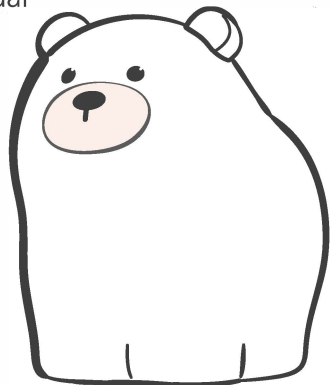

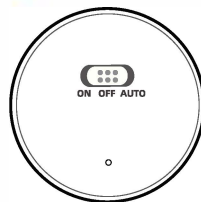

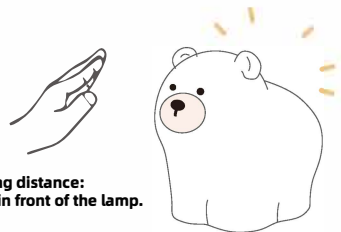

INSTRUCTION

 Warm Light Model

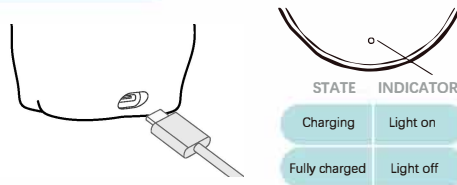


- ON** Steady on mode
- OFF** Turn off the lights
- AUTO** Sensor mode.
When motion is detected, light will turn on for about 30 seconds then turn off. Light will turn on again if motion is detected again.



Sensing distance:
1-2m in front of the lamp.

CHARGING



1. Do not use mobile phone fast charging/charging bank fast charging/in-line fast charging port, fast charging will damage the circuit chip.
2. Please use the output reference 5V1A or 5V1.5A adapter, turn it off when charging, and turn it on after charging.
