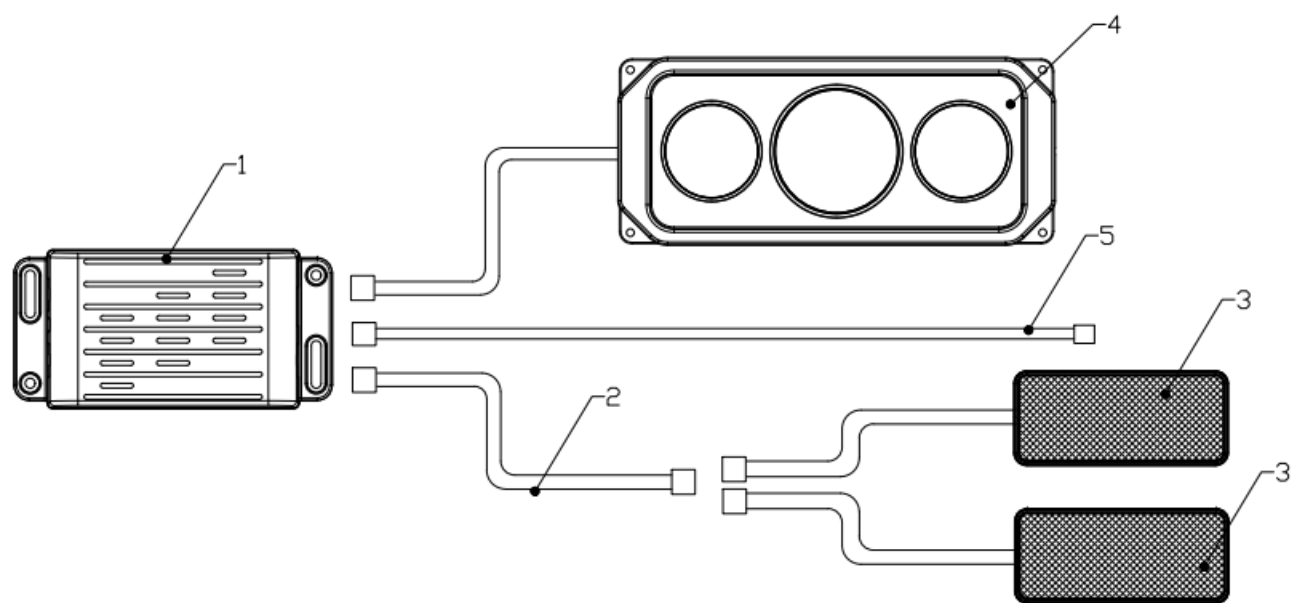

1. Device powers on and automatically enables Bluetooth, with the voice prompt "Power on".
2. Turn on your phone's Bluetooth, search for and pair with the device named "Subwoofer Speaker_Nxxxxx". Upon successful connection, the voice prompt will say "Connected successfully". A disconnect tone will sound when disconnected.

FCC Regulations

Radio Frequency (RF) Energy

This device is designed and manufactured not to exceed the emission limits for exposure to radio frequency (RF) energy set by the Federal Communications Commission of the United States.

The exposure standard for wireless devices employing a unit of measurement is known as the Specific Absorption Rate, or SAR. The SAR limit recommended by the general public is 1.6W/kg Averaged over one gram of tissue by IEEE Std 1528.

The FCC has granted an Equipment Authorization for this device with all reported SAR levels evaluated as in compliance with the FCC RF exposure guidelines. While there may be differences between the SAR levels of various devices and at various positions, they all meet the government requirements. SAR compliance for body-worn operation is Based on SAR test exclusion, all values meet the SAR test exclusion thresholds and are exempt from routine evaluation.
