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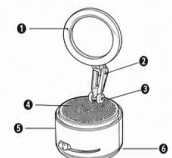

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Product Introduction



- 1 Magnetic suction module
- 2 360° rotatable link rod
- 3 360° rotatable connecting rod
- 4 Audio area
- 5 Toggle switch
- 6 Suction cup base

Switching Mechanism

Toggle the switch to the right to activate suction (on smooth flat surfaces).

Toggle the switch to the left to release suction.

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Instructions for Using the Phone Holder Function

- 1 Peel off the suction cup film and place it on a desk or other smooth surface.
- 2 Toggle the switch to the right to activate suction on smooth flat surfaces; toggle left to release.
- 3 Place the magnetic attachment side (with magnetic ring) or the iron side of your phone onto the magnetic module.
- 4 Rotate the product to adjust to a comfortable angle.

Smartphone Stand Function Instructions

- 1 Peel off the suction cup film and place it on a desk or other smooth surface.
- 2 Toggle the switch to the right to activate suction on smooth flat surfaces; toggle left to release.
- 3 Place the iron side of your phone onto the magnetic module to use the stand function.
- 4 Rotate the product to adjust to a comfortable angle.

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Key Operation Instructions

	Power On/Off Press and hold for 3 seconds to turn on.
	Play/Pause Press briefly once.
	TWS (True Wireless Stereo) When one device is already connected, double-press to connect or disconnect.
	Incoming Call Press briefly to answer; double-press to reject.
	Call End Press briefly to end the call.
