



GAME INSTRUCTIONS

GAME PREPARATION

1. Choose a flat, dry and spacious area for play.
2. Spread the six mini construction vehicles around the play area.
3. Turn on the Engineering Eater Truck and make sure it can move forward, reverse and turn normally.
4. Control the Engineering Eater Truck and aim the front intake opening at a mini construction vehicle.
5. Slowly drive forward to swallow the mini construction vehicles one at a time.
6. After the game, remove all the mini vehicles from inside the truck.

Tips: Adjust the direction before moving forward. Slow down when turning to help the truck line up with and swallow the target vehicle more accurately.

SINGLE-PLAYER MODE

GAME 1: GOBBLE & GROW CHALLENGE

▲ GAME RULES

1. Randomly place the six mini construction vehicles flat on the floor.
 2. Control the Engineering Eater Truck to find and swallow the mini vehicles one by one.
 3. Successfully swallow all six mini vehicles to complete the challenge.
 4. Repeat the challenge and record the time taken for each round.
- ADVANCED CHALLENGE** Swallow the mini vehicles in the following order: No. 1 → No. 2 → No. 3 → No. 4 → No. 5 → No. 6. If a vehicle is swallowed in the wrong order, remove it, return it to its original position and continue the challenge.



Tips: Remember the position of each mini vehicle and plan the best driving route before starting. This will help you complete the challenge faster!

GAME 2: FUN MATH GAME

▲ GAME RULES

A parent gives number challenges based on the child's age. The child controls the Engineering Eater Truck and swallows the correct number of mini vehicles.

The parent calls out a number, for example: "Please swallow three mini vehicles."

The child counts and swallows the corresponding number of mini vehicles. The parent gives addition or subtraction questions using numbers up to six: "2+3=? 6-2=? 1+4=?"

After working out the answer, the child swallows the corresponding number of mini vehicles.



Tips: Combining numbers with vehicle-control games makes learning feel like an exciting challenge!



GAME 3: COLOR SORTING CHALLENGE

▲ GAME RULES

1. First swallow the green mini vehicle.
2. Then the yellow mini vehicle.
3. And finally the orange mini vehicle.



Tips: Identify the correct target and carefully control the direction of the truck. Complete the tasks accurately to pass the challenge! Do not focus only on speed. Accurately lining up with the target will help save more time!

TWO-PLAYER MODE

EXCITING BATTLES LET'S SEE WHO WINS!

Compete for mini construction vehicles in the same play area. Test your speed, route-planning skills and vehicle-control skills to find out who is the ultimate Engineering Eater Truck champion!

Tips: Each toy set contains only one Engineering Eater Truck. Two-player games require two complete toy sets.



GAME 1: ORDERED RACING CHALLENGE

▲ GAME RULES

1. Divide the play area into two separate zones: left and right.
2. Player A and Player B each receive six mini construction vehicles.
3. Both players start from their designated starting points at the same time.
4. Each player must swallow the mini vehicles in their own play zone in the following order:
No. 1 → No. 2 → No. 3 → No. 4 → No. 5 → No. 6
5. If a player swallows a vehicle in the wrong order, they must stop for two seconds before continuing.
6. The first player to swallow all six mini vehicles in the correct order wins.



Tips: This is a fair head-to-head racing challenge. Planning your route in advance is more important than simply driving fast!

GAME 2: ACE VEHICLE BATTLE

▲ GAME PREPARATION

1. Player A and Player B each prepare mini vehicles No. 1 to No. 5 from their own toy set.
2. Choose one No. 6 mini vehicle as the shared "Ace Vehicle."
3. Place the Ace Vehicle in the center of the play area and keep the other remaining mini vehicle outside the play area.
4. Place each player's mini vehicles inside their own play zone.

▲ GAME RULES

1. When the game begins, both players must first collect the five mini vehicles in their own zones.
2. A player may enter the central area only after completing their own collection task.
3. Both players then compete for the Ace Vehicle in the center.
4. The first player to swallow the Ace Vehicle wins.
5. If a player accidentally swallows a vehicle belonging to the opponent's zone, the vehicle must be returned to its original position.



Tips: Complete your own collection task as quickly as possible before competing for the Ace Vehicle. Both speed and strategy are essential!

GAME 3: CRAZY FREE-FOR-ALL

▲ GAME RULES

1. Mix all twelve mini construction vehicles from the two toy sets together and randomly spread them around the center of the play area.
2. Both players start from opposite sides of the play area at the same time. Players may freely swallow any mini vehicle on the field.
3. The game, players may use the body of their truck to gently block their opponent's route.



4. Do not move the mini vehicles by hand or forcefully crash into the opponent's truck.
5. When all the mini vehicles have been swallowed, count how many each player has collected. The player who has swallowed the most mini vehicles wins.



Tips: Observe where the mini vehicles are positioned before choosing your direction. Select the shortest route and quickly collect the vehicles to complete the challenge.

1. Adult supervision is required when using this product.

7. If a mini vehicle or foreign object becomes stuck, turn off the power before asking an adult to remove it.
8. Remove all mini construction vehicles included in the package after each game.
9. Do not disassemble, strike, throw or drop the toy from a height.
