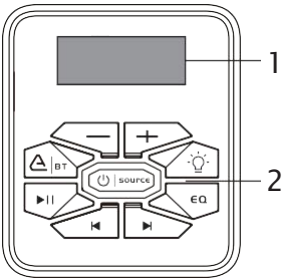
VERY IMPORTANT

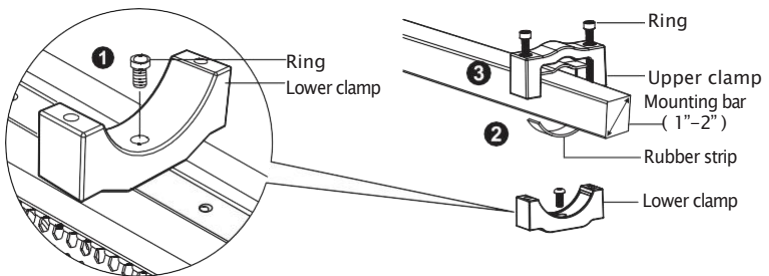

INSTALLATION

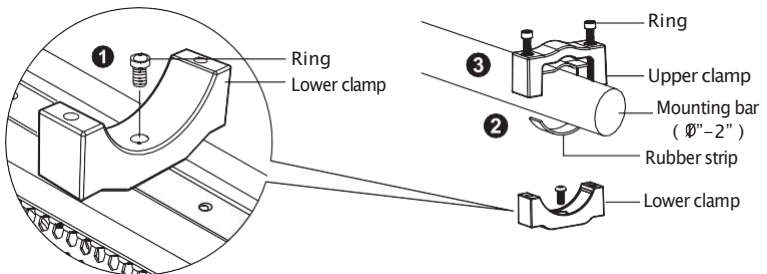
- **USE THE SUPPLIED ADJUSTABLE BRACKET TO SECURE TO RAILS.**
- **ALWAYS RECHECK BRACKET BEFORE EVERY RIDE.**

- 1 Adjust the installation bracket to the slot above the host and tighten it with a hex screw.
- 2 Attach the supplied rubber pads for secure clamping and abrasion prevention.
- 3 Tighten the upper clamp to the lower clamp with a hex wrench. Make sure the supplied spring washers are used to provide more stable bolt tightening against vibration.
- 4 Repeat the steps above to secure the sound bar with the other clamp.

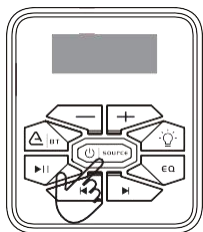
a. Square Tube

POWER ON/OFF

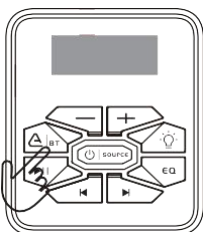


1. Power On: Long press "  " button 2.5s to turn on.
2. Power Off: Long press "  " button 2s to turn off.
3. In the power on state, short press the "  " button to switch between BT→Aux in→USB→BT modes.

BLUETOOTH OPERATION

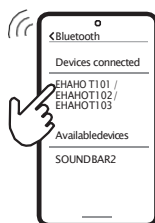
PAIRING / DISCOVERING A NEW BT CONNECTION

Press the "  " button. The **SOUND BAR** will automatically go into pairing



MOBILE OPERATION

- a. Go into the **Settings Menu** of your device
- b. Enter the **BT Menu**
- c. **TURN ON BT** and press **SCAN**
- d. **EHAHOT101/EHAHOT102/EHAHOT103** will now be displayed under **AVAILABLE DEVICES**



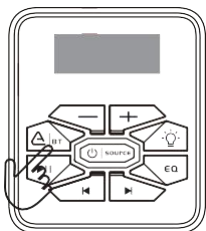
NOTE: You have 2 minutes before you must restart this procedure over again.

2. If **EHAHOT101/EHAHOT102/EHAHOT103** is not seen, repeat the above steps to refresh the **Device List**
3. When the connection is successful, you are now ready to stream music from your favorite media player to the **SOUND BAR**.

BLUETOOTH OPERATION

RECONNECTION

1. Power on the **SOUND BAR** and your last paired BT device.
2. Press the "  " button. The unit will now automatically reconnect.



3. If your device was previously paired with the **SOUND BAR**, but it wasn't the last paired device:
 - a. Ensure no other devices are currently paired
 - b. Enter the PIN on your device being paired
 - c. **EHAHO T101 / EHAHO 102 / EHAHO 103** will display under AVAILABLE DEVICES
 - d. Choose the **SOUND BAR** to reconnect
4. If the device is out of range from the **SOUND BAR**, it will disconnect automatically:
 - a. The **SOUND BAR** will automatically reconnect to the device once back in range.
5. BT function can only be connected to a **SOUND BAR**, does not support multiple **SOUND BAR** connection at the same time.

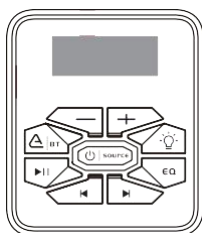
AURACAST OPERATION

PAIRING / CONNECTED / DISCONNECTED

When the device is powered on:

- * Single click the "  " button; hear a DI beep to enter Auracast pairing mode.
- * Single click the "  " button; hear a DUDU beep to disconnect the Auracast connection.
- * Long press the "  " button to clear pairing records and re-enter pairing mode.
(The display screen simultaneously shows the connection status.)

BUTTON OPERATION



1. Press the "  " button once to start playing music or pause the music.
2. In BT source to select the previous song, press the "  " button or use your device's controls.
3. In BT source to skip songs or advance, press the "  " button or use your device's controls.
4. To raise the volume, press the "  " button or use your device's controls.
5. To lower the volume, press the "  " button or use your device's controls.
6. Press "  " button to select lighting mode
Long press 2s "  " button to turn on / off the lighting
Single click the light button to switch lighting modes; 4 modes cycle:
L01: Flow → L02: Breathing → L03: Rhythm → L04: Gradient → L01: Flow (cycle).
7. Single click the "  " button to switch EQ modes; 3 modes cycle:
CLAS: Classic → BASS: Bass → VOCA: Vocal → CLAS: Classic (cycle).



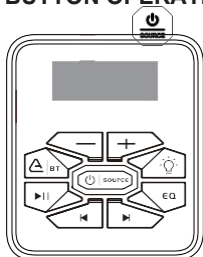
TIPS: For maximum audio performance, ensure your device BT volume is set to a minimum 75% level before stowing.

AUX INPUT

AUX-IN Operation

1. Connect the **3.5mm AUX** audio cable to the device's **AUX-IN** jack.
2. Press the " " button. Switch **SOUNDBAR** to **AUX** mode. player with 3.5mm audio jack output

BUTTON OPERATION

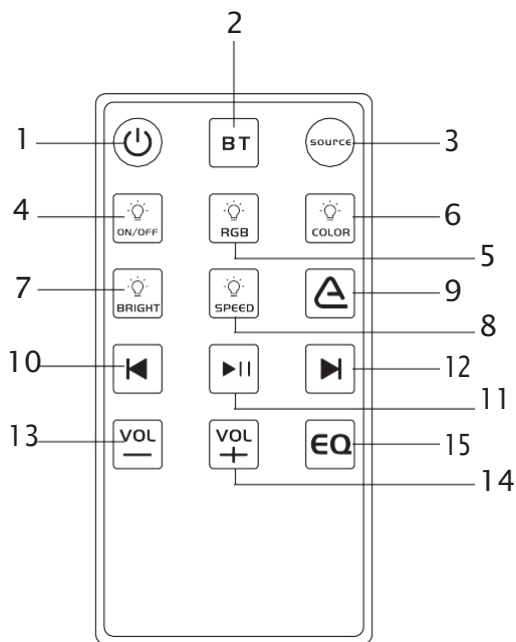


1. To raise the volume, press the **VOLUME UP** button.
2. To lower the volume, press the **VOLUME DOWN** button.

TIPS: Sound bar can play audio from any device that has a 3.5mm headphone audio jack.

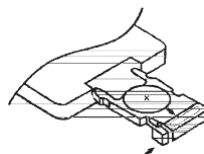

- 3) Do not store in direct sunlight

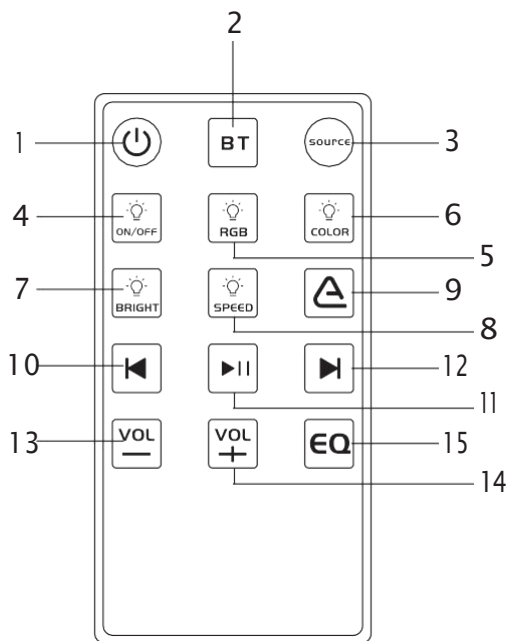

REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION



Function Introduction

1. Power off : Single-click switch (fade in/out)
2. Bluetooth : Single click to clear pairing; flashing indicates re-entering pairing mode.
3. Source: Single click to switch playback source: BT → Aux in → USB → BT (cycle).
4. Light switch: Press once to turn on all lights; press again to turn off all lights.
5. RGB lighting mode switch: Single click to switch RGB lighting effects.
6. Single-color light switch: Press once to switch to the next color; seven colors in total: Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Cyan, Blue, Purple.
7. Brightness cycle: Single click to cycle through High, Medium, and Low.
8. Speed cycle: Single click to switch among 5 speed levels.
9. Auracast/BT: Single click to enter/exit broadcast mode.
10. Previous track: Single click for Previous Track.
11. Next track : Single click to Play/Pause.
12. Play/Pause : Single click for Next Track.
13. Volume + : Single click to increase volume.
14. Volume - : Single click to decrease volume.
15. EQ: EQ: Classic → Bass → Vocal → Classic (cycle).

TROUBLE SHOOTING

TROUBLE	CAUSE	SOLUTION
Device will not turn on	The fuse is blown	Check / replace the fuse
	Vehicle didn't start Main acc switch not engaged	Starting the vehicle / Turn switch to on position
	Operating voltage not applicable	The soundbar operates on 12V DC. The soundbar does not work properly when the voltage is below 8V DC or above 18V DC.
No sound is heard	Incorrect operating voltage	Check the operating voltage, DC 12V
	Soundbar volume is low muted	Turn up the volume on your device
	The volume of the device inputting music to the Soundbar is too low muted.	Turn up the volume of the input device
	BT/AUX are not connected properly	Check if the soundbar control panel is successfully connected to the device (BT, AUX IN)
Cannot pair BT	The BT function of the device is not enabled	Refer to the user manual of the device for how to enable the BT function
Device not responding	Power failure or interference	Press power and vol+ buttons simultaneously to force shutdown

Q1: Will this sound bar fit my vehicle?

Mounting with Universal Brackets, fits any off-road vehicle with a 1" ~ 2" roll cage, including UTV, ATV, golf cart, Marine, Boat, Polaris RZR, Ranger, Can-Am, Defender, Maverick, etc.

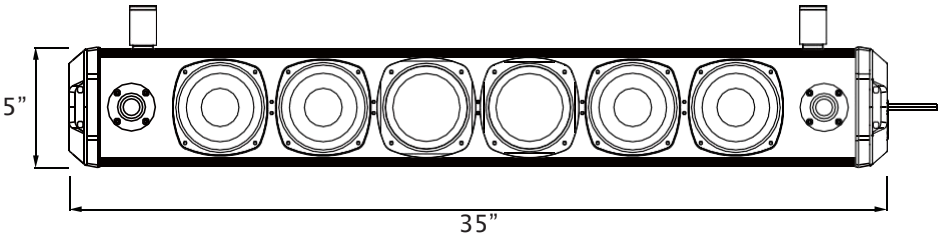
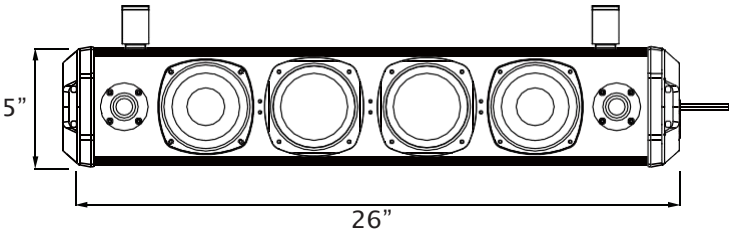
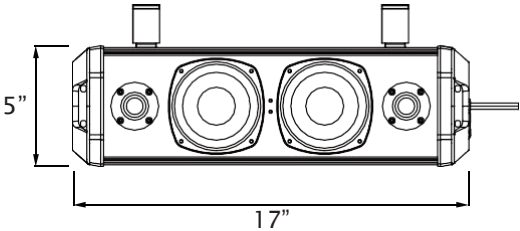
Q2: Is it plugged in? Or run off a charge?

This soundbar is NOT rechargeable. It needs to be hardwired straight to the battery via the 12VDC converter (included in the package).

Q3: Can I turn the led lights off while listening to music?

Yes, RGB light can be turned off at any time by remote control, press "  " button to turn off the light.
