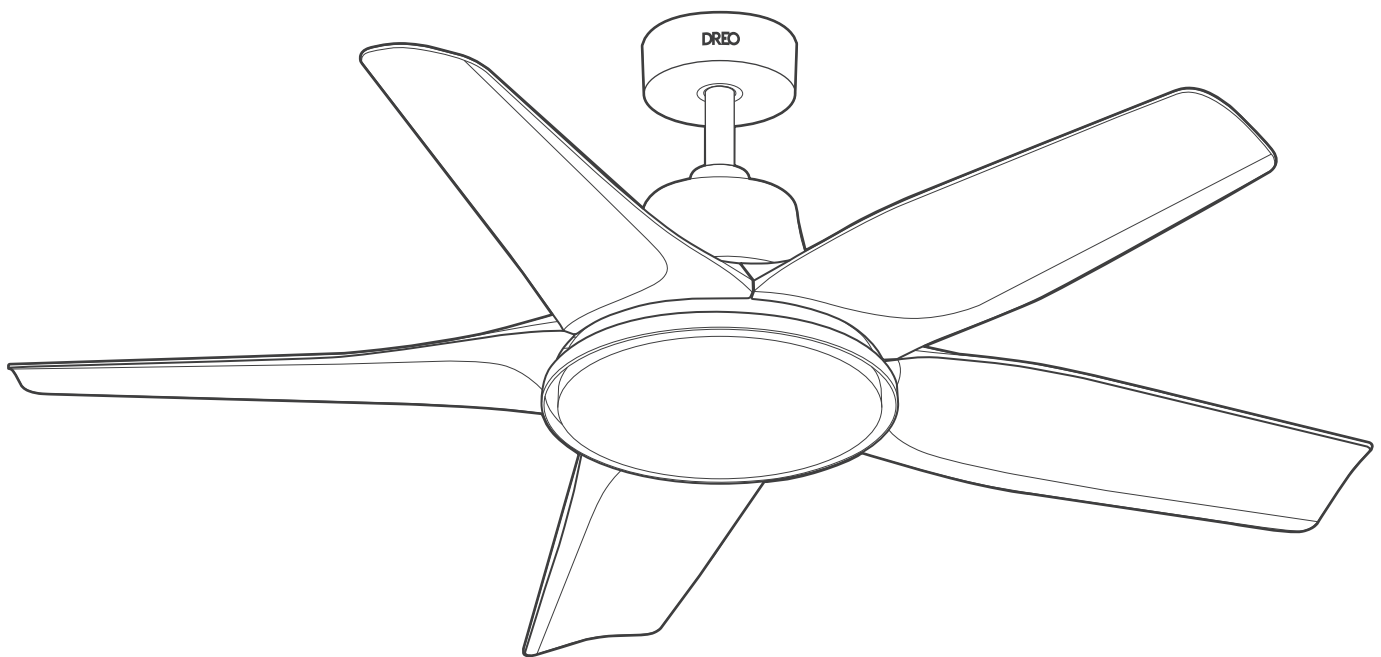

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IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS READ ALL CAUTIONARY MARKINGS ON THE APPLIANCE AND SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS IN THE USER MANUAL BEFORE USE. FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY

- WARNING:** To Reduce The Risk Of Fire, Electric Shock, Or Personal Injury, Mount Directly To A Structural Framing Member Or To An Outlet Box Marked Acceptable for Fan Support of 15.9 kg (35 lbs). For Outlet Box Mounting, Use Mounting Screws Provided With The Outlet Box.
- To avoid possible electrical shock, before installing or servicing your fan, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breakers to the outlet box and associated wall switch location. If you cannot lock the circuit breakers in the off position, securely fasten a prominent warning device, such as a tag, to the service panel.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, this fan must be installed with an isolating wall control/switch.
- WARNING:** To reduce the risk of personal injury, do not bend the blade brackets when installing the blade brackets, balancing the blades, or cleaning the fan. Do not insert foreign objects in between rotating fan blades.
- Chemical burn hazard. Keep batteries away from children. This remote contains a lithium button cell battery. If a new or used lithium button/coin cell battery is swallowed or enters the body, it can cause severe internal burns and can lead to death in as little as 2 hours. Always completely secure the battery compartment. If the battery compartment does not close securely, stop using the product, remove the batteries, and keep it away from children. If you think batteries might have been swallowed or placed inside any part of the body, seek immediate medical attention. Dispose of cells properly and keep away from children. Even used cells may cause injury.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the product.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision. It is recommended that children be supervised to ensure that they are not using the appliance improperly.
- WARNING:** To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock or injury to persons, do not use replacement parts that have not been recommended by the manufacturer (e.g. parts made at home using a 3D printer).
- Read all instructions and safety information before installing your new fan. Review the accompanying assembly diagrams.
- Before installing the fan, disconnect the power by removing fuses or turning off circuit breakers.
- Make sure all electrical connections comply with local law and the national electrical code. Please hire a qualified electrician or consult a do-it-yourself wiring handbook if you are unfamiliar with installing electrical wiring.
- Make sure the installation site is roomy enough to allow fan blades to rotate. There are at least seven feet from the floor to fan blades' tips.
- If you are mounting the fan on a ceiling outlet box, please use a metal outlet box. Secure the box directly to the building structure. The outlet box and its support must be able to support the rotating fan (at least 15.9 kg (35 lbs)). Do not use a plastic outlet box. Attach the mounting bracket using the ceiling outlet box's hardware.
- After installing the fan, make sure all the connections are secured so that the fan won't fall.
- Do not insert anything between fan blades while the fan is operating.
- Turn the fan off and wait for it to stop before reversing fan's rotating direction.
- WARNING:** To reduce the risk of electrical shock and personal injury, do not install the fan on a sloped ceiling, and do not use this fan with any solid-state fan speed control device, or rheostat. You must install the outlet box using the two steel screws and lock washers coming with the fan.
- All wiring must be in accordance with national and local electrical codes ANSI/NFPA 70. If you are unfamiliar with wiring, use a qualified electrician.
- After making the wire connections, the wires should be spread apart with the grounded conductor and the equipment-grounding conductor on one side of the outlet box and the ungrounded conductor on the other side of the outlet box.
- The splices after being made should be turned upward and pushed carefully up into the outlet box.
- Instructions for supply connections: the white conductor of a fan identified as grounded conductor to be connected to a grounded conductor of power supply, the black conductor of fan identified as ungrounded conductor to be connected to an ungrounded conductor of power supply, the green conductor of fan identified for equipment grounding to be connected to an equipment-grounding conductor.
- The total weight of the fan install to outlet box is 6.9 kg (15.2 lbs), check that the outlet box is securely installed in place such that it is able to support at least the fan weight.
- When mounted directly to the building structure, appliance installation shall not expose combustible material and do not install the appliance to a ceiling with combustible finish. The installation of the appliance cannot leave the wood of the rafters or any thermal insulation exposed to the interior of the room.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, disconnect the electrical supply circuit to the fan before installing light kit.
- WARNING:** If unusual oscillating movement is observed, immediately stop using the ceiling fan and contact the manufacturer, its service agent or suitably qualified persons.
- The fixing means for attachment to the ceiling such as hooks or other devices shall be fixed with a sufficient strength to withstand 6 times the weight of the ceiling fan; The mounting of the suspension system shall be performed by the manufacturer, its service agent or suitably qualified persons.
- WARNING:** Maintenance this product should only be carried out by professionals.

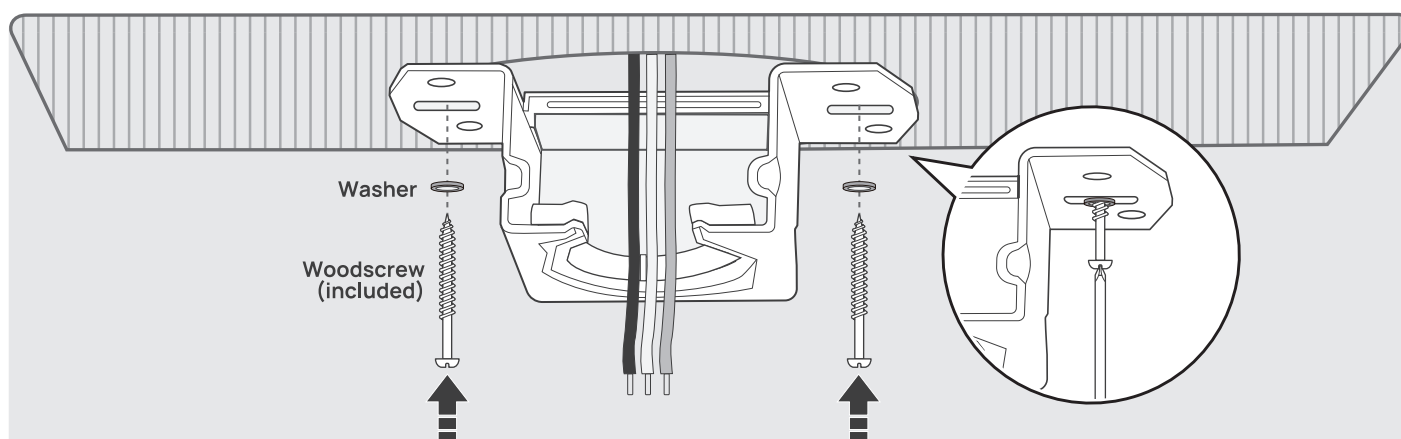
Option 1:

Use machine screws (provided with outlet box) when:
Securing to existing ceiling fan-rated outlet box.

Make sure it is securely installed and is acceptable for fan support of 15.9 kg (35 lbs) or less.



Note: Machine screws are not included in the shipped package, they are typically provided with your outlet box.



Option 2 :

Use wood screws and washers when:

Securing to support structure with approved electrical outlet box.

Drill 9/64" pilot holes in Support Structure to aid in securing ceiling bracket.

ASSEMBLING THE DOWNROD

WARNING: FAN FALL HAZARD

To prevent SERIOUS INJURY or DEATH:

- ALWAYS tighten setscrew with screwdrivers.
- DO NOT hand tighten setscrew.
- CHECK the setscrew is tight using screwdrivers each time you change fan direction.

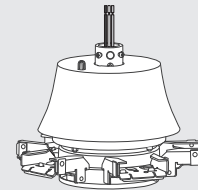

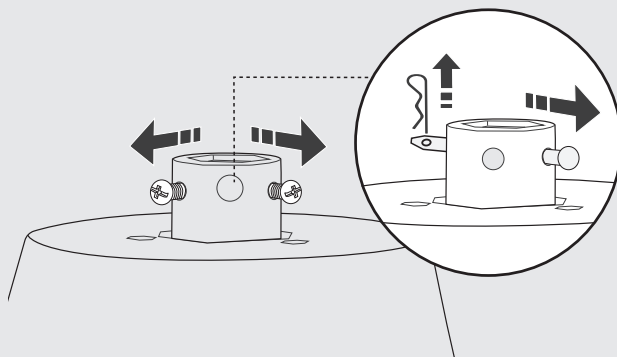

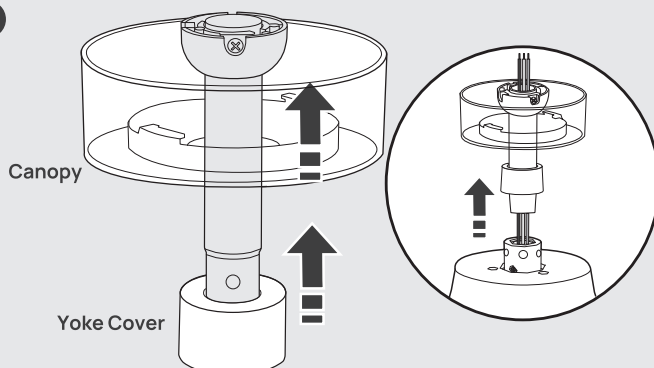

Remove the 2 pre-installed setscrews and downrod pin.

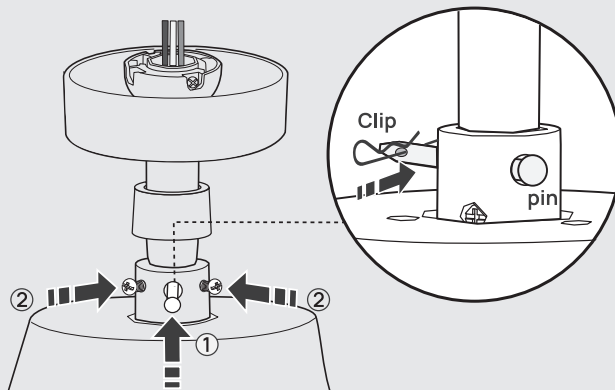

Insert the **canopy** and then the **yoke cover** to the downrod.

Pass all the wires to one side of the horizontal bar in the downrod to prevent excessive wire tangling.

Carefully slide the downrod into the yoke of the motor assembly.

Align the holes in the downrod.

Carefully re-install the downrod **pin** and **clip**.

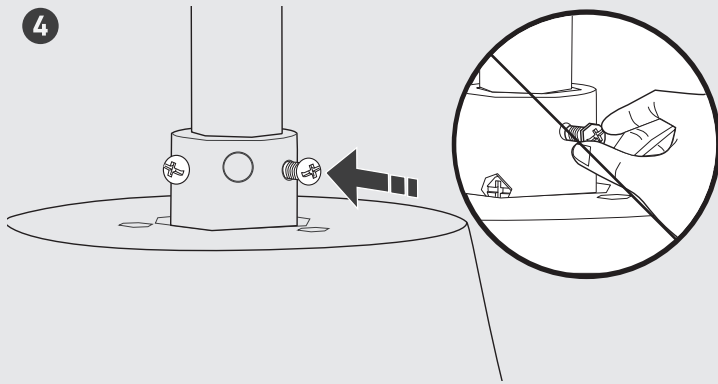

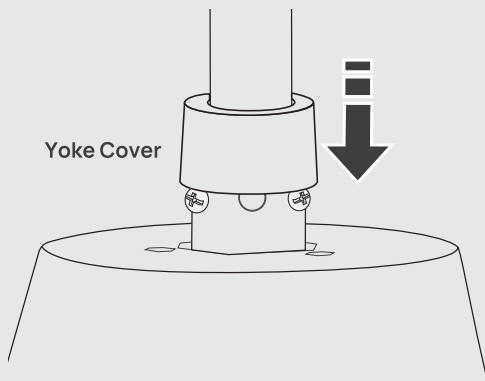

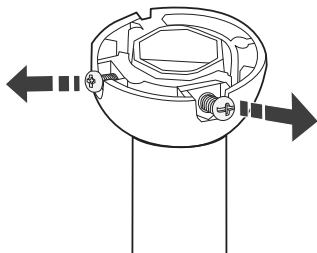
Put down the yoke cover.

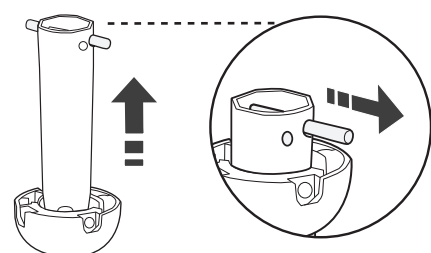
The downrod ball has been pre-installed on the 6-inch downrod. If you wish to move it to the 4-inch downrod, please follow these steps.

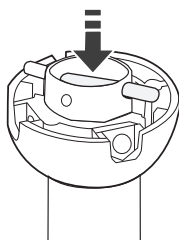
Loosen and remove the two screws on the downrod ball from the 6-inch downrod.

②



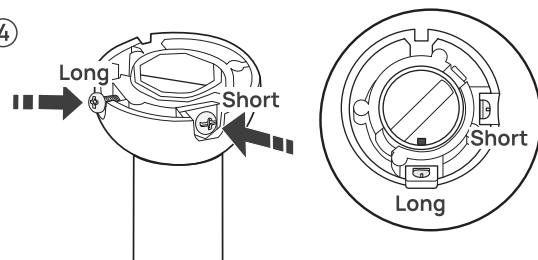
Lift the downrod upwards, then remove the horizontal bar, and detach the downrod ball from the 6-inch downrod.

Install the downrod ball onto the 4-inch downrod and securely insert the horizontal bar in its designated position.

④



Insert the first perforated long screw tightly, and then insert the second short screw tightly.

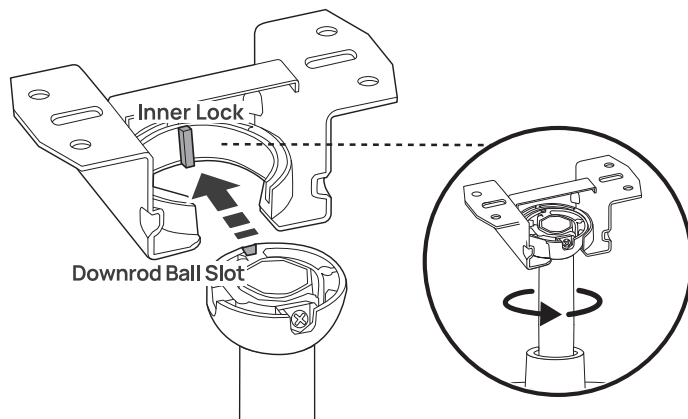

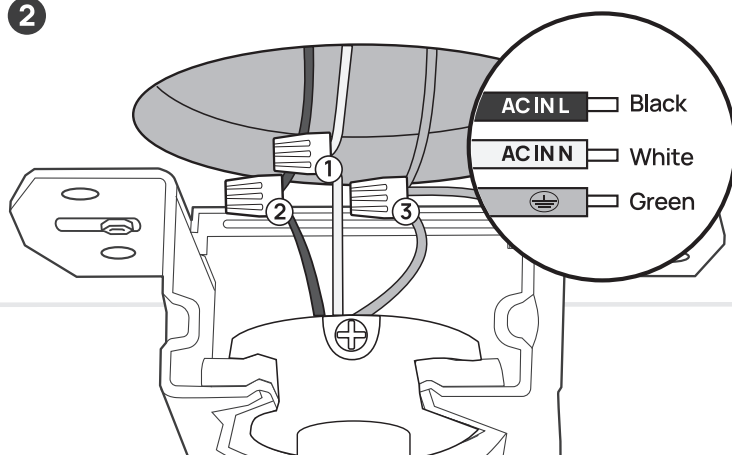


Place the downrod ball into the ceiling bracket.

Make sure the **downrod ball slot** matches the **inner lock**.

Rotate the downrod until it's secured.

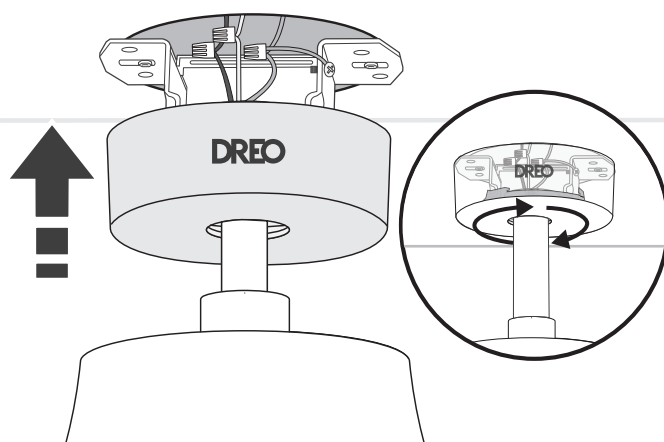


1. Connect the white (grounded) wire from the ceiling to the white wire from the fan.

2. Connect the black (ungrounded) wire from the ceiling to the black wire from the fan.

3. Connect the three grounding wires (green, green/yellow stripe, or bare copper) coming from the ceiling, downrod, and hanging bracket.

Rotate the canopy **clockwise** (from your bottom view) to securely fasten it to the ceiling bracket.

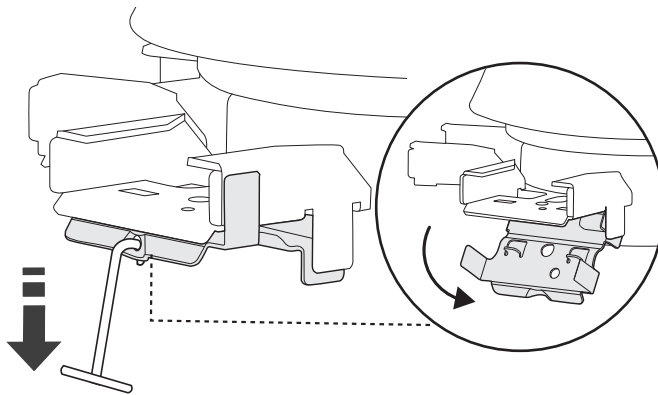

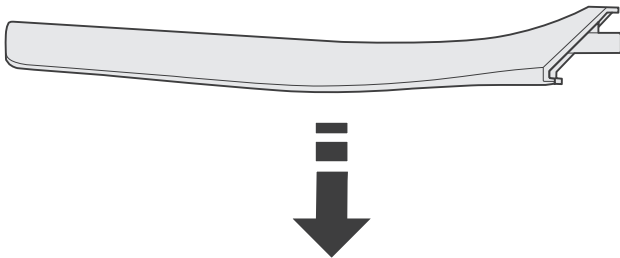

Hook the L-shaped hook onto the outermost hole of the metal toggle clamp and carefully pull down to **fully open** it.

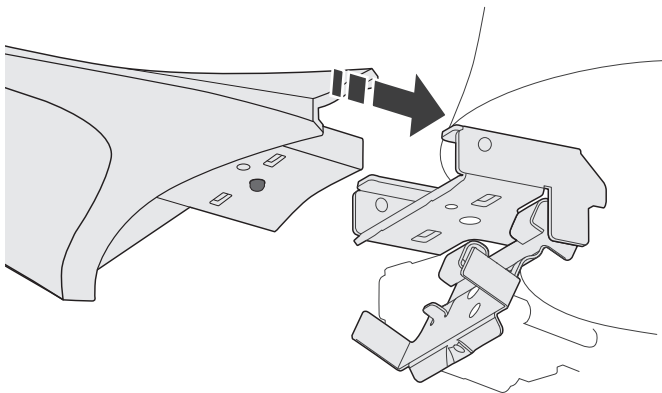

Position the fan blades with the curvature slope facing downwards during installation.

Align the fan blade with the slot on the ceiling fan's blade arm, then insert it.

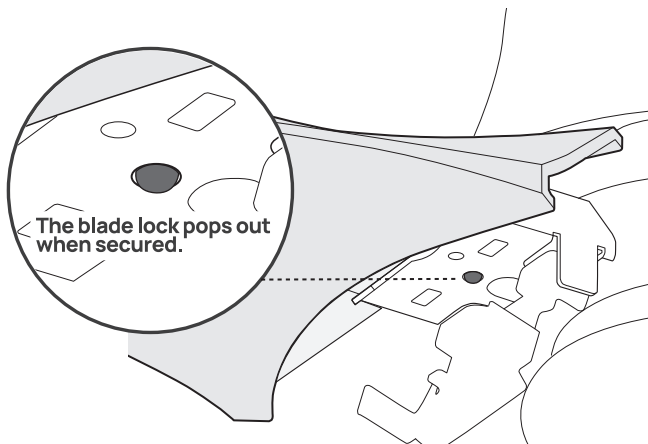

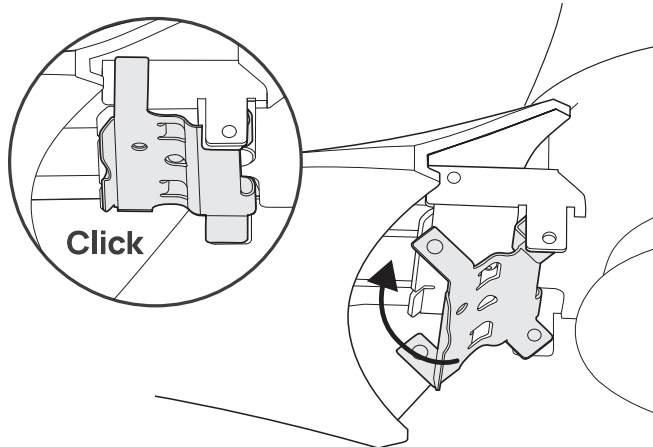

Make sure the **blade lock** on the fan blade **pops out** when secured in place.

Note: To remove the fan blade, push the blade lock upwards using the thumbscrew (or a tool if necessary).

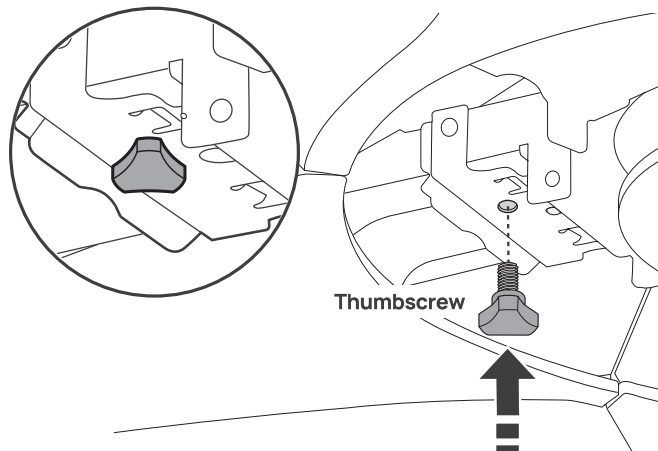

Push the metal toggle clamp on the blade arm upward to fully lock the fan blade. (You'll hear a distinct 'click'.)

Caution: **ALWAYS** be careful not to pinch your fingers when pulling the metal toggle clamp.

6



Securely tighten the **thumbscrew** into the middle hole of the blade arm.

7



Follow the above six steps to complete the assembly of the remaining four blades.

NOTE: Follow the instructions on the blade carefully. Incorrect installation could result in the fan not functioning properly.

Connect the two transparent ports for the LED light and then connect the two solid white ports for the RGB light.

Rotate the light kit **clockwise** to securely fasten it into place.

Note: Make sure that you hear a distinctive "click" when fastening the light kit in place.

NOTE: Please check if the ceiling fan is properly installed before use.

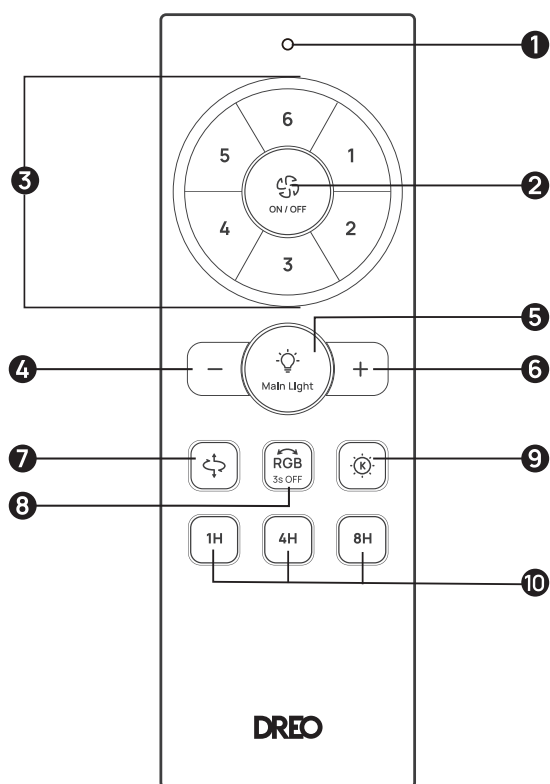

- 1 Command Indicator
- 2 Fan Power Button (On/Off)
- 3 Fan Speed Settings (1 to 6)
- 4 Decrease Brightness Button
- 5 Main Light Button (On/Off)
- 6 Increase Brightness Button
- 7 Airflow Direction Button
- 8 RGB Light Button
 - Press this button repeatedly to cycle through 7 light colors (red, orange, yellow, green, turquoise, blue, purple) and 3 ambient light effects.
 - Long press for 3 seconds to turn off the RGB light.
- 9 Light Temperature/Mute Button
 - Long press for 3 seconds to turn on/off the button sound.
- 10 Quick Timer Settings (1H - 4H - 8H)
- 5 + 9 WiFi Connection/Disconnection (Long press 3 Seconds)

Touch **8H** repeatedly 5 times to restore factory settings.

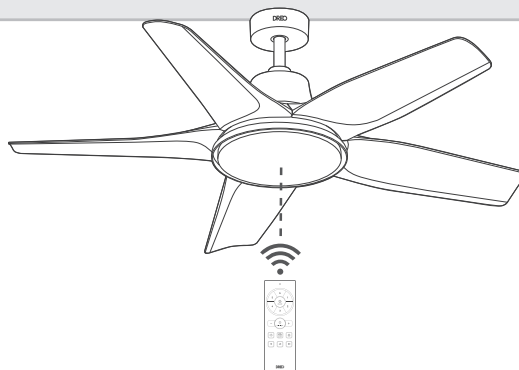
Note: When the remote control battery is low, the command indicator light will flash for a few seconds.

Remote Control Pairing

The remote control that shipped with your fan is already paired.

Note: When pairing a new remote control, you MUST disconnect power (at the wall switch, breaker, or fan from other ceiling fans within range) to prevent faulty operation.

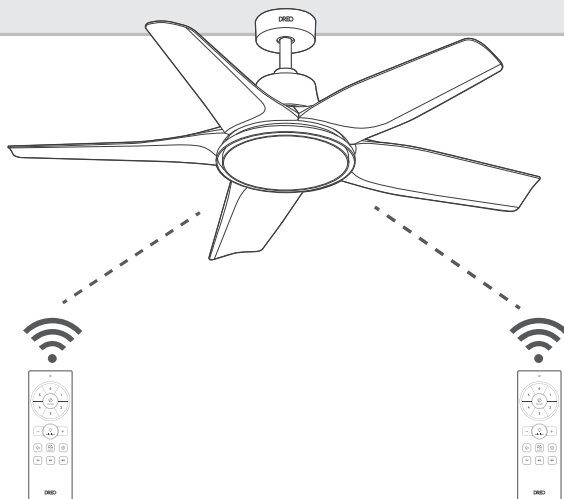
Pairing a new remote control to an existing appliance



If you lose your remote control or purchase a new one, please follow the steps below to pair the remote control to your appliance.

- Power cycle the fan by toggling the wall switch (or circuit breaker if needed). Within three minutes, long press  and  on your remote for 3 seconds to pair it.
- If pairing is successful, there will be a long beep, and the LED lights will flash and stay on for 3 seconds.

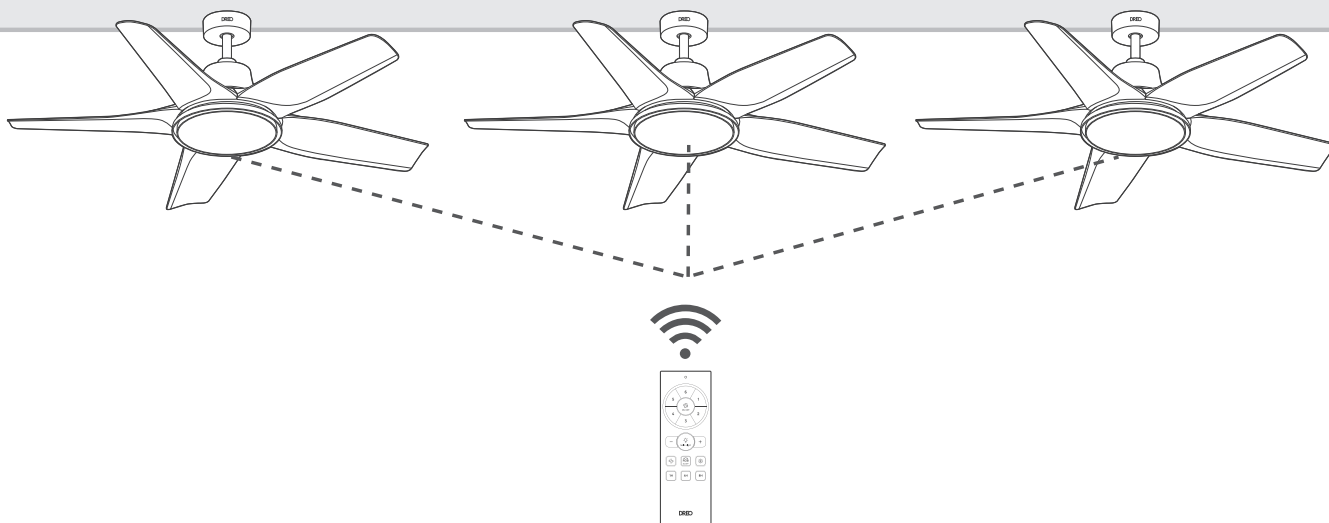
Pairing multiple remote controls to an existing appliance



To pair multiple remote controls to an existing appliance, you must pair each additional remote control separately. The remote control that shipped with your fan is already paired.

- For each additional control, power cycle the fan by toggling the wall switch (or circuit breaker if needed). Within three minutes, long press  and  on your remote for 3 seconds to pair it.
- If pairing is successful, there will be a long beep, and the LED lights will flash and stay on for 3 seconds.

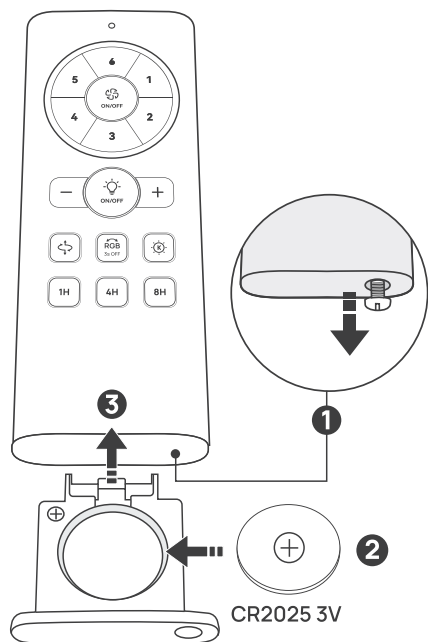
Pairing one remote control to multiple appliances



To pair one remote control to multiple appliances, you must pair each additional appliance separately. The remote control that shipped with your fan is already paired.

- For each additional fan, ensure that a compatible receiver is installed. Disconnect power from all other fans while pairing.
- Power cycle the fan by toggling the wall switch (or circuit breaker if needed). Within three minutes, long press  and  on your remote for 3 seconds to pair it.
- If pairing is successful, there will be a long beep, and the LED lights will flash and stay on for 3 seconds.

Battery Replacement



1. Unscrew the locking button with a Phillips screwdriver to remove the battery holder.
2. Replace with the same battery type with the (+) side facing up.
3. Push the holder in and tighten the screw until it is securely locked into place.

Note: If the indicator on the remote control doesn't turn on anymore, please consider replacing the battery.

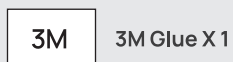

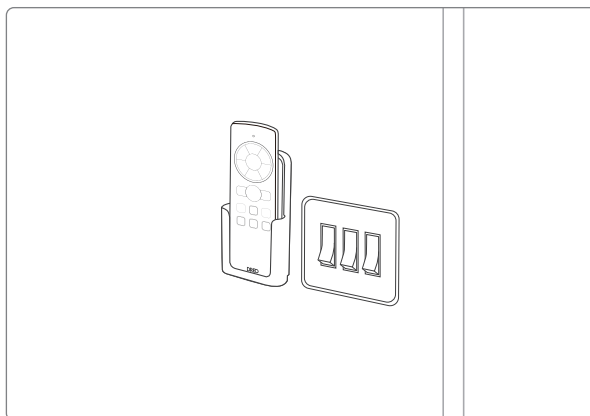
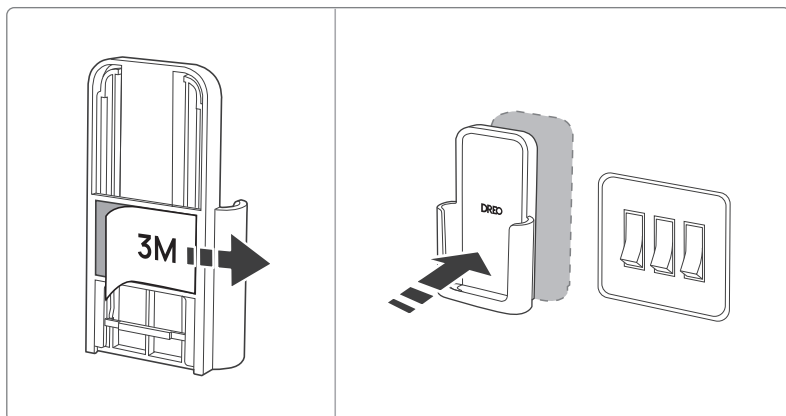

Option 1:

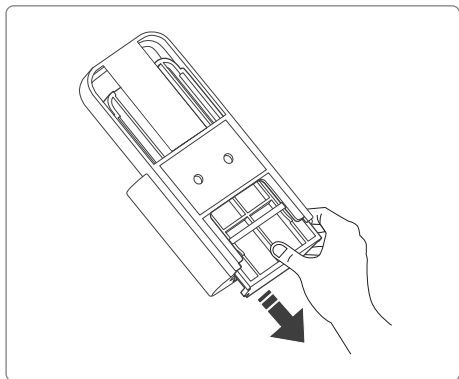
- 1 Peel off the 3M glue on the back of the holder to adhere it to the desired location.

- 2 Store your remote control.

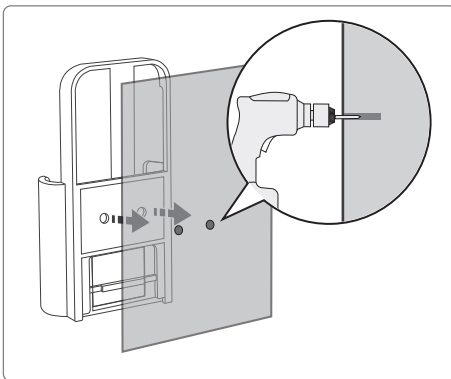

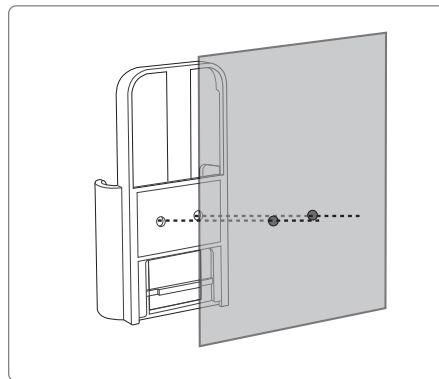
- 1** Slide the backboard downward to remove it.



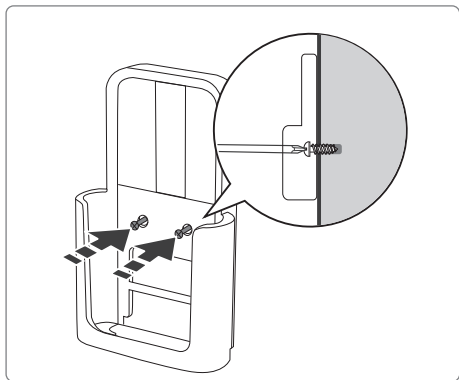
- 2** Use the two holes on the holder as a guide to drill two corresponding holes in the flat wall.



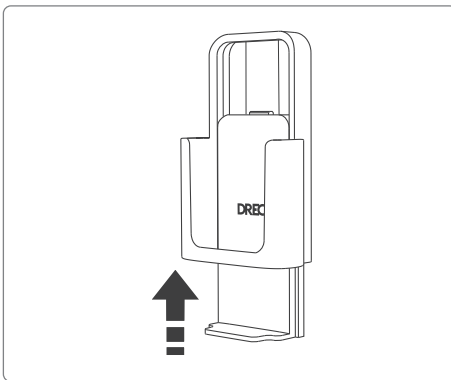
- 3** Align the two holes on the holder with the two holes on the wall.



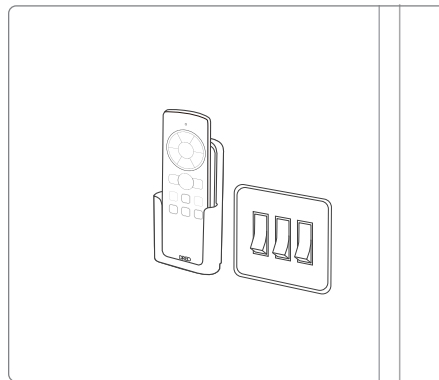
- 4** Insert the two screws into the holes and tighten them using a screwdriver.



- 5** Slide the backboard upward to reposition it.



- 6** Store your remote control.



Additional Features



Memory

If the appliance is turned OFF or disconnected from power, it will operate under the previous settings (except the Timer setting) when it is turned ON again.



Timer

When the appliance is ON/OFF, touch the timer button **1H** **4H** **8H** repeatedly to set a timer (1H, 4H, 8H). When the timer ends, the appliance will stop/start running automatically.

RGB

RGB Light

To turn on the RGB light, press **RGB 3s OFF** on the remote control. Use this button to cycle through 7 light colors and 3 ambient light effects.

To unlock even more light color and style options, download the official DREO app via App Store or Google Play.

To turn off the RGB light, long press **RGB 3s OFF** for 3 seconds.



Mute

Long press **Mute** for 3 seconds to turn on/off the button sounds.

CONNECTING TO YOUR APPLIANCE

Before connecting the appliance to your mobile device, please scan the QR code on the left or go to the app store and search “DREO”, then select and download the app.



Look for "Smart Ceiling Fan 712S" when connecting your new appliance.



You can use the DREO app to connect your appliance to Amazon Alexa or Google Home. Please follow the in-app instructions to set up your voice assistant.
NOTE: You must create a DREO account to access voice assistants.



Launch DREO and sign in or create an account by following in-app instructions.

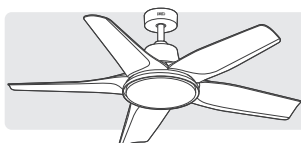

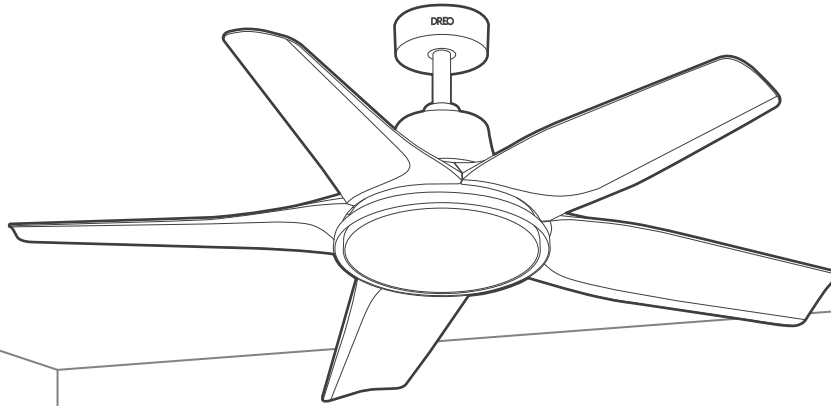

(Tip: To restart connection settings, hold  and  again for 5 seconds)



Clean the motor housing and blades with a soft brush or lint-free cloth to avoid scratching the finish.

At least twice each year, lower the canopy to check the downrod assembly and tighten all screws on the fan.



- Shut off the main power supply before you begin any maintenance task.
- **DO NOT** use water or a damp cloth to clean the fan.
- Cleaning products may damage the finishes.

Problem	Solution
Fan Doesn't Work	• Make sure the power switch is on. • Check the circuit breaker to ensure the power is turned on. • Make sure the blades spin freely. • Turn off the power at the circuit breaker, then loosen the screws on the ceiling bracket. Rotate the ceiling fan body clockwise and hang it on the L-shaped hook on the bracket. Check all connections according to the wiring diagram.
Excessive Wobbling	• Make sure the blades are properly installed on the blade iron posts. • Turn the power off, support the fan carefully, and check that the screws on the ceiling bracket are properly seated.
Remote Control is Erratic	• Make sure the battery is installed correctly. • If the command indicator light keeps flashing, indicating low battery, install a fresh battery.
Remote Control Only Works Close to Fan	• Change batteries.
Noisy Operation	• Make sure the blades are properly installed. • Check to see if any of the blades are cracked. If so, replace all of the blades.

If you find any damaged or missing parts upon receiving the package or during installation, or if your issue is not listed above or continues to persist, please contact our Customer Support immediately (see page 19).

12-MONTH LIMITED WARRANTY

What is Covered

DREO warrants to you that your product will be free from original defects in materials and workmanship for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of your purchase, when you use your product for intended purposes in accordance with this User Manual. Please retain your proof of purchase. If you do not retain your proof of purchase, your warranty will start two (2) months from the date of manufacture printed on your product label.

What is Not Covered

This limited warranty only applies to the original purchaser of your product and is non-transferable.
