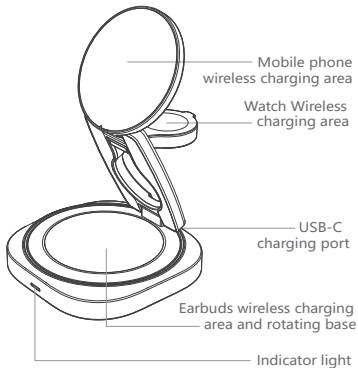

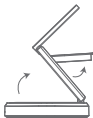

Use Instructions:

- 1 Lift the folded cell phone wireless charger upward, and gently push the watch charger to make it unfold completely.



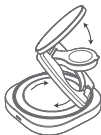
- 2 Insert the USB-C end of the charging cable into the product and the other end into the power adapter; the product can enter the normal working state.



- 3** This product can charge three devices at the same time: cell phone,earbuds and watch.



- 4** The folding part and rotating base can be adjusted to fit the user's comfortable angle.



5. Indicator light state:

Standby state	after connecting the power supply,the green light is constant to enter the standby state.
Charging state	when the phone is charging, the blue light comes on and automatically goes out after 20 seconds.
FOD foreign object detection	blue light flashes and stops power supply.

Warning:

5. Please do not place metal objects or magnetic cards on this product to avoid product damage or abnormal charging.
