Keyboard Operation Instructions

1. Insert two AAA batteries, slide the power switch to ON, and the keyboard will enter pairing broadcast mode.
2. Enable Bluetooth on your device and locate the Bluetooth name starting with BTKB. Pairing must be completed within 60 seconds; the keyboard is ready for use once paired successfully.

Switching Paired Devices

1. With the keyboard powered on, long press FN + 1 to activate broadcast mode. Complete pairing with your target device within 60 seconds, then start using the keyboard after successful connection.

This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.
