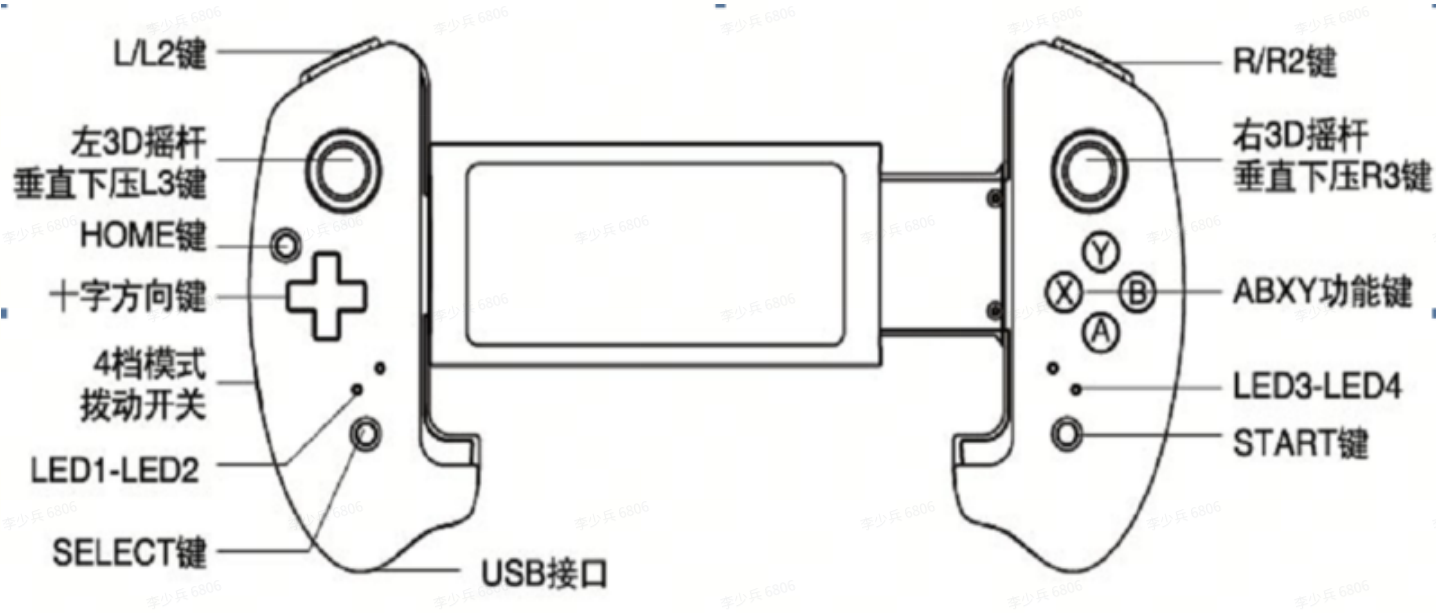

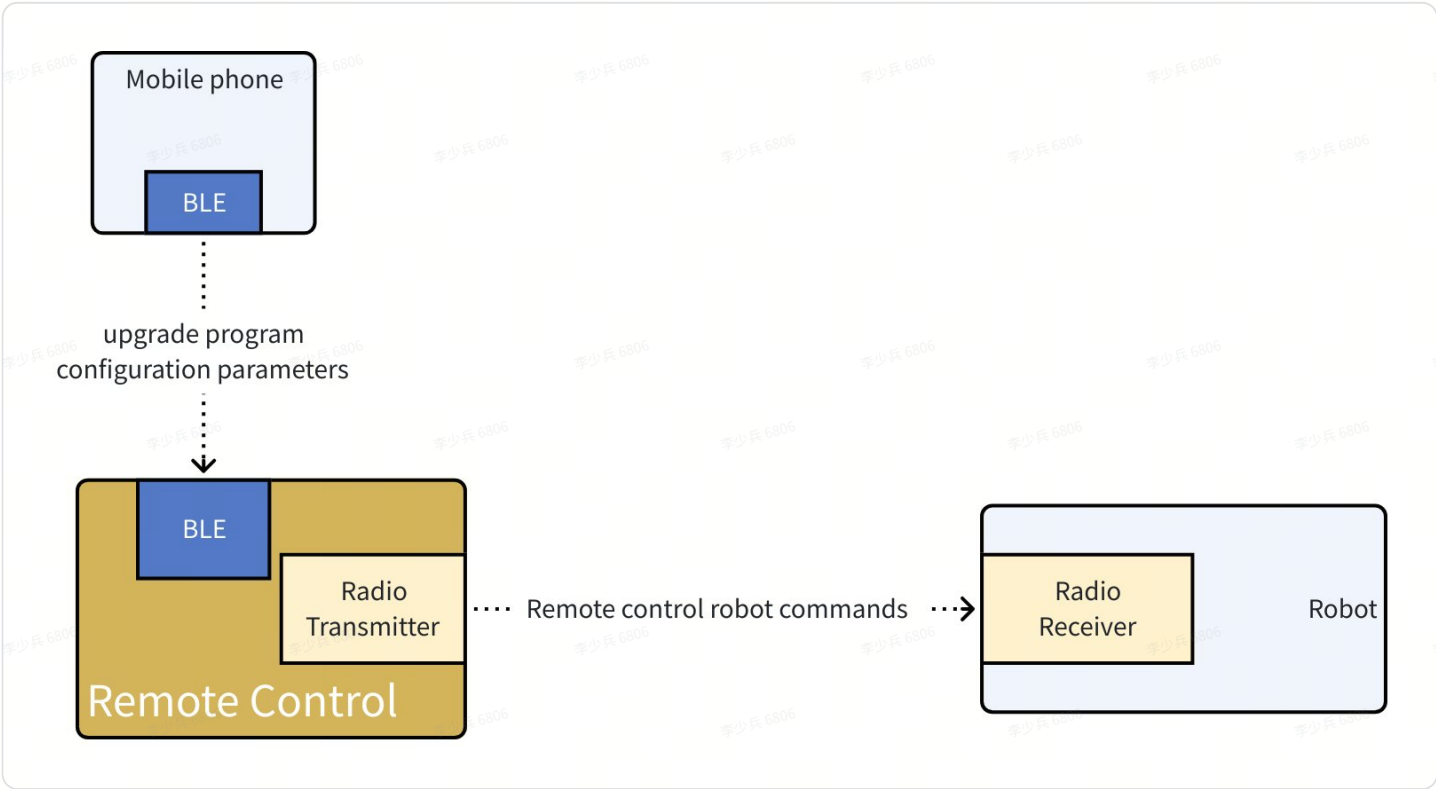

3.2 Function Introduction



This Remote control adopts a dual-link wireless architecture, including a Bluetooth communication link and a remote control link. The two links have independent functions and clear division of labor, ensuring system reliability and ease of use.

- The Bluetooth communication link is mainly used for firmware program upgrade and remote control parameter configuration, supporting parameter reading/writing, firmware downloading and version updating, to realize device function iteration and flexible parameter configuration.

- The remote control link is dedicated to real-time delivery of remote control commands, undertaking robot motion control functions, including stable transmission of key control commands such as robot forward, backward, left/right steering and state switching.

4 Power On/Off and Charging Functions

4.1 Power On/Off Functions

- **Power On** : Long press the Home button for 5 seconds to turn on the device; all indicators LED1, LED2, LED3, and LED4 light up simultaneously when powered on; LED1 remains on after successful startup.
- **Power Off** : Long press the Home button for 5 seconds to turn off the device; LED1, LED2, LED3, and LED4 flash synchronously during shutdown; all indicators turn off after successful shutdown.

4.2 Charging Functions

- When the battery is low: LED2 flashes to remind.
- During charging: LED2 keeps flashing.
- When the battery is fully charged: LED2 turns to constant on.
