1. Product Introduction

The Talkie One earphone jack requires connection to the HFit pro app to access its features. To fully utilize its advanced AI capabilities, we recommend downloading and installing the HFit pro app first, then following the instructions to connect and configure your device.

The main functions of the Talkie One headphone jack include: AI robot, music, volume, TikTok, translation, equalizer, headphone search, photography, voice assistant, games, brightness adjustment, phone, etc., helping users efficiently handle various application scenarios.

2. Software Specifications

Match the headphone jack app version number and update it according to the app store version

3. System Requirements

Download the HFit Pro app from the App Store or in-app store, version XXXX or later

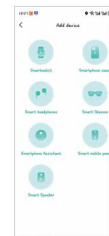
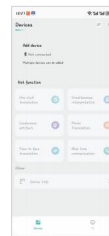
4. Device Binding and Unbinding

(1). Device binding

- Open HFit Pro and sign in
- Select the home or device page, click Add Device, and choose Scan or Add Device
- Enable Bluetooth manually before searching. If Bluetooth is not enabled, prompt the user to turn it on.
- Find the chat interface, then click to display the QR code for connection. If the code is not scanned, scan it again.



- Before connecting, ensure no other phones are connected (the process is the same for both Android and iOS devices).

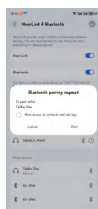
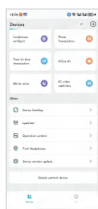


(2). Unbind device

- Android phone: Open the Wearfit Pro device page, tap Delete Device, and confirm to unpair the device. The phone will automatically disconnect via Bluetooth.
- iOS device: Open the Wearfit Pro homepage or device page, tap 'Delete Device' to unpair. The phone's Bluetooth won't automatically disconnect. You must manually turn off FT36 RPO in the phone's Bluetooth settings. Ignore this setting.

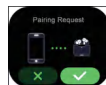
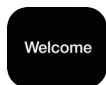
5. Charging Case Power Brtton

- click
 - Primary key click: On/Off screen
 - Click the menu to return to the desktop
 - Click the function interface to return to the desktop
- double click
 - Double-click the primary key to enter the AI robot
- Long press
 - Long press 3 seconds: Power off, restart, or swipe to open the prompt
 - Long press 8 seconds: Force reset
- strike out
 - Triple-click primary key: Pair headphones with warehouse



6. Charging Case Operation

- 1. Device initialization (connecting the earphone jack to the phone)
- 2. Download and install the Wearfit Pro app on your phone
- 3. Device connection process: Power on the device → Set up voice → Pair the device



2. Basic Functions

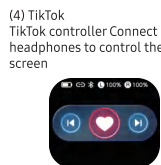
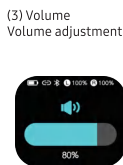
(1) AI robots

Supports casual chat, online queries, weather checks, storytelling or jokes, reasoning, creation, translation, and memory history queries



(2) Music

Play music synchronously on your phone. Support previous track, next track, pause/play music

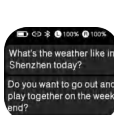


(3) Volume
Volume adjustment

TikTok controller Connect headphones to control the screen

After connecting the headphones, the operation supports standard, rock, pop, classic, and jazz modes.



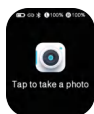
(7) Find headphones

2 built-in mini-games: Dice Roll and Cup Battle



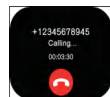
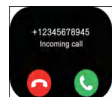
(11) Brightness adjustment

7. Earphone Controls Chattr

No.	function	state	Action description
1	starting up	When charging or shutting down	Long press 2 seconds to remove the headphones
2	shut down	When starting	Long press 5 seconds to charge
3	Mute	While playing the song	Double-click the right ear
4	Increase volume	While playing the song	Double-click the left ear
5	Play/Pause	While playing the song	Click on the left or right ear
6	Answer/End	Incoming call / On call / Incoming call	Click on the left or right ear
7	Do not answer calls	When calling	Hold down the left or right ear for 2 seconds
8	Siri	Standby or playing	3 Strike the right ear
9	Call back	Standby or playing	3 Strike the left ear
10	Next track	While playing the song	Press and hold for 1.5 seconds on the right ear
11	Previous track	While playing the song	Long press the left ear for 1.5 seconds
