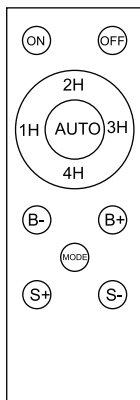

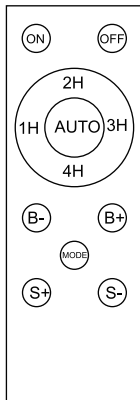

Remote Control Functions



1. ON, OFF
Turn on/off the lamp.
2. 1H, 2H, 3H, 4H Timer
Press once to set the timer, the lamp with flash 3 times and turn off after 1H/2H/3H/4H hours.
3. AUTO
Press once to activate or exit the AUTO mode.
4. MODE
Press once to cycle through the following lighting modes: Red, Green, Blue, Yellow, Cyan, Purple, White, Flash, Smooth...
5. B-, B+
Decrease/Increase the brightness.
6. S+, S-
Increase /Decrease the flashing speed.
