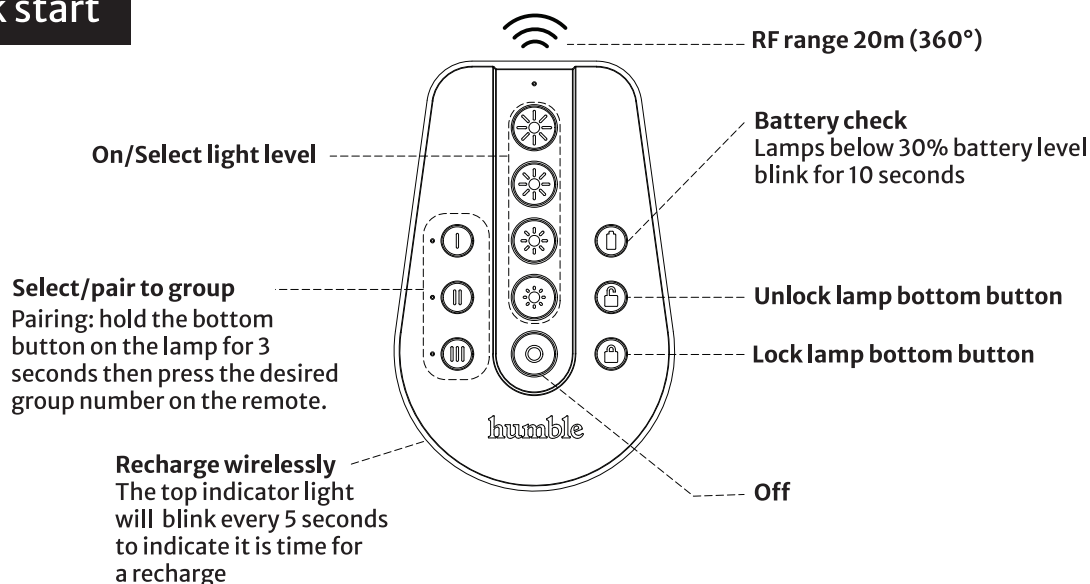

Quick start



Compatibility

The functionality the remote offers depends on the version of the lamps.

Features	Lamps with USB-C port	Lamps without USB-C port
On/Off + brightness	✓	✓
Grouping, locking & battery check	✗	✓

Charging the remote

When the battery is low, the top indicator light blinks every 5 seconds. Charge by placing the remote on a Humble or compatible wireless charger (not compatible with Apple brand MagSafe chargers). Charging takes about 60 minutes; a full charge lasts over one year with daily use.

Group lamps

By default all lamps are paired to group 1. To control lamps separately, pair them to groups 1–3:

1. Press and hold the lamp button for 3 seconds. The lamp fades in and out to indicate it is in pairing mode (60 seconds). If not paired within 60 seconds, it reverts to its previous state.
2. Press the desired group button on the remote. The lamp blinks to confirm pairing.
3. Select a group button on the remote to control only the lamps paired to that group.

Lock & unlock lamps

Prevents guests from adjusting lamps manually. To lock or unlock a group:

1. Select the group to lock/unlock.
2. Press the lock button to lock or the unlock button to unlock. The lamp blinks to confirm locking/unlocking.

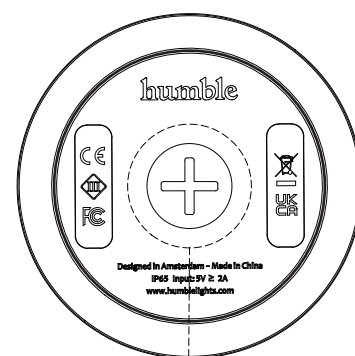
Check battery status

At brightness level 1 or 2, lamps typically last another night when the battery is above 30%. To check which lamps have fallen below 30%:

1. Select the group to check.
2. Press the battery check button. Lamps below 30% will blink for 10 seconds.

Factory reset of lamps (without a remote)

To reset all grouping on a lamp: press and hold the lamp button for 8 seconds. The lamp blinks to confirm.

Safety

Only charge using a Qi compatible wireless charger (not compatible with MagSafe).

Battery

This product operates on the 432–434 MHz frequency band with a maximum radiated power of 10 mW.
