Precautions on Volume Level Usage

Warning: Exposure to high sound volume levels from any source for prolonged periods may affect your hearing. The higher the sound volume, the faster hearing is affected.

Card Installation

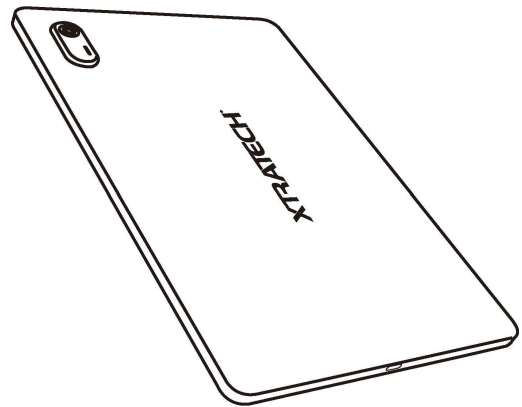
Power off your device before inserting or removing a card.

Charging the Device

This device works with most USB adapters and a USB Type-C cable. Use a compatible charger with output no less than 18W.

Note: It is recommended to use a compliant charger. Using other chargers may damage the equipment.

To extend battery life, we recommend charging to at least 30%~50% capacity each time.



FCC Statement
