


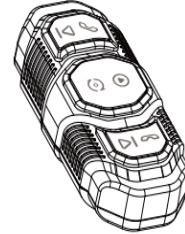


04 Bluetooth Remote Instructions

1. Pairing Mode: Press and hold the leftmost and rightmost buttons simultaneously to enter pairing mode. The LED will flash red and blue alternately 5 times.
2. Battery Status: Blue light if battery > 2.85V; Red light if battery < 2.85V.
