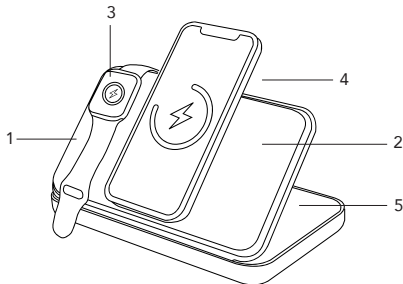

#### Product Overview

1. USB-C Input
2. Wireless charging surface for earbuds
3. Wireless charging surface for watch
4. Wireless charging surface for phone
5. Organizing tray



#### Charging your devices:

- Plug in the provided USB-C cable to the side of the lid
- You must have the organizer tray plugged in to use the wireless charger
- Plug the other end of the cable into a proper power source
- To charge your phone, place your phone on the wireless charging surface on top of the lid
- To charge your earbuds, place your earbuds on the wireless charging surface on top of the lid
- To charge your watch, place your watch on the wireless charging surface on top of the lid
