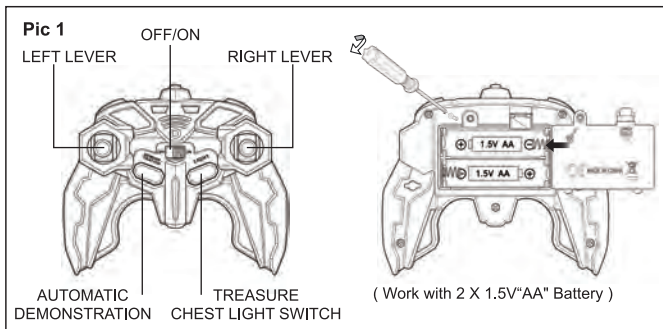

How to install the battery

1. Turn the switch on both the stunt car and the remote control to the "OFF" position.
2. Use a Phillips screwdriver to open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert the AA batteries as illustrated in Pic 1.
4. Close the battery compartment cover.



How to use it

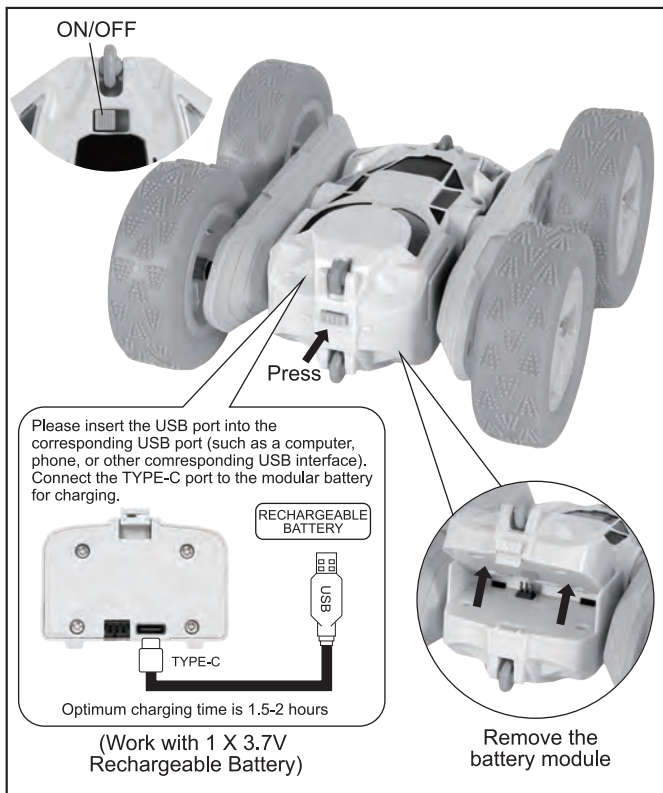
1. Turn on the switch on the remote controller by sliding it to the "ON" position.
2. Switch on the stunt car by sliding its power switch to the "ON" position.
3. You can now use the remote controller to operate the car.
4. If the car does not respond to the remote controller, the battery in the car may need to be recharged.

Maintenance

1. If the toy will not be used for an extended period, please ensure the batteries are removed.
2. Gently clean the car with a soft, dry cloth.
3. Keep the toy out of direct sunlight and avoid exposing it to high temperatures when not in use.

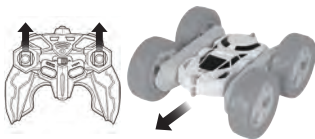
Tips

When charging is complete, the red LED at the charging port will automatically turn off, indicating a full charge.

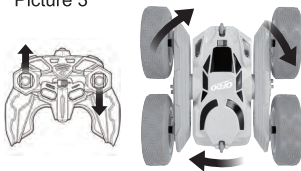
Push both control sticks upward to move forward.

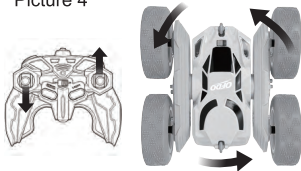
Pull both control sticks downward to move backward.

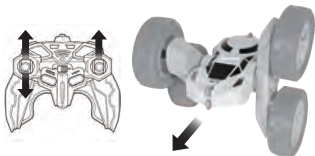
Push the left stick upward and pull the right stick downward to spin clockwise.

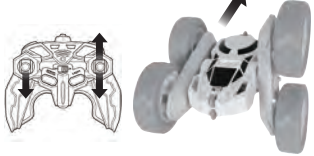
Pull the left stick downward and push the right stick upward to spin counter clockwise.

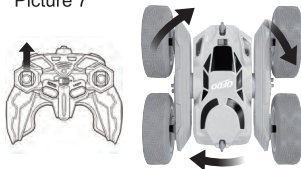
Push both sticks upward to move forward, then pull the left stick down to rotate the left wheel forward.

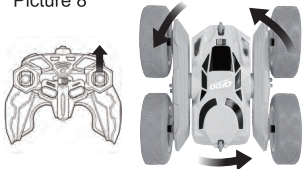
Pull down on both rockers to move backward, then push up on the right rocker to rotate the right wheel backward.

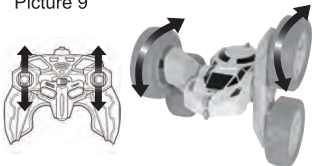
Push only the left stick upward to spin the car to the right.

Push and pull both sticks alternately to make both wheels spin forward and backward at the same time.

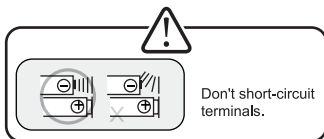
Battery Usage Attention

1. Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
2. Do not attempt to charge non-rechargeable batteries.
3. Rechargeable batteries must be charged under adult supervision.
4. Do not mix different types of batteries or new and used batteries.
5. Do not dispose of batteries in fire; they may explode or cause environmental harm.

6. Regularly inspect the charger wires, plugs, casing, and battery parts. Discontinue use immediately if any damage is found and repair it before reuse.
7. Remove exhausted batteries from the toy promptly.
8. Rechargeable batteries must be removed from the car before charging.
9. Keep these instructions for future reference.
10. Retain the product packaging for potential future use.

Attention

1. If the battery is low, the car may not flip properly during play.
2. Do not use the car on overly smooth surfaces, as this may prevent the flip function from working correctly.
3. Ensure the battery is fully charged before use.
