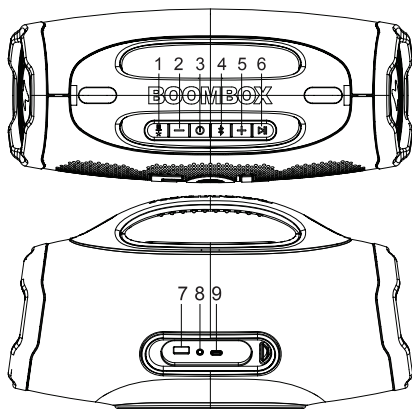


### Functional panel diagram



### Button function description.

1. Press this button to directly enter BT mode, then press to switch to USB-FM/AUX mode, and press again to return to BT mode. In any mode, inserting a USB flash drive will take priority. While playing music, hold this button to cycle through the light display modes—there are 7 lighting options available.
2. “-”: Briefly press to go to the previous song. In FM mode,

briefly press to tune to the previous channel. Press and hold for several seconds to decrease volume.

3. “⏻”: Press and hold to power on; press and hold again to power off.
4. “⌘”: Briefly press to enter BT mode and start pairing with your mobile phone. After successful connection, the BT indicator stays on. Press and hold for 1–2 seconds to initiate TWS pairing mode. After both speakers connect successfully, their Bluetooth indicators remain lit. Double-click to disconnect the mobile phone's BT connection once; double-click twice to disconnect the TWS connection.
5. “+”: Briefly press to skip to the next song. In FM mode, briefly press to tune to the next channel. Press and hold for several seconds to increase volume.
6. “▶||”: Briefly press to play/pause. In FM mode, briefly press to mute; press and hold to automatically search for available channels. During scanning, briefly press to stop the search.
7. USB Input
8. LINE IN auxiliary port.
9. Type-C Charging Port, 5V–2A

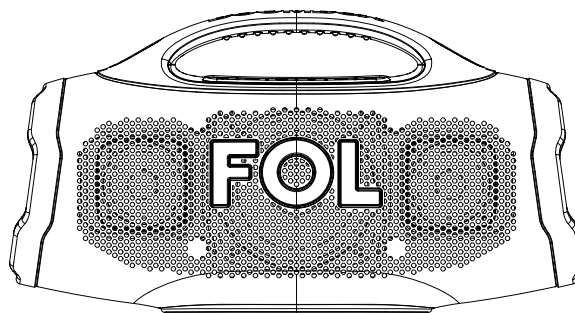
