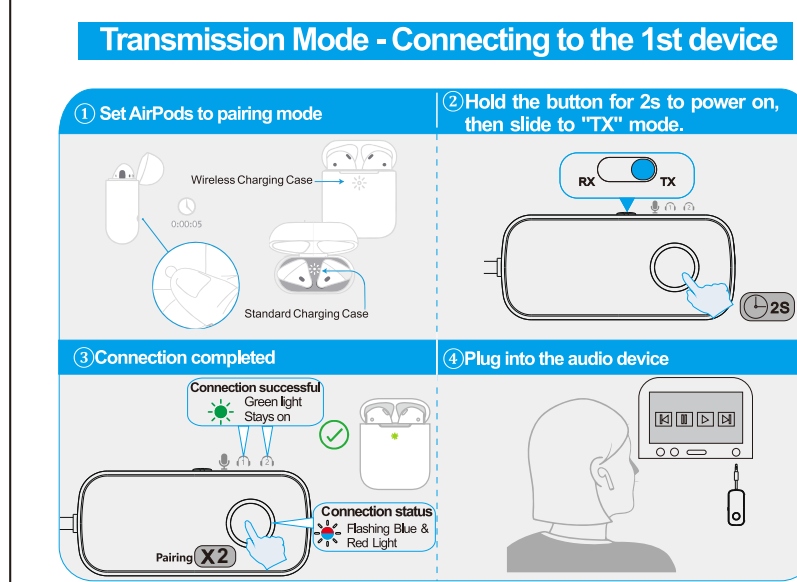


Transmitter mode: Connects to audio devices such as televisions, Switch, MP3, etc., and transmits the audio to a Bluetooth speaker or Bluetooth headphones (such as AirPods).

Receiver mode: Connects to audio devices with speakers, such as non-Bluetooth-enabled home stereos, car stereos, etc., and receives and plays audio from a phone (or tablet, computer).

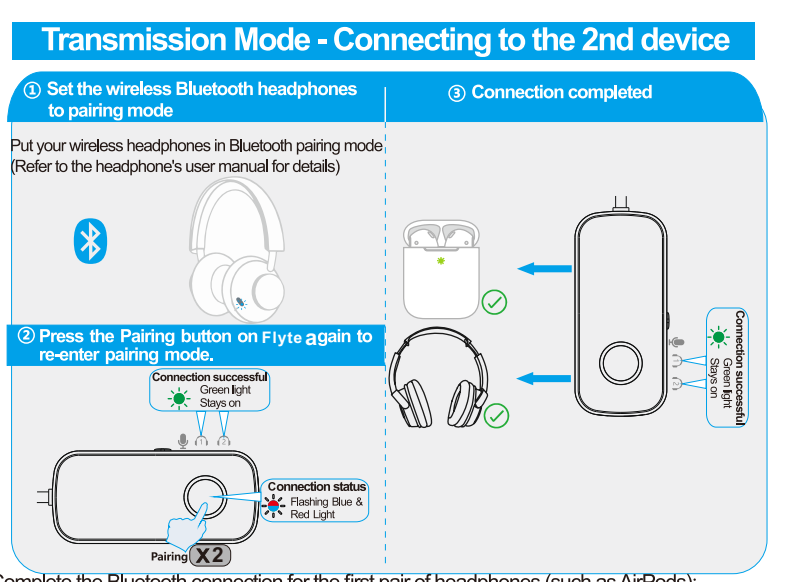

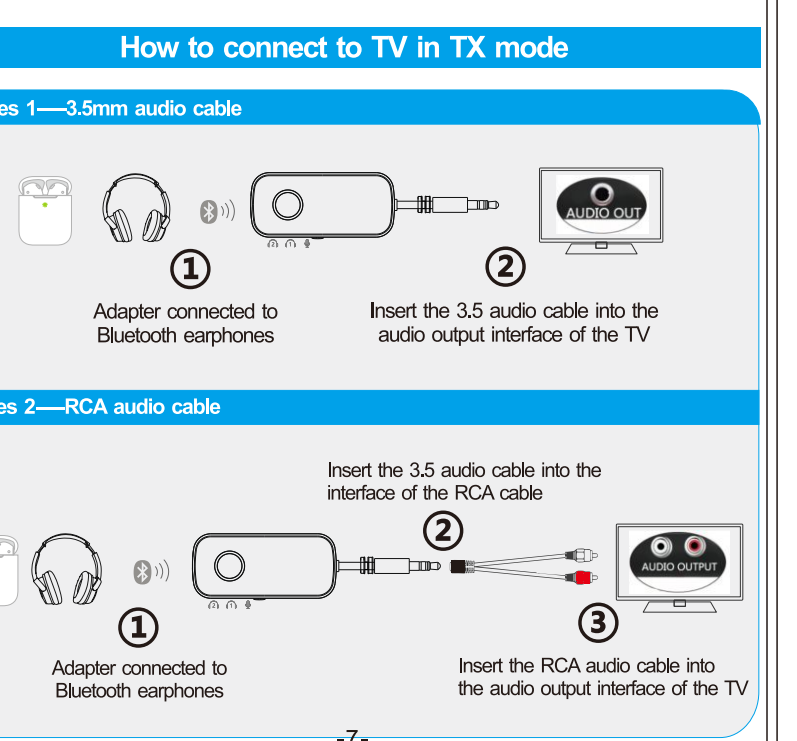
- ① Set AirPods to pairing mode (refer to the AirPods user manual for details);
- ② Hold the button for 2s to power on, then slide to "TX" mode. Double-click for pairing mode.
- ③ After successful connection to the headphones, the ① green light on the product stays on;
- ④ Plug the product into the audio source device (such as airplane media system, TV), and the headphones can play sound.

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- ① Set the second pair of headphones to Bluetooth pairing mode (refer to the headphone's user manual for details);
- ② Single-click the "Pairing" button on the product, and the status light flashes (Flashing Blue & Red Light) to indicate that it is ready to connect to the second pair of headphones;
- ③ Successful connection, both ① and ② green lights on the product will illuminate simultaneously.

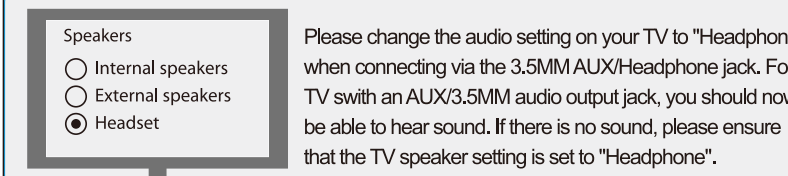
FCC Statement

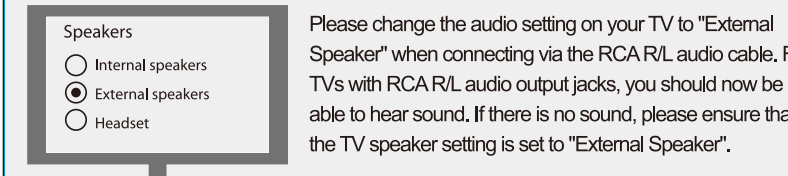

① 3.5MM AUX/Headphone Jack Connection:

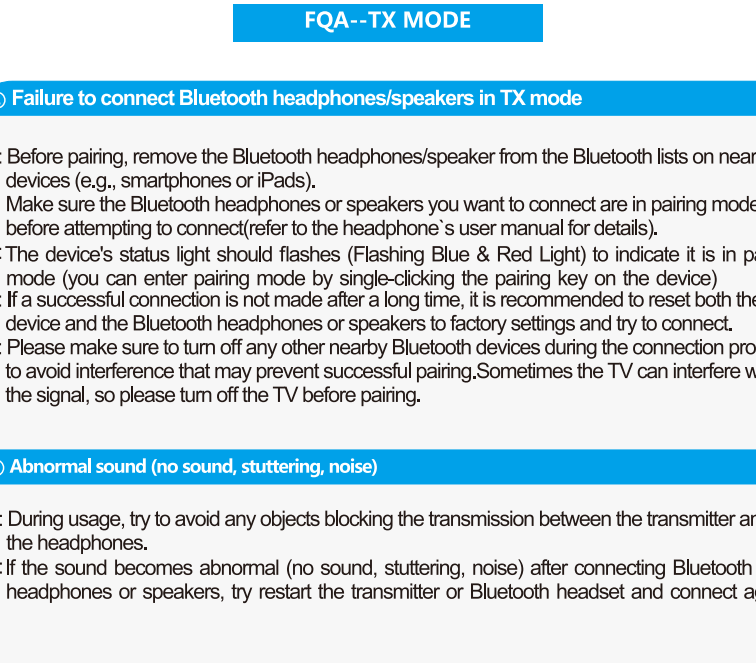


② RCA/R/L Audio Cable Connection:

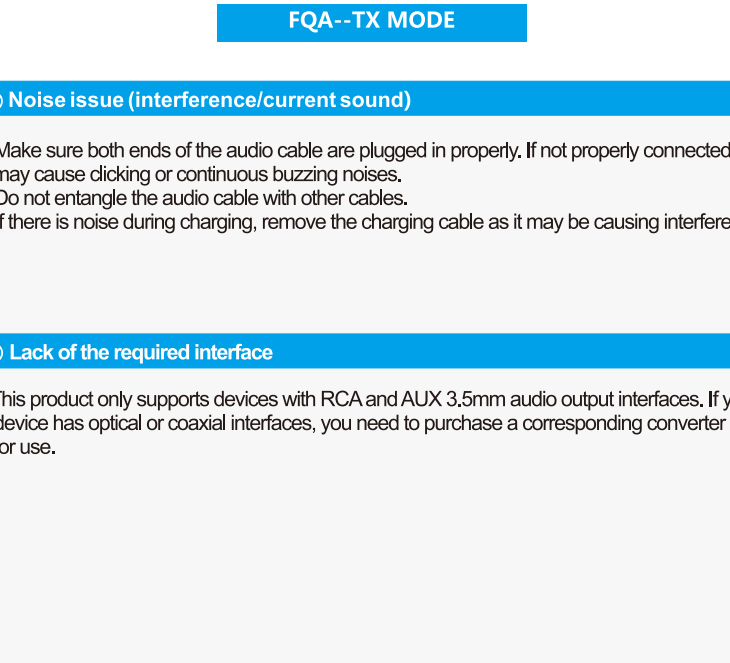

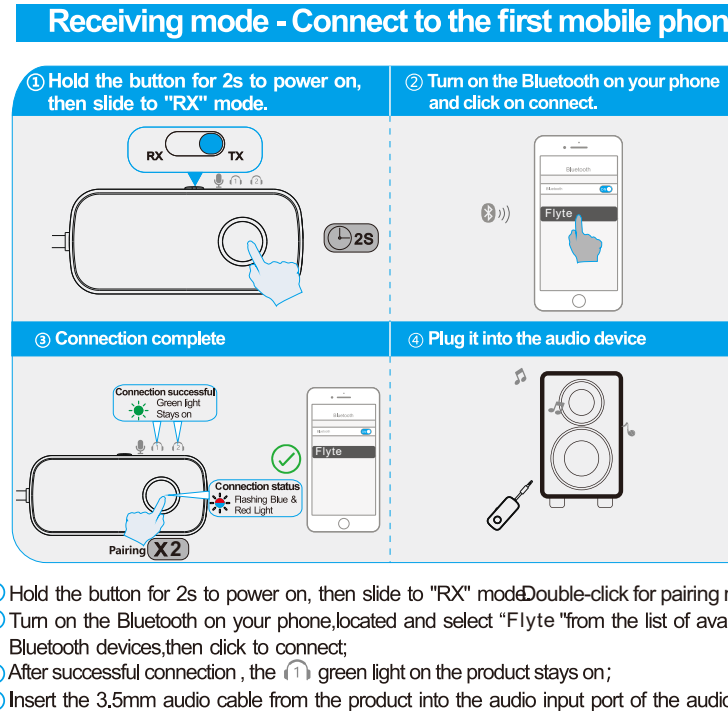

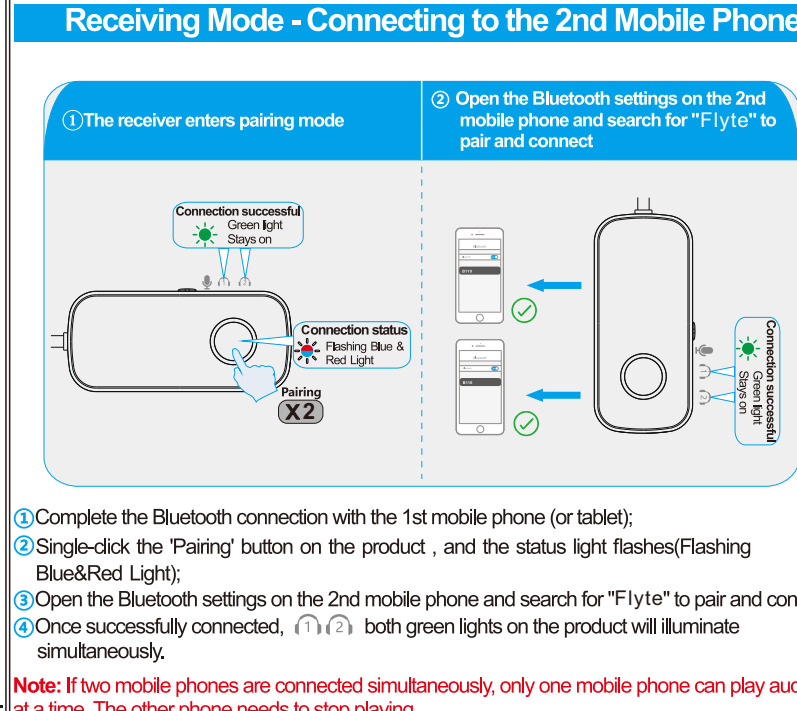

- ① Hold the button for 2s to power on, then slide to "RX" mode. Double-click for pairing mode.
- ② Turn on the Bluetooth on your phone, located and select "Flyte" from the list of available Bluetooth devices, then click to connect.
- ③ After successful connection, the ① green light on the product stays on;
- ④ Insert the 3.5mm audio cable from the product into the audio input port of the audio device.

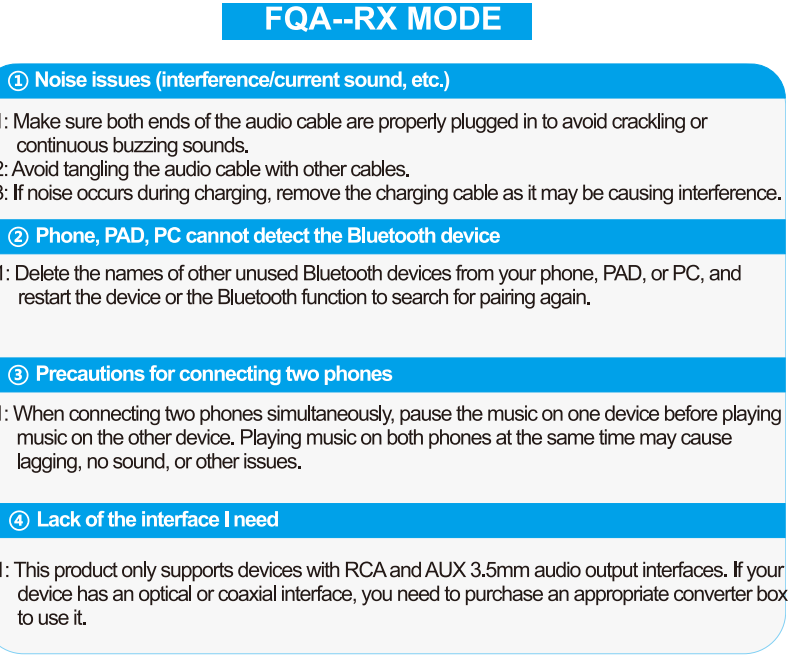

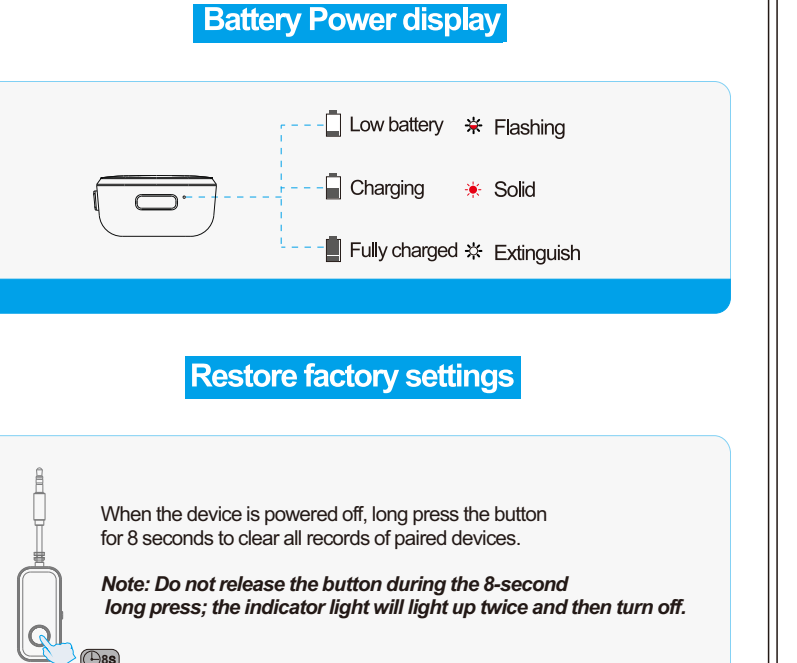
- ① Complete the Bluetooth connection with the 1st mobile phone (or tablet);
- ② Single-click the "Pairing" button on the product, and the status light flashes (Flashing Blue & Red Light);
- ③ Open the Bluetooth settings on the 2nd mobile phone and search for "Flyte" to pair and connect;
- ④ Once successfully connected, ① ② both green lights on the product will illuminate simultaneously.

Note: If two mobile phones are connected simultaneously, only one mobile phone can play audio at a time. The other phone needs to stop playing.
