

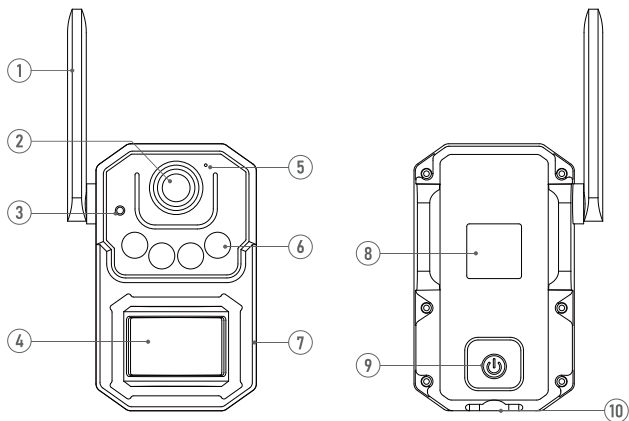

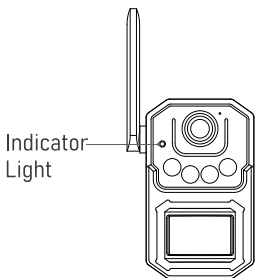

Recharge the Camera

- 1. Connect a certified USB cable to the camera charging port.
- 2. Connect the cable to a USB power adapter.

3. Wait until the indicator light turns off before the first setup.

1. Scan the QR code below or search for **Gazing** in the Apple App Store or Google Play. Then download and install the app.

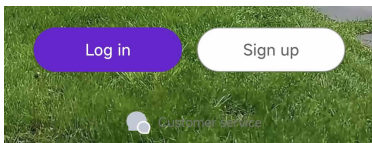

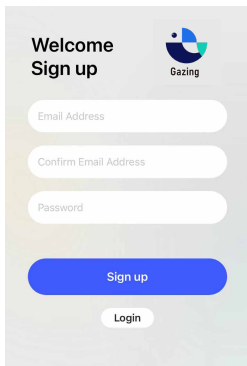

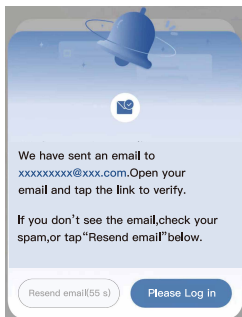
2. Open the app on your cellphone and tap “Sign up”.



3. Enter your email address, set a password, and tap “Sign up”.

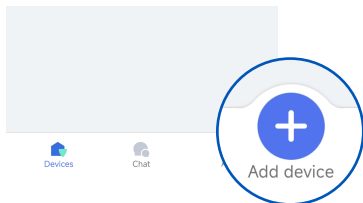
4. After activating your account with the email link, log in to the app using your email and password.



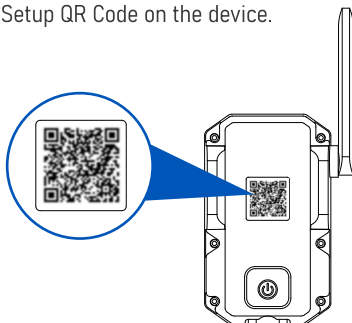
5. Re-open the app, enter your email address and password, and tap “Log in”.

Set Up Your Camera in the App

1. Press the **power button** to turn on the camera.
2. Open the Gazing App and sign in to your account.
3. Tap the “+” button in the bottom-right corner.



4. Scan the Setup QR Code on the device.

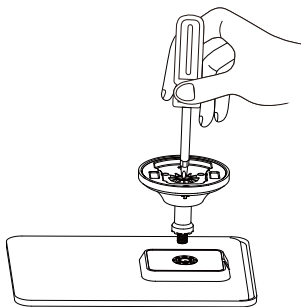


5. When the app displays “Make sure your device is powered on,” tap “Yes”.
6. Subscribe to a 4G service plan in the app to bring your camera online, then allow 30 seconds to 3 minutes to connect to 4G on first setup.
7. Your setup is complete.

Set up Your Solar Panel

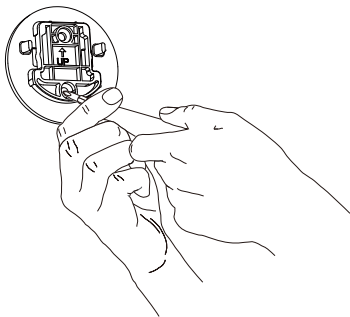
Step 1: Attach the mounting arm

Align the mounting arm with the back of the solar panel and secure it using a screwdriver.



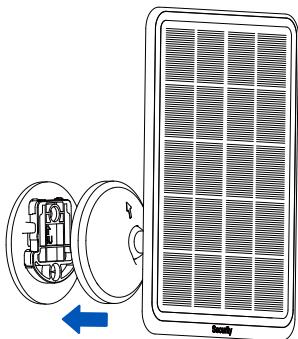
Step 2: Prepare the wall

Use the mounting base to mark your drill points. Drill the holes, insert the wall anchors, and secure the base with screws.



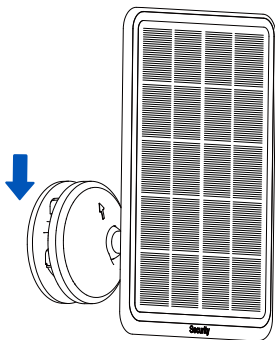
Step 3: Mount the solar panel

Slide the mounting arm into the base until it clicks into place.



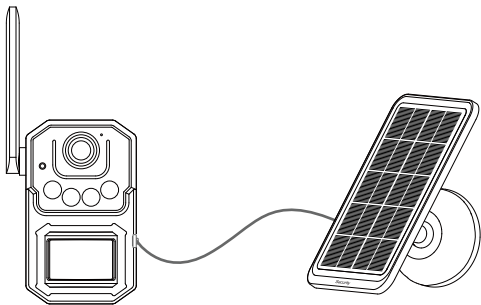
Step 4: Lock it in and aim

Push the arm down to secure the fit. Tilt the solar panel to capture maximum sunlight throughout the day.



Step 5: Connect the solar panel to the camera

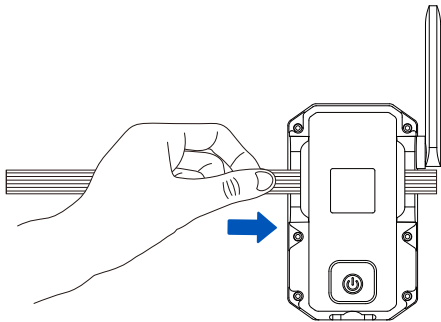
Plug the solar panel cable into the charging port on the camera.



Set up your trail camera using the strap

Step 1: Thread the strap

Slide the mounting strap through the slots on the back of the camera. It clicks into place with a secure fit.



Step 2: Find the perfect spot

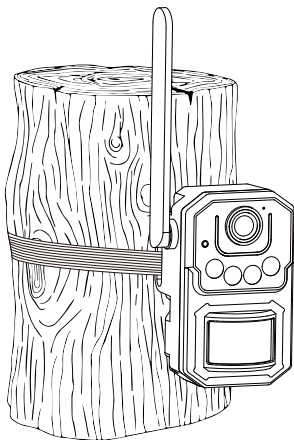
Choose a sturdy tree or post with a clear view of your target area. Wrap the strap around it—flat, snug, and ready.

Step 3: Lock it down

Pull the strap tight. Fasten the buckle to keep the camera steady and right where you want it.

Step 4: Frame your view

Adjust the camera to perfectly capture your target area. You're all set to start recording.



Frequently Asked Questions

1. How can I share the device with family members?

Open the app and tap on Settings. From there, you can share the device via QR code or email, and even transfer ownership of the device. The new user must first download the app and create their own account.

2. Why can't I change the settings?

Only the owner account can change settings, delete videos, and share the device. Shared accounts do not have these options.

3. Why is the camera offline?

If the camera is offline, it means it is disconnected. If the battery is depleted, you will need to recharge it.

4. How can I enable notifications on my phone?

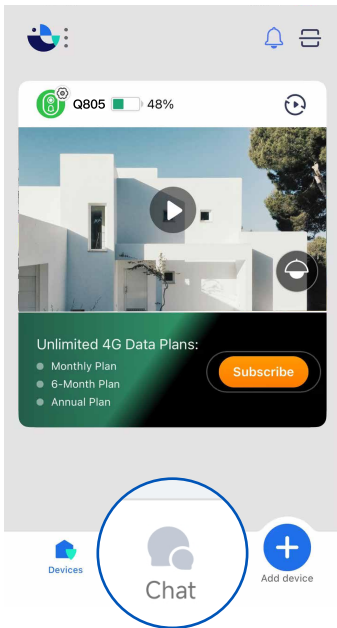
- 1) Open the app. From the Device page, tap the Settings icon, then tap the Motion Detection icon. Here, you can choose whether to turn Motion Alerts on or off.
- 2) Open your phone's settings. Navigate to "App Management" and "Notification Settings," then locate the app. Ensure all permissions and notifications are enabled for the app.

5. Does this device come with a SIM card, or do I need to buy one separately?

The device has a built-in 4G LTE SIM card, so you don't need to buy or insert one yourself. It's ready to use right out of the box. The SIM card is not removable - it's built in to keep the connection stable and setup easy.
