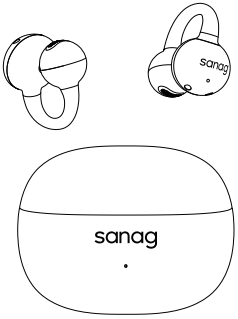


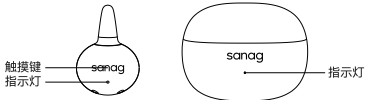

● 产品概述



● 按键功能操作

● 开机: 1.打开充电仓取出耳机自动开机, 白蓝灯交替闪, 左右耳连接成功后副耳灯熄灭, 主耳白蓝灯交替闪烁; 2.长按耳机任意耳MFB键3秒开机。

● 关机: 耳机放入充电仓自动关机。

● 配对: 耳机开机后自动进入配对状态(与手机待连状态), 主耳白蓝灯交替闪烁, 副耳不亮灯。

● 接听: 来电时, 双击任意耳MFB触摸键。

● 挂断: 通话中, 双击任意耳MFB触摸键。

● 拒接: 来电时, 长按任意耳2秒MFB触摸键。

● 播放/暂停: 双击任意耳MFB触摸键。

● 上一曲: 三击左耳MFB触摸键。

● 下一曲: 三击右耳MFB触摸键。

● 音量加: 手机端控制。

● 音量减: 手机端控制。

● 语音助手: 长按3秒任意耳MFB触摸键自动进入语音助手。

● 恢复出厂设置: 开机时长按任意耳MFB键10秒后恢复耳机出厂设置, 恢复成功后白灯常亮3秒后进入待连接状态。

● 低电报警: 耳机电量不足时 每隔3分钟提示一次低电报警提示音。

● 耳机充电: 耳机放入仓充电中, 耳机白灯闪3下后常亮, 仓闪一下后常亮。耳机充满电, 耳机灯灭, 仓灯灭。

● 充电仓充电中: 仓绿灯闪烁, 充满后绿灯常亮。

● 蓝牙操作

● 蓝牙连接成功:

1.耳机进入蓝牙模式, 手机搜索蓝牙配对名“sanag Z60S”, 点击连接即可。

2.耳机默认回连上一次设备。

● 蓝牙断开:

1.手动关闭手机蓝牙端, 耳机进入蓝牙配对模式。

2.耳机与手机超距后断开, 5分钟内回到有效距离范围, 能正常回连手机, 超过5分钟会自动关机。

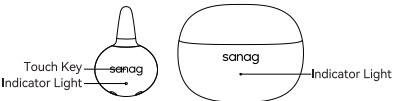

● Product Overview

● Key Function Operation

● Power on: 1. Open the charging case and take out the earphones to automatically turn on the device. The white and blue lights flash alternately, and the left and right ears are successfully connected

The auxiliary ear light goes out, and the main ear white and blue lights alternate flashing; 2. Press and hold the MFB button on any ear of the headphones for 3 seconds to turn on the device.

● Shutdown: The earphones will automatically shut down when placed in the charging compartment.

● Pairing: After turning on the earphones, they automatically enter pairing mode (waiting to be connected to the phone), with white and blue lights on the main ear

Alternating flashing, the secondary ear does not light up.

● Answering: When a call comes, double-click the MFB touch button on any ear.

● Hanging up: During the call, double-click on any ear MFB touch button.

● Reject: When receiving a call, press and hold the MFB touch button on either ear for 2 seconds.

● Play/Pause: Double click on any ear MFB touch button.

● Previous song: Three clicks on the left ear MFB touch button.

● Next song: Three clicks on the right ear MFB touch button.

● Volume increase: Control on mobile phone.

● Volume reduction: Control on mobile phone.

● Voice Assistant: Press and hold the MFB touch key on any ear for 3 seconds to automatically enter the voice assistant.

● Factory reset: Press and hold the MFB button on any ear for 10 seconds during startup to restore the headphone's factory settings. After successful restoration, the white light will remain on for 3 seconds before entering the ready to connect state.

● Low battery alarm: When the earphone battery is low, a low battery alarm prompt sound will be triggered every 3 minutes.

● Earphone charging: When the earphones are placed in the charging compartment, the white light on the earphones flashes 3 times and stays on, and the compartment flashes once and stays on.

The earphones are fully charged, the earphone light is off, and the compartment light is off.

● During charging in the charging compartment: The compartment green light flashes, and the green light remains on after being fully charged.

● Bluetooth operation

● Bluetooth connection successful:

1. The headset enters Bluetooth mode, the cell phone searches for the Bluetooth pairing name "sanag Z60S", click to connect.

2. The headset defaults back to the last device connected.

● Bluetooth Disconnect:

1. Manually close the Bluetooth terminal of the cell phone, the headset enters the Bluetooth pairing mode.

2. The headset disconnects from the cell phone after over distance, returns to the effective distance range within 5 minutes, and can connect back to the cell phone normally, and will automatically shut down after more than 5 minutes.
