!"



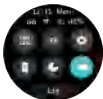
Select the corresponding device from the scanning list.

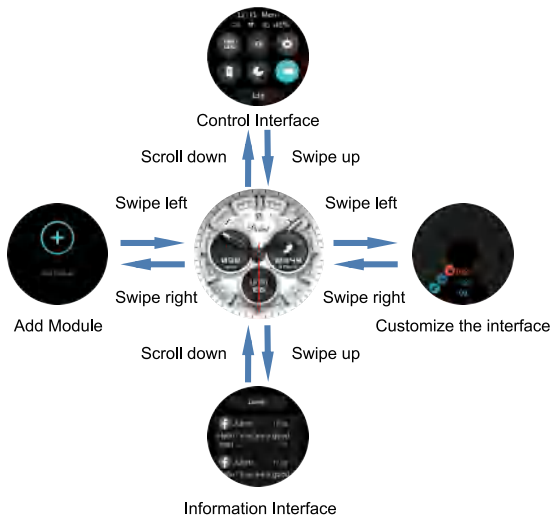


Bluetooth not connected.

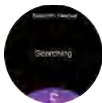

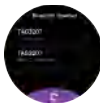


Location in motion.

Unbinding via App

"iOS: In the app's 'Device' interface, find 'Unbind'. After clicking 'Unbind,' go to your phone's 'Settings - Bluetooth' interface, click the 'i' icon to the right of the device, and then select 'Forget This Device.' This will unbind the device from your phone's system, ensuring it's no longer connected. Otherwise, you won't be able to reconnect next time. Android: In the app's 'Device' interface, find 'Unbind' and click 'Unbind' to disconnect from your phone."

Precautions

1. Do not wear the watch in hot showers or saunas to prevent steam intrusion.
Damage caused by water ingress due to improper use is not within the warranty.
2. Do not place the device near heat sources or exposed fire sources, such as induction cookers, microwave ovens, ovens, water heaters, stoves, candles, or other places that may generate high temperatures.
3. This device has a non-removable built-in battery. Do not replace the battery personally.
4. Please wipe the water off the watch immediately after washing hand or found any water on the watch. Water inside the speaker cavity may affect the sound quality. Check the speaker outlet and promptly wipe any remaining water from the speaker outlet.
5. If the watch malfunctions, dead, or becomes unresponsive, press and hold the power button for 10 seconds. The device will force into restart, which restoring normal operation.
6. After restoring factory settings, the data will be cleared, and the watch will need to be reconnected.
