# Components



# Instructions

## 1. Power On:

Long press the power key for about 5 seconds to power on.

## 2. Power Off:

Long press the power key for about 2 seconds until the three icons—'Power On', 'Restart', and 'Factory Reset'—pop up. Then, tap the 'Power Off' icon to shut down.

## 3. Restart:

Long press the power key for about 2 seconds until the three icons—'Power On', 'Restart', and 'Factory Reset'—pop up. Then, tap the 'Restart' icon to reboot automatically.

## 4. Factory Reset:

Long press the power key for about 2 seconds until the three icons—'Power On', 'Restart', and 'Factory Reset'—pop up. Then, tap the 'Factory Reset' icon to restore the device to its factory settings.

## 5. Voice Dialogue:

When connected to the APP, double-click the power key to enter the voice dialogue interface. Or swipe up to enter the conversation interface.

**6. When Disconnected:** Double-click the power button to access the app download QR code.

**7. Swipe down for controls:** View battery level and adjust screen brightness.

**8. Main interface wallpaper:** Swipe left or right to switch wallpaper effects.

**Note:** After restoring the device to factory settings, iOS requires manually unpairing it from Bluetooth and then re-establishing the connection.

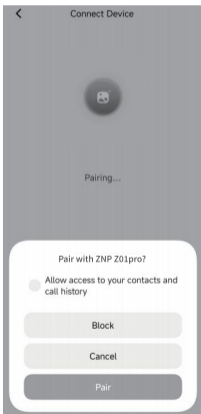
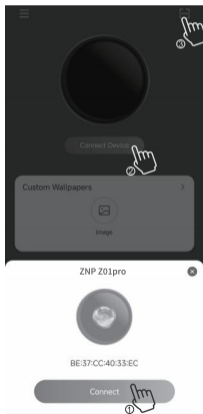

# Software Connection and Usage

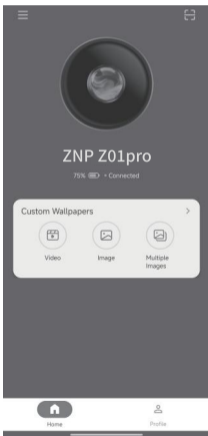
Three connection methods:

1. Open the app, and a pop-up window will appear on the page, allowing you to connect.
2. On the app home page, connect your device by tapping on the device named "ZNP Z01pro".
3. Tap the scan icon in the upper right corner and scan the device QR code to connect.



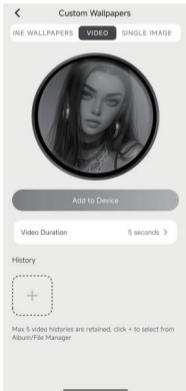
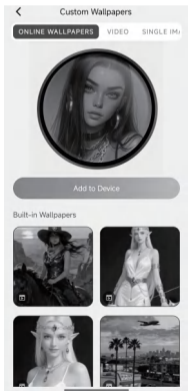
# Connection Successful

Access the main app interface as shown below.



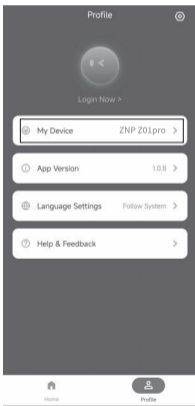
# Custom Wallpapers

1. Online Wallpaper: Select your favorite themes. Tap "Upload".
2. Video: Tap "+" to choose from the album/file manager. The duration of each video clip must be between 3 and 8 seconds. Tap "Upload" to proceed. (Up to 5 historical videos can be saved.)
3. Single Image: Tap "+" to choose from the album/file manager. Stickers are also available for image editing. Tap "Upload" to proceed. (Up to 5 historical images can be saved.)
4. Multiple Images: Tap "+" to choose 1–10 images from the album/file manager. You can also select the playback duration for each image in the carousel. Tap "Upload" to proceed. (Up to 5 multiple-image AVI files can be saved.)

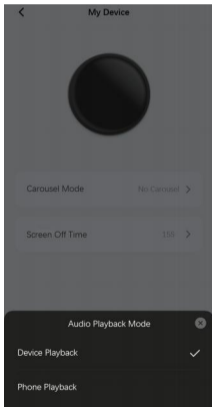


# Playback Mode

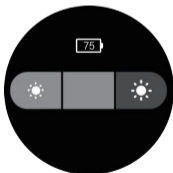

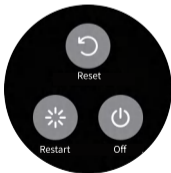

### **1. Do I need to connect Bluetooth from the phone settings first?**

No, you only need to connect via the APP. Remember to click "Pair".

### **2. Is "Saymi" the only option for switching audio playback?**

Yes, the audio playback switch in the APP interface is only for the "Saymi" audio output port. Please disconnect the "Saymi" connection first if other APPs need to change the audio output port.

### **3. Does "Saymi" have a memory function?**

Currently, it does not. The previous memory is not supported for storage after each restart of the conversation.

### **4. What can "Saymi" do?**

At present, "Saymi" can provide mutual translation in 60 languages (you can do this by issuing the command "Enter translation mode"), knowledge Q&A (equivalent to an "encyclopedia"), and companion mode (playing games and adventures together, and it can also tell you stories)...

### **5. Why didn't my wallpaper upload succeed? It shows insufficient memory.?**

Uploading videos consumes a significant amount of memory. If you have insufficient space, you can try pressing and holding an unwanted wallpaper for 2 seconds to delete it, freeing up space before re-uploading.

### **6. Why can't my device connect/pair?**

Due to the Bluetooth auto-reconnection mechanism, the device failed to pair. To resolve this, clear the historical connection records in both your phone and the APP, or perform a factory reset on the device.

The development of Saymi's functions has never stopped. Feel free to use your imagination and put forward your needs—we are always here!

## Important Safety Instructions

Carefully read all the safety instructions in this document before using the product.

### General safety instructions

- Use the product with care and store it in a clean environment that is free from extreme temperature, pressure, and humidity. Make sure that the product is stored in a location where it cannot be bent or squeezed.
