

Tablet User Manual

Notice

This manual contains important safety precautions and information for proper product use. To avoid accidents, please read this manual carefully before using the device.

- Do not use the device in high-temperature, humid, or dusty environments.
- Do not leave the device in high-temperature places. Especially in summer, **do not place the device inside a closed car**.
- Avoid dropping the device or subjecting it to severe impact. Do not shake the TFT display violently, as this may cause malfunction or permanent damage to the screen.
- Set an appropriate volume. Do not use headphones at excessively high volume. If you experience tinnitus, turn down the volume or stop using the device immediately.

Charge the device in the following situations:

1. The battery icon shows empty power and the system shuts down automatically;
 2. The device fails to restart after power-off and the operation buttons do not respond;
 3. A red icon appears in the upper right corner of the screen.
- Do not disconnect the connection abruptly while the device is formatting, uploading, or downloading files—this may cause application errors.
 - The company assumes no liability for memory data loss caused by product damage, maintenance, or other reasons. Operate and use the device strictly in accordance with this user manual.
 - Do not disassemble the product. Do not clean the device with alcohol, thinner, or benzene.
 - Do not use the device in areas where electronic devices are prohibited (e.g., on an airplane).
 - Do not use the tablet while driving or walking on the street.
 - The USB port is only for data transmission.

1. Power On / Power Off

Power On

Press the power button of the tablet (usually located on the side or back of the device). After startup, the system boot screen will appear.

Power Off

- On the system interface: Tap the **Settings** icon at the top of the screen and select the **Power Off** option.
 - For some brands: Long press the power button to force shut down the device.

Wi-Fi Connection

1. Go to the system **Settings** menu.
2. Select the desired wireless network.
3. Enter the correct password to connect.

Data Cable Connection

3. Install & Uninstall Applications

Install Apps

1. Open the app store on the tablet.
2. Search for the required application.
3. Download and install it on your device.

Uninstall Apps

1. Access the **Application Manager** in Settings.
 2. Locate the target application.
 3. Select the **Uninstall** option.

4. Tips & Precautions

1. **Quick App Launch:** On the home screen or app list, long press an app icon and drag it to the desktop to create a shortcut for quick access.
2. **Voice Input for Text Editing:** Use the tablet's voice recognition function to edit text without manual typing, improving work efficiency.
3. **Privacy Protection:**
 - Keep the screen away from strangers to prevent sensitive information leakage.
 - Regularly clear browsing history and cache files.
1. **Keep Updated:** Regularly check and install operating system and application updates to maintain optimal performance and security.
2. **Proper Charging:**
 - Use the original charger as recommended by the manufacturer.
 - Avoid overcharging to prevent shortening battery life.
1. **Data Backup:**
 - Back up data regularly to avoid loss from accidental damage or device failure.
 - Use cloud storage or external hard drives for backup.
1. **Safe Use of Public Wi-Fi:**
 - Avoid sensitive operations (e.g., online banking, account login) when using public Wi-Fi.
 - Use a VPN to enhance network security.
1. **Master Shortcut Keys:** Learn common shortcuts (e.g., copy, paste, undo) to improve operating efficiency.
2. **Adjust Display Settings:** Modify screen brightness, contrast, and color temperature according to ambient light and eyesight needs to reduce eye strain.
3. **Regular Restart:** Restart the tablet periodically to clear memory and cache, improving performance and stability.
4. **Avoid Damage:** The tablet is fragile—prevent drops or impacts to avoid screen cracking or internal component damage.
