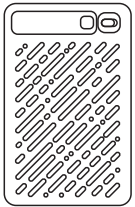

Download Methods Scan the QR code on the right to download, or for Android phones, enter "Yushu" in the "App Store" to download the app. For iPhones, search for "Yushu" directly in the App Store and download it, then follow the prompts to install and use. (2). Wireless Device Appearance and Function Indicator Diagram (1) Monitor Battery level indicator icon (1) Recording in progress NOTE: Meeting/Recording icon (2) Suspended CALL Call Recording icon (3) Playback icon (2) Power button Long press "Power" button (3 seconds), power on to enter recording mode. Short press "Power" button recording. Double press "Switch" between "NOTE" and "CALL" recording modes. (3) Recording button Press the switch to the left. Start recording. Press the switch to the right. Stop recording. See back and refer to the app. II. Wireless Connection Process for the Product Connecting wireless devices: Wireless devices require the "Yushu" app for operation. Turn on wireless search. Connecting devices: Confirm App Connection. Open the app and tap "Connect". (Wait for successful connection.) The app's home page will show the device's "Video & Audio" and "Voice" status.	II. Go to the "Video/Voice Calls" page. 4. After completing the recording, click the "Save" button. A "Name File" input box will appear. Enter the desired name and confirm to save.	3. Select the following options in sequence: Video/Voice Call > My Language > Other Party's Language > Invite Friends to Call. 4. Invite Friends: Share the link via WeChat, Skype, email, etc. Friends can simply open the link to start a call.	(3) Meeting Minutes 1. Enter the "Recording List" interface and tap the record button to start the recording process. 2. After clicking the recording button, the "Recording Language" settings box will appear. Select the audio language and set the recording title.	V. Equipment Charging and Usage: Remove the dedicated magnetic charging cable from the packaging box and insert it into the charging port of the "Recording Card Translator". The charging icon will flash to indicate charging is in progress. Once fully charged, the charging icon will display a full battery indicator.	VI. T29PRO Installation: To install the magnetic plate, peel off the adhesive backing from the magnetic ring sticker. Then attach it to the back of your phone case (or directly to your phone). Once done, the T29PRO back clip case will magnetically attach to the back of your phone.
